SCHOOL HISTORY

Bishop High School provides a rigorous college preparatory program for young men and women in grades 9-12. Bishop combines the rich heritage of two predecessor schools, Dolores School, which opened in 1914 and Catholic High School, which opened in 1940. The school relocated in 1959 and was renamed in honor of Francisco Garcia Diego y Moreno, the first bishop of California. Bishop is independently operated and is governed by a Board of Trustees.

The school serves the diverse community of Santa Barbara County (population 446,499) and is located near downtown Santa Barbara, with access to many cultural, educational and recreational activities.
