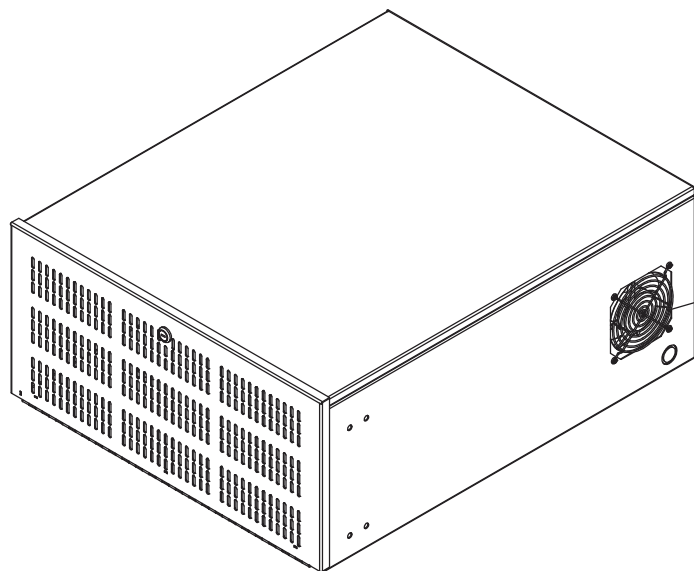
PRODUCT FEATURES

INSTALLATION

TOOLS REQUIRED

- #2 Phillips Head Driver
- 5/16" Wrench (For Installing Optional Fan Controller)



FOR EASE OF INSTALLATION THE TOP MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE MOUNTING



- 1) Open the front door and remove the two screws from the top. **(FIGURE A)**

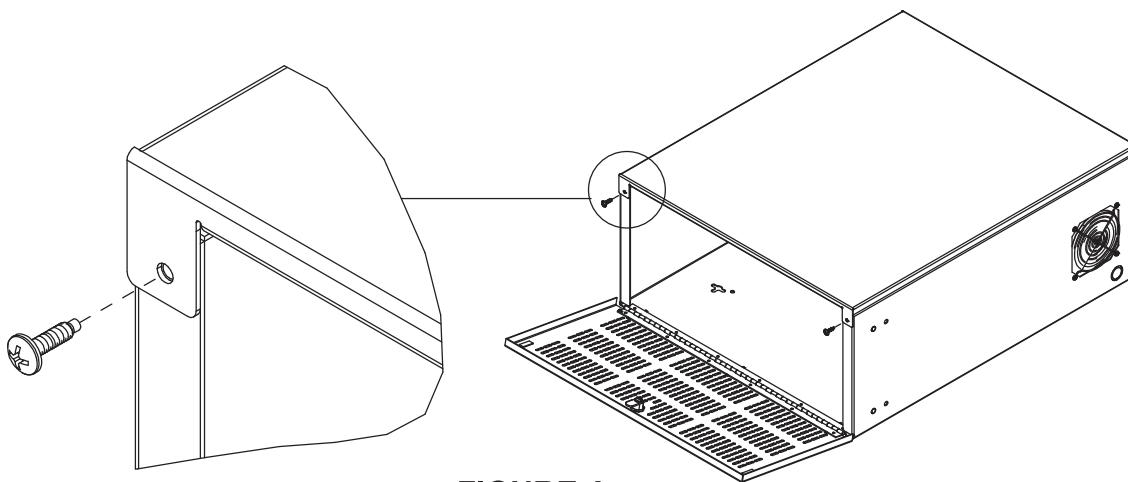

2) Remove top by sliding it forward (**FIGURE B**) to detach tabs (**FIGURE C**).

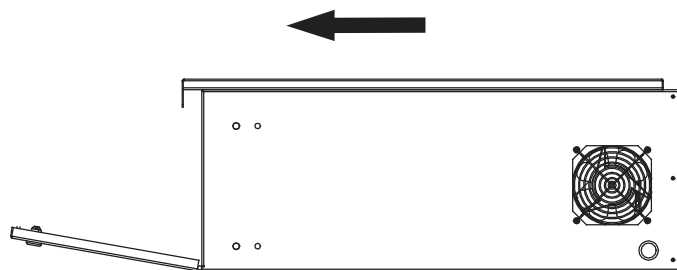

3) Lift off the top. (**FIGURE D**)

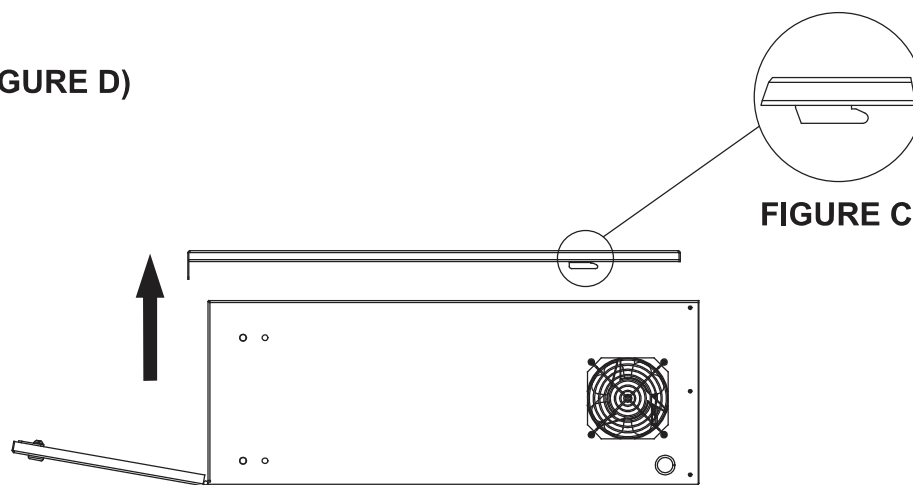

TIP: When mounting in this position, placing washers between the DLBX and mounting surface provides greater clearance for the door to swing open. (**FIGURE E**)

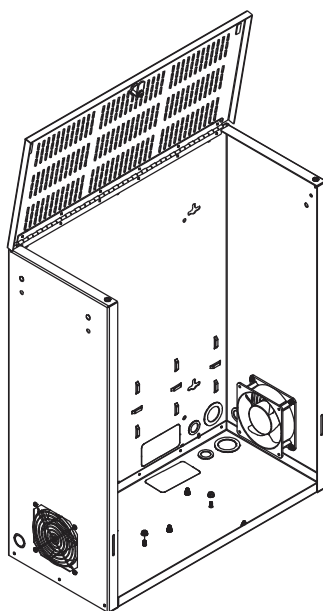
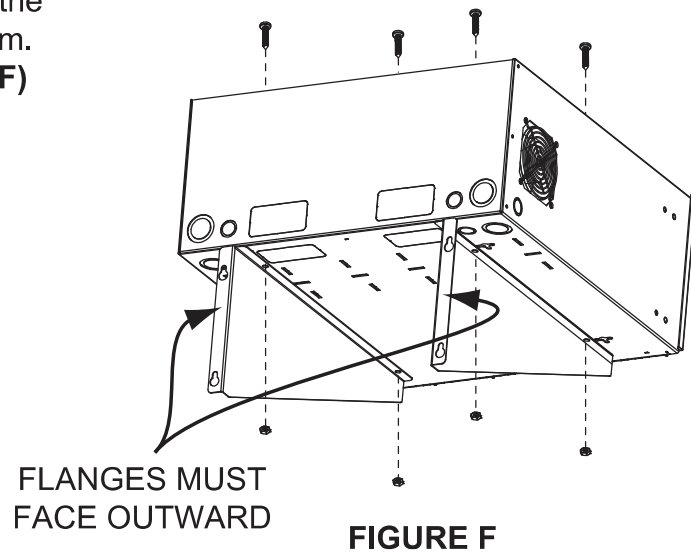

Mounting DLBX using optional wall-mount brackets, part number DLBX-WM.

- 1) Using the provided studs and nuts, attach the mounting bracket (DLBX-WM) to the bottom. The flanges must face outward. **(FIGURE F)**



WOOD STUD WALL INSTALLATION

- 2) Drill a 5/32" pilot hole in stud center.
- 3) Using customer supplied 5/16" lag bolt and washer, mount DLBX to wall ensuring lag bolt penetrates 2" into the stud.

BLOCK WALL INSTALLATION

- 2) Drill a 7/8" pilot hole in hollow.
- 3) Bolt DLBX to wall with customer supplied 5/16" toggle bolt and washer.
- 4) Using customer supplied hardware, mount brackets to wall. **(FIGURE G)**

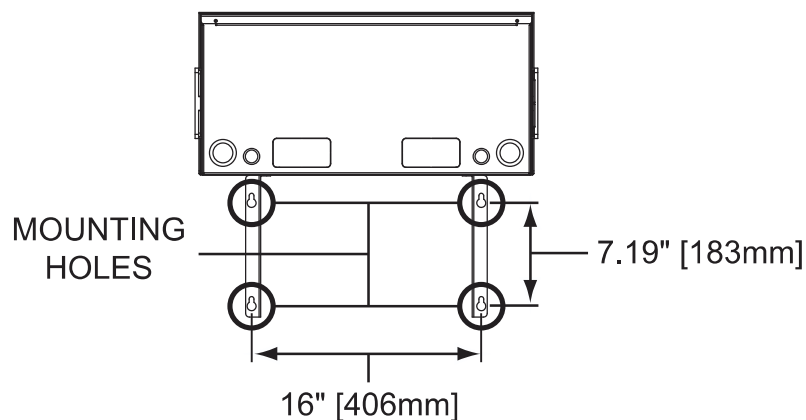

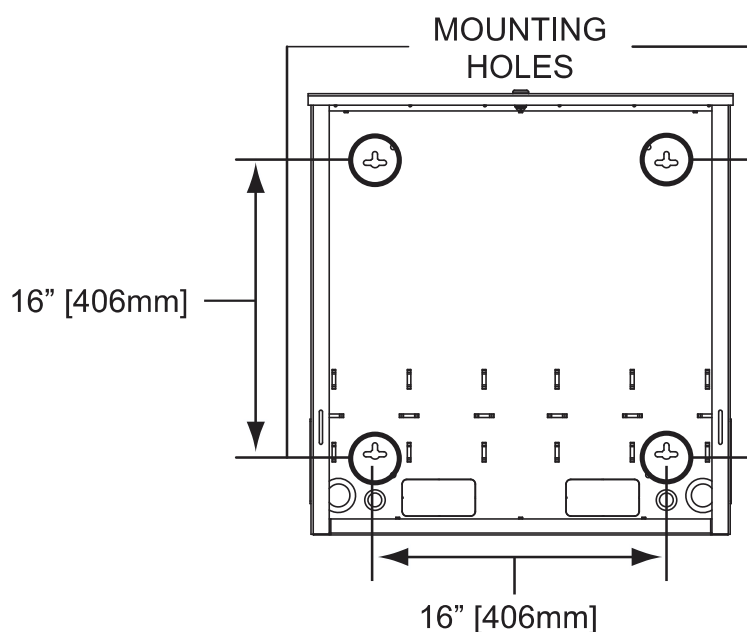
Mounting DLBX without optional wall-mount brackets, part number DLBX-WM.

WOOD STUD WALL INSTALLATION

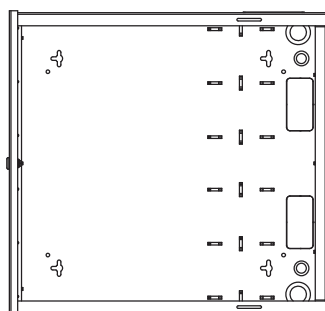
- 1) Drill 1/8" pilot hole into stud center.
- 2) Using customer supplied 1/4" lag bolt and washer, mount DLBX to wall ensuring lag bolt penetrates 2" into the stud. **(FIGURE H - mounting hole locations)**

BLOCK WALL INSTALLATION

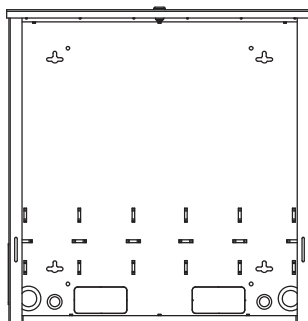
- 1) Drill 5/8" hole in hollow.
- 2) Bolt DLBX to wall with customer supplied 1/4" toggle bolt and washer using all 4 mounting holes. **(FIGURE H - mounting hole locations)**



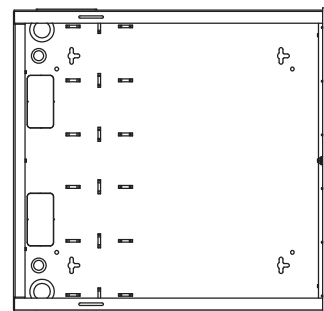
TIP: Mounting holes are designed to allow mounting in three different positions.

CENTER MOUNT

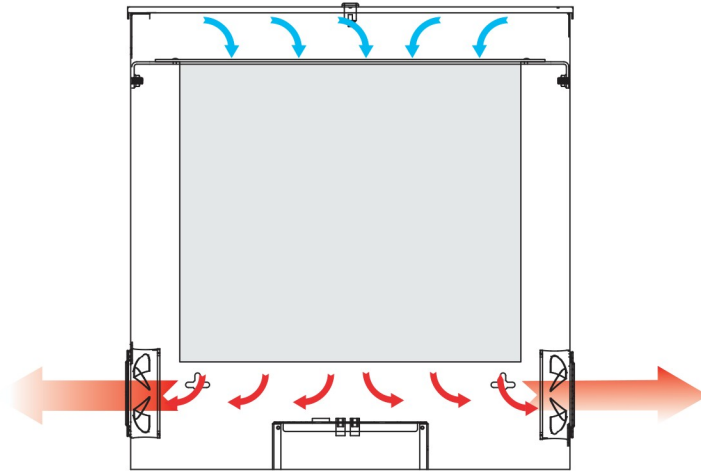


RIGHT MOUNT

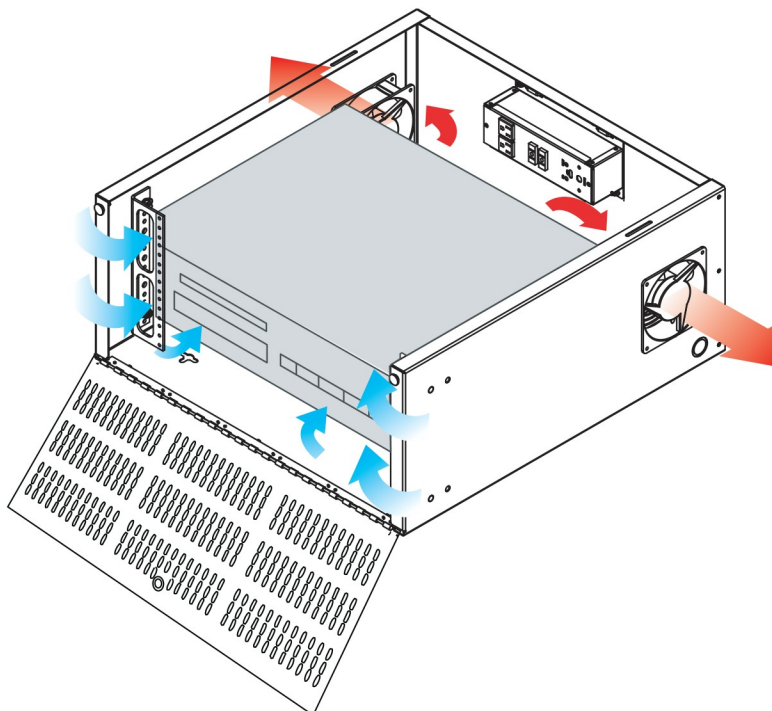

THERMAL MANAGEMENT (Shown With Optional Rackrail And Fan Controller)

- DLBX shown mounted horizontally to the wall.



- DLBX shown mounted vertically to the wall (Top removed and front open for clarity).



OPTIONS

- Middle Atlantic Products recommends using the FC-2-215-C Proportional Speed Thermostatic Fan Controller to extend equipment life and reduce noise.
- Using the nuts installed on the back of the DLBX, install the Fan Controller using a 5/16" wrench (**FIGURE J**). The Fan Controller can be mounted top or bottom justified.

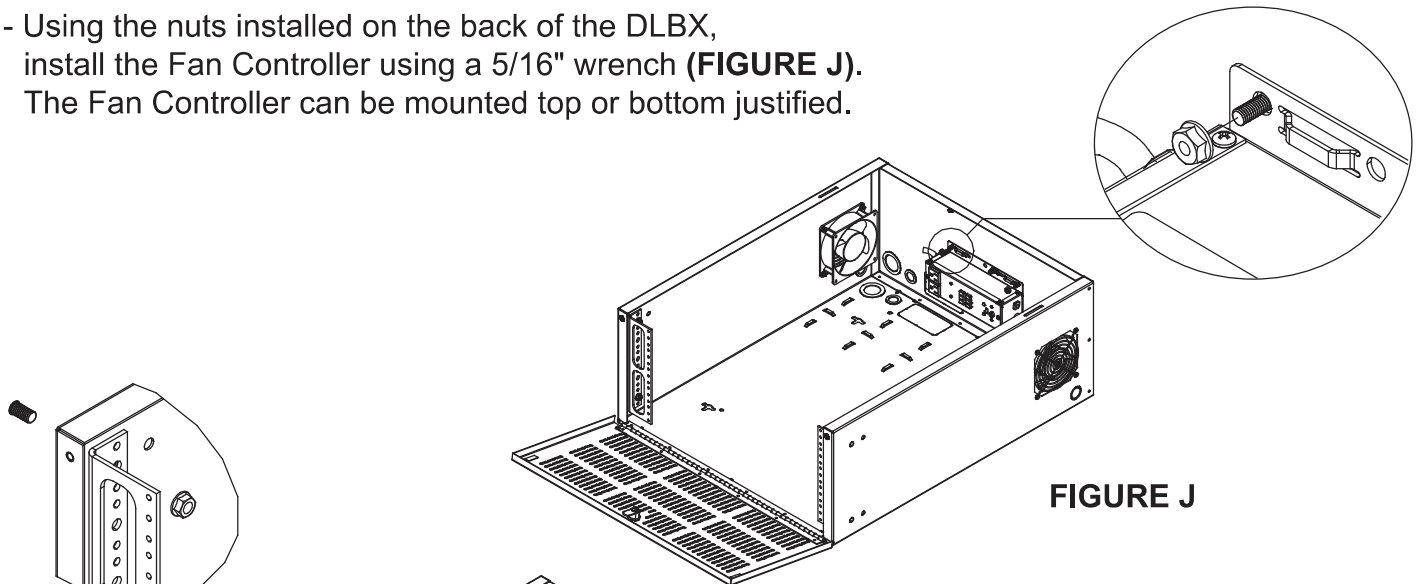

- 5 space 10-32 threaded rackrail with cable pass-through cutouts available. Part number DLBX-RR5. Install as shown using provided hardware. (**FIGURE K**)

- Two sets of mounting holes for rail setback.

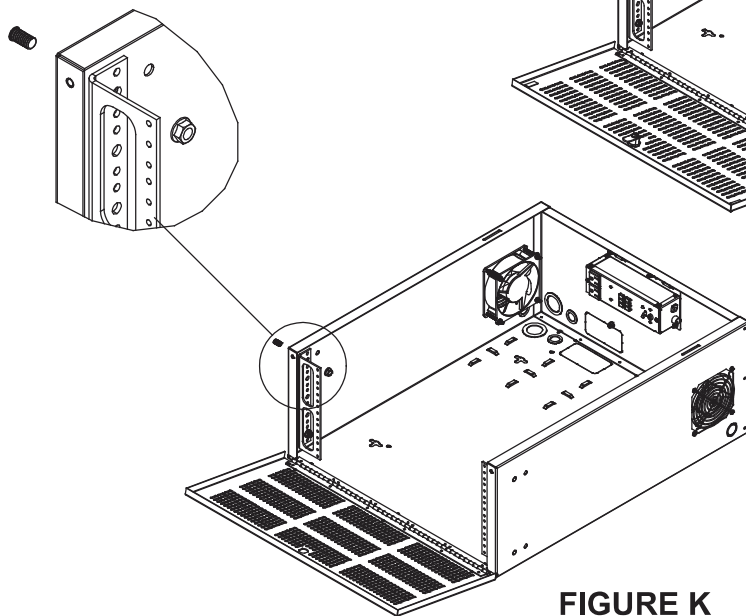
