My dear Miss Dudley:

I am pleased to inform you that on the basis of your credentials from Michigan State Normal College, you may be admitted to the Graduate School for work in the Department of Hygiene and Public Health.

Students seeking the master's degree must complete a minimum of 24 hours of graduate credit which satisfactory grades, 18 hours of which must be earned in residence. You will note in the bulletin that registration begins June 26 and that classes start June 29. At the time of registration you will be given the opportunity to confer with an adviser in your Department of Specialization, who will assist in arranging a satisfactory program of study.

If it is found at the time of registration that deficiencies exist in your record, these may be made up during the Summer Session. It is usually possible to complete the requirements in one academic year or four summer sessions, and in exceptional cases one semester and one summer session or three summer sessions are sufficient.
