We are sorry to advise you that on account of new contract just entered into with the union effective yesterday's date, we are obliged to work on a forty hour week from now on and therefore closed on Saturdays and also it would not be possible to have the jury on Sunday, April 7th. We would however recommend that you have your meeting on the 8th of April and finish on the 9th if necessary and presume that you will send us the usual list of exhibitors' names. Also we would recommend that you advise the out of town artists who are shipping by express to allow more time than usual for transit as all express matters are very badly delayed these days.
