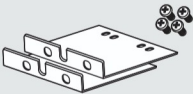
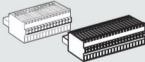

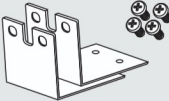

Installing the HDD



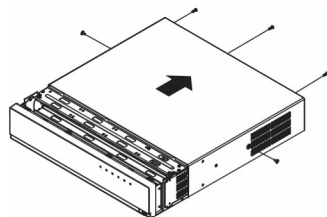
- If you are adding a new or previously used HDD to this product in addition to the HDD(s) originally installed, format the new HDD manually in the set before use.
- If you wish to replace or add an HDD, contact your dealer or our customer service first.

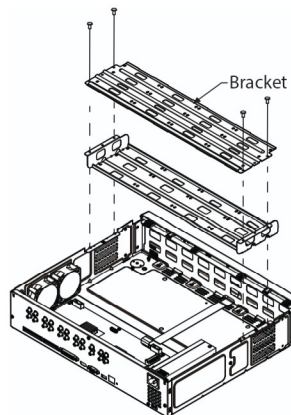


- The images below are based on the HRX-1635 model.

- 1 Loosen the screws on the left/right sides and back and slide the cover back to remove it.

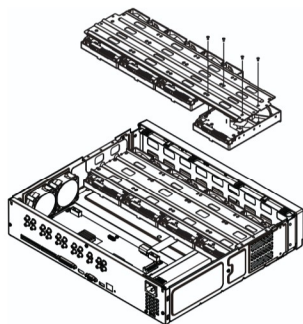


- 2 Loosen the left/right screws and remove the bracket.

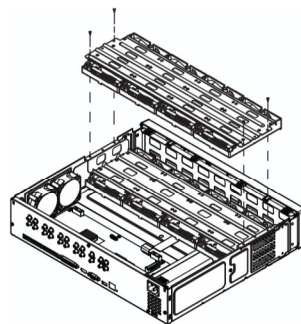


- 3 Install 8 HDDs to the bracket and fix them with screws.

- For the HRX-835A, install the HDD only to the bottom bracket.



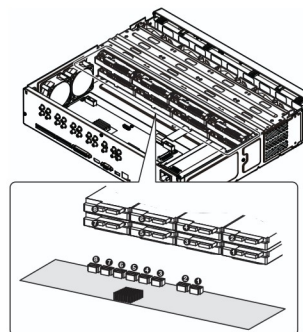
- 4 Fix the bracket with the HDD to the recorder with screws.



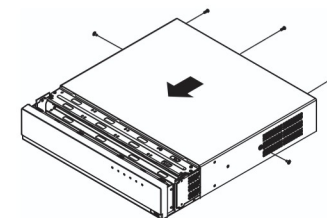
- To prevent damage to the HDD(s) due to vibration, it is recommended to install it first to the bottom bracket.

- 5 Connect the SATA/power cable of the HDD to the connector on the motherboard.

- Refer to the figure below for the location/connector number of the HDD.

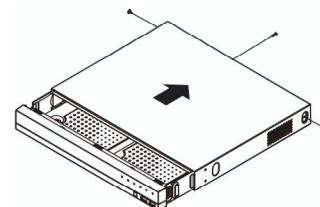


- 6 After making sure that there is no problem with the connection terminal and wiring inside the product, close the cover and fix it with screws.

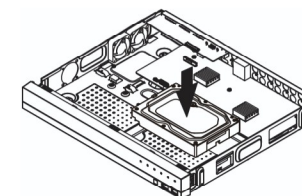

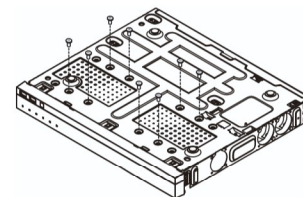
- 1 Loosen the screws on the left/right sides and back and slide the cover back to remove it.



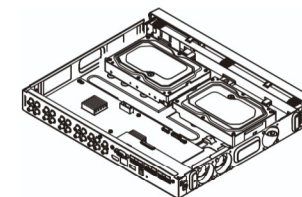
- 2 Connect the SATA/power cable of the HDD to the connector on the motherboard.



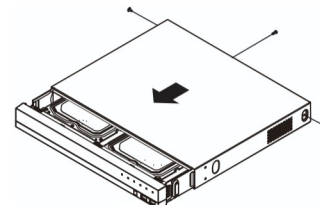
- 3 Fix the HDD to the bottom of the recorder with screws.



- 4 Check if there is any problem with the connection terminal and wiring inside the product.

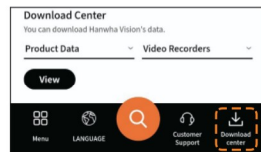
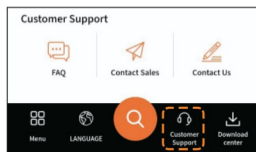
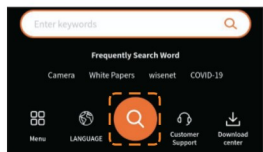
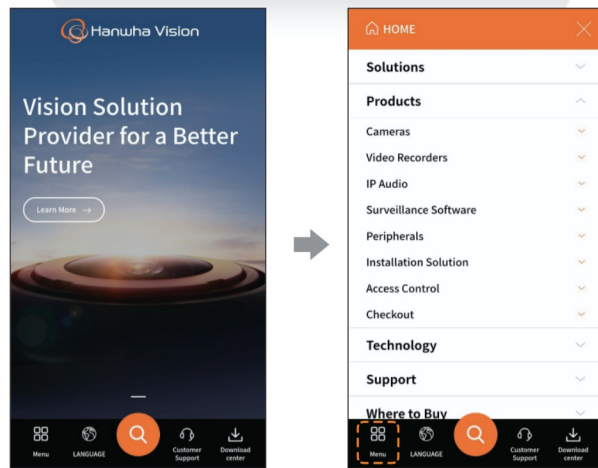


- 5 Close the cover and secure it with screws.

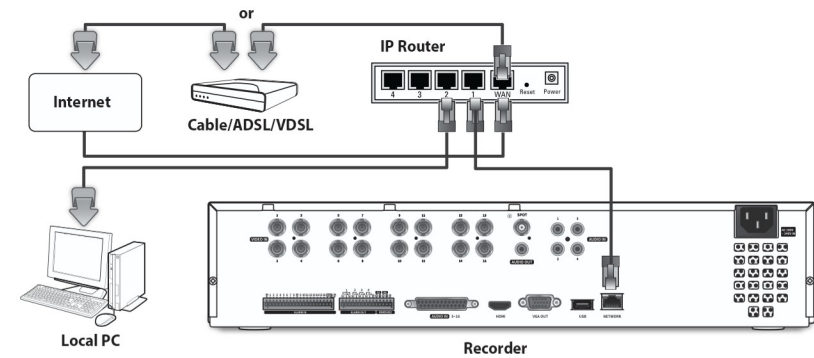


Connecting to a Network Using a Router

If you want to add 1-3 PCs and recorders in an environment using xDSL/Cable modem, you can use the router with only one Internet line.

Connecting a router with PC



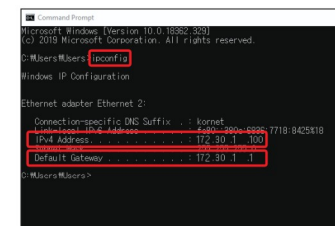

Connecting a recorder and a router

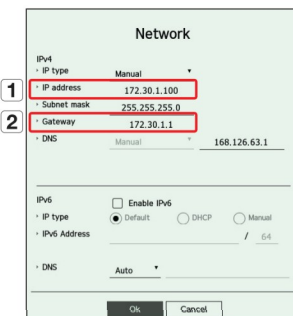
Move to <IP & Port> of the Recorder <Network> Setting menu, and set the ① <IP address> and ② <Gateway> in <Setup>.

※ The <Default gateway> checked on the [cmd.exe] window of the local PC and the <Gateway> of the recorder must be the same.

※ At least the third number of the recorder <IP address> should be set to be the same as the <Default gateway> checked on the [cmd.exe] window of the local PC.



<cmd screen>

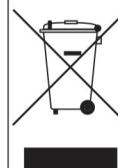


<ex. Recorder screen>
