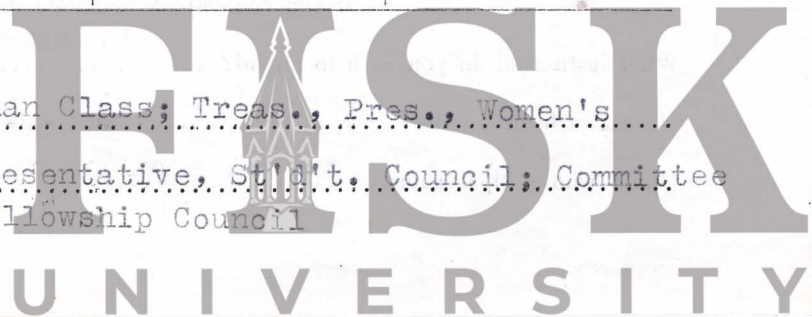

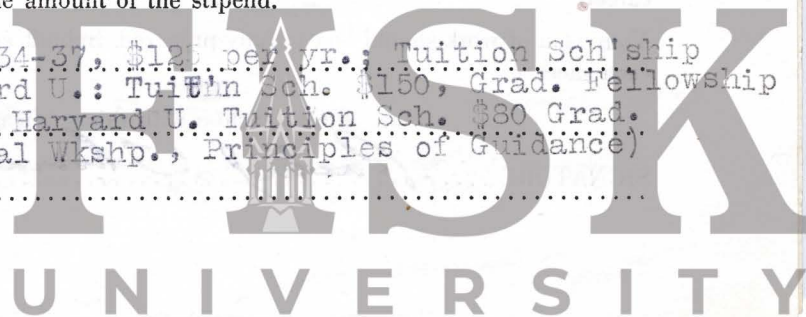

Statement of Plan of Work

Your plan of work should be carefully prepared. Submit *eight copies* typed on 8½" x 11" paper. Your name should be on each sheet.
