

In addition to the above allotments, lump sum appropriations have been made by the Fund for (1) school-houses from seven-teacher to twelve-teacher types and (2) teachers' homes, specific allocations to be made to states by approved applications, after a careful study of each individual project.

The Fund will also consider giving, for the year 1930-31, one and one-half times the regular allotment to the first Rosenwald School constructed in any county having 10% or more Negro population. There are now 101 such counties in the South with Negro populations ranging from 10% to 72%, which have not built a single school by aid of the Fund. This special offer is made with the hope of stimulating a large number of these counties to erect schools of three-teacher type or larger the current year.

The attached plan for distribution of aid shows for the year 1930-31 the schedule of allotments for all types of construction and some general requirements.



Dear Mr. Snead: In Mr. Credle's absence I am writing to say that the Fund's aid on a four-room permanent shop building would be \$1,100 on the building and one-third the cost of the purchase of equipment not to exceed \$100 per room. In other words it would be possible for you to receive a total of \$1,500 on the building and equipment.

Since you are trying to make this a model school and since the Fund's large offer on schools like yours was made with the hope and expectation that vocational work for both boys and girls would be furnished to suit the needs of the community I very much hope that you and your fine Board will put forth every effort to get the building erected this year if possible. That would put you in a fine position to begin the vocational work for the boys next year. It might be that the State Department would cooperate with you either in building the vocational room or in helping to furnish aid on a teacher or teachers. You certainly have an excellent school building, one of the best I have seen in a state.

Dear Mr. Lambert: We note from your letter of the second that the Montgomery County Training School lost its building which was given aid by the Fund on a four-teacher basis - \$1,100. Since they collected \$3,700 insurance and the total cost of the building was reported to us at \$4,775, the Fund's moral equity in the insurance would be about \$848.

If you rebuild this on a four, five, or six-room basis you would receive the regular allotment from the Fund less \$848. If you should build a six-room vocational shop in brick we could give you \$1,600 less \$848 or in wood, \$1,300 with \$848 deducted. Or if you should decide to build a six-teacher school, we could give you the regular allotment less \$848. We leave this for you to figure out, making application for the type of building you desire.




