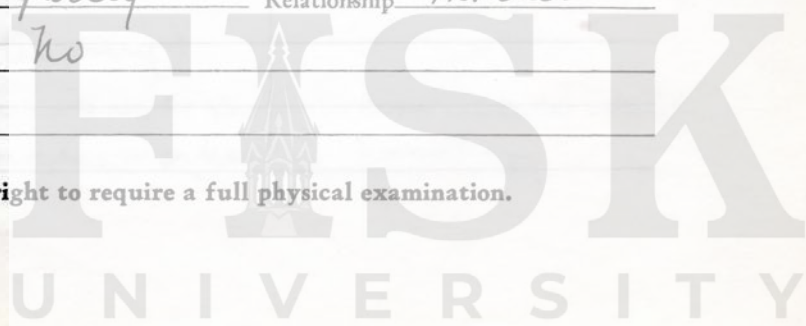

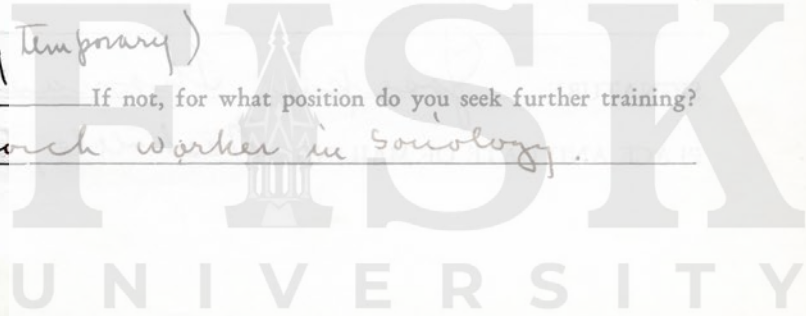

Your Plan of Work should be complete and carefully prepared. Submit five copies typed on 8 1/2" x 11" paper. Your name should be on each sheet.
