2012-13 SEASON PREVIEW

Expectations and goals for the Cleveland State men's and women's swimming and diving teams are as high as ever in 2012-13.

"Our goals are always to have a winning record, to win a league championship, and combine being great students with great athletes," said Head Coach Wally Morton on the upcoming season.

Here is a preview breakdown of the men's and women's squads.

Men's Preview

The men's Cleveland State swimming and diving team is coming off strong and record-breaking 2011-12 season, and ready to improve on those results this upcoming season.

On the men's side, the squad will be looking to improve on an 11-4 record that saw them win nine of their last 10 meets.

Individually, three different Vikings were able to break records last season, with all three returning in 2012-13. Senior Berry Thompson broke the record in the 100-yard freestyle (43.33), junior Alex Lewis broke the record in the 100-yard butterfly (48.28), and junior Justin Kermack broke the record in the 200-yard butterfly (1:47.30). All three of those records came at the Horizon League Championships, where the Vikings finished second as a team.

As the men's squad looks ahead to this season, the three swimmers mentioned above will in no way be the only strong returners. Looking at the team's top times from 2011-12, every single top time was swam by a swimmer returning to the pool for Cleveland State this year.

Other top returners outside the three mentioned above include, Nathan Grant (swam team's top time in the 200 freestyle, and the 50, 100, and 200 breaststrokes, George Thoresen (swam the team's top time in the 500 and 1,000 freestyle), Al Shillito (swam the team's top time in the 100 and 200 backstroke), and Jon Querciagrossa (swam the team's top time in the 1,650 freestyle).

Even with all of the top returners, the best men's swimmer may be one who missed all of last year with an injury, senior Mark DeSwardt.

"Mark is arguably individually in terms of his events the greatest swimmer in the history of the Horizon League," said Morton on his returning senior.

DeSwardt wasn't the only swimmer that Morton recognized as one of his top male returners.

He also mentioned both Cohara and Thoresen going along with De Swardt to lead the distance, and guys like Berry Thompson and Justin Hill leading the sprinters group.

While the men's team will have an impressive amount of returners, they will be filling in spots with a talented incoming freshman class as well.

The freshman class in 2012-13 features a strong group of six swimmers as well as one diver.

These swimmers include Vaughn Dueble (sprints), Mauricio Gonzalez (freestyle, butterfly), Adam Ingledew (freestyle, backstroke), Michael Pavlak (IM, backstroke), Martin Persson (freestyle), and Alex Strawser (breaststroke, IM). The new diver added to the program is Danny Roberts.

Women's Preview

The Cleveland State women's swimming and diving team is coming off a 12-4 finish in 2011-12, and ready to continue the program's rise towards the top of the Horizon League in 2012-13.

Similar to the men's side of the pool, the Viking returners this season are a record-breaking bunch. The group broke 11 individual swimming school records, and four relay school records.

School records weren't the only records to fall last season, league records fell to returning CSU swimmers as well. Joanna Olsson was able to break the 400 IM record with a time of 4:19.57, and three returners (Alice Sommerville, Christine Kopacko, and Alexandra Johansson) were members of the league record breaking 200 free relay team (1:31.18).

The chance for those records to fall again this season is there for CSU, as each swimmer who broke an individual record last year is back in the pool in 2012-13.

With top returners in multiple individual events this season, there is nowhere to go but up for the team and program.

A few of those key returners include Alice Sommerville (freestyle/butterfly/breaststroke), Alexandra Johansson (freestyle/butterfly/backstroke), Joanna Olsson (butterfly/breaststroke/IM), Gretchen Hestley (freestyle/IM), and Nicole Kolis (freestyle/backstroke).

Head Coach Wally Morton mentioned Sommerville and Olsson as being two of the top swimmers in program history, with big things expected of them in the year ahead.

Similar to the men's squad, the Viking women's team will also be bringing a very successful and promising freshman class.

Four swimmers and one diver will be joining the team this upcoming season, and they will be looking to add depth to that already strong returning group.

Those freshmen include Kayley Chevalier (IM/backstroke), Jill Rothgery (freestyle), Jodi Turk (IM), Madison Wolfe (backstroke, butterfly), and Samantha Sposet (diving).



WALLY MORTON

HEAD COACH // 32ND SEASON

With over 300 combined wins in his 31 years as a head coach at Cleveland State, Wally Morton has secured his legacy as one of the greatest coaches in Viking history.

Morton has led the men's team to double-digit wins 15 times, including each of the past 11 seasons. In 28 of his 31 seasons the men have finished .500 or better, with the team obtaining a winning percentage of .700 or higher a remarkable 14 times. Since taking over as coach in 2007, the women's team has also experienced an unprecedented level of success, winning 41 dual meets over the past three seasons with the team taking second at the 2011-12 Horizon League Championships.

Named the Director of Competitive Aquatics in 2007, Morton is entering his 39th season with the men's program and his sixth with the women's team. Prior to being named the head coach of the men's program in 1981, he spent seven years as an assistant coach with the Vikings.

While coaching the men, Morton has compiled a record of 288-149-2, including an 11-4 record this past year. His successful tenure includes 14 Penn-Ohio Championships, a pair of Midwestern Collegiate Conference (MCC) titles, a Horizon League Championship and an astounding 28 seasons with a .500 or better record. In his coaching career, Morton has led five athletes to qualify for the NCAA Championships, including three appearances by 2009 All-American Jakub Dobies. Last season the men set four Cleveland State records (three individual and one relay) en route to a second place finish at the Horizon League Championships.

Over the last six years, Morton has also turned the women's program into a contender, including a 12-3 season in 2011-12, those 12 wins gave Morton his third straight season with double digit wins for the women. Morton has led the men to a record of 123-40-1 over the past 12 seasons, and the women to a record of 49-21 over the last four seasons.

The 2005-06 Horizon League Coach of the Year, Morton led the Viking men to back-to-back MCC titles in 1998 and 1999 and was named the MCC Coach of the Year in 1997 and 1999. He was also named the Coach of the Year of the Penn-Ohio Conference six times, including a stretch of three straight seasons from 1984-86.

Morton's success on the pool deck is affirmed by the number of successful athletes he has coached during his career at CSU. He has led countless swimmers to the United States Senior Swimming Nationals and five to the NCAA Championships. His success has also translated internationally with Nedim Nisic competing in the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing, China. Two other CSU swimmers under Morton's direction have gone on to be Olympic Trials finalists and the Vikings got their first All-American in school history in Dobies in 2009. In 2010, both Dobies and Mark deSwardt earned Mid-Major All-American Honorable Mention accolades.

Morton joined the CSU staff in 1974 as the Aquatic Director of the brand-new Cleveland State University Natatorium while also serving as an assistant coach with the men's swim team. Following the retirement of coaching legend Bob Busbey in 1981, Morton was named the head coach and has since brought regional and national prominence to the Vikings. In addition to coaching, Morton has been extensively involved in event management for 38 national and international aquatic events as the University's Aquatics Director and has overseen four NCAA Division I Championships and many regional and international competitions hosted by Cleveland State.

Due to his vast experience in coaching and hosting championship swimming events, Morton has become a well-known face in the swimming world, allowing for international recruiting. During his tenure, he has successfully recruited athletes from a number of countries including Australia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Croatia, Canada, England, Germany, Ireland, New Zealand, Norway, Panama, Poland, Portugal, Russia, Serbia and Montenegro, South Africa, Spain and Sweden.

A 1970 Miami (Ohio) graduate, Morton was a member of back-to-back Mid-American Conference Championship swim teams in 1966 and 1967.

The winningest coach in Cleveland State swimming history, Morton credits his successful coaching career to two great influences: Tom Patton of the Dover, Ohio YMCA and former USA Olympic coach Busbey, who Morton had the privilege to serve under for his first seven years with the Vikings. In addition to his duties with the swim teams, Morton is also a faculty member in the Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance Department at CSU. Morton and his wife, Carol, a professor at Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio, have one son, Robert. They reside in Strongsville, Ohio.

RICH KARBAN

DIVING COACH // NINTH SEASON

Since taking over CSU's Head Diving Coach position in 2003, Rich Karban has had tremendous amounts of success. He is not only viewed as one of the top coaches in Cleveland State's history, but also the entire Horizon League because of that success. Karban has earned Horizon League Diving Coach of the Year honors six times, including last season.

Last year, for the seventh time in the last eight seasons under Karban, a Viking earned league Diver of the Meet honors when Kacey Cummings claimed the title. Josh Gonzalez was recognized in 2010; Dan Baiko took the top honor in both the one- and three-meter events in 2008; Chris Dalman won both the one- and three-meter titles in 2007 and the one-meter in 2006; Thatcher Carr won the three-meter in 2006, as well as both the one-meter and three-meter titles in 2005; and Chris Jones claimed the one-meter title and finished second in the three-meter in 2004. Dalman was also coached to an 18th place finish in the one-meter diving event and 20th place finish in the three-meter diving event at the 2007 NCAA Championships while under Karban.

During the early 1980's, Karban had a very successful diving career at Cleveland State. In 2000, he became just the second diver and the fourth member of the swimming and diving team to be voted into the Cleveland State Athletics Hall of Fame.

Karban also became the first CSU diver and just the second swimming and diving team member to win an Eastern Intercollegiate Championship, claiming the three-meter title in 1984. During each of his four seasons on the team, he also helped the Vikings to a team title at the Penn-Ohio Championships. His career culminated in 1984 after being named the team's most outstanding athlete and qualifying for zones.

Karban spent three years with CSU from 1984-1987 before leaving to work with Olympic diving coach Ron O'Brien. He spent the first two seasons as an assistant and was the head diving coach for the Vikings for the 1986-87 season. Karban then coached the diving team at Eastern Michigan from 1989-94, earning the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year honor in 1992. He also coached his U.S. Diving Junior Olympic Club to a fifth-place finish at the national championships in 1990.

Karban and his wife, Betsy, were married in 1988 and have two children, Rich and Elyssa.



KEVIN RAPIEN

HEAD ASSISTANT COACH // FIRST SEASON

Rapien will be a member of the Cleveland State Vikings coaching staff for the first time in 2012-13.

As a coach, he spent the last two seasons as the Head Assistant Swim Coach at the University of North Dakota. While at North Dakota Rapien was the Distance Coach as well as Recruiting Coordinator for the program. In 2011-12 he coached three NCAA Division I B standards and helped swimmers break three school distance records.

Prior to working at the University of North Dakota, Rapien spent one season as an Assistant Swim Coach at Delta State University. While at Delta State he was the Sprint Group Coach, helping guide 18 student athletes to the NCAA Division II Championships.

As a swimmer, Rapien was a four-time letter winner and team captain from 2005-2007 at Ashland University for the Eagles.



BAILEY NENNIG

ASSISTANT COACH // FIRST SEASON

Nennig will be joining the Vikings' staff for the first time in 2012-13 as the Assistant Swim Coach.

Nennig is familiar with the Horizon League as she was a four-year letter winner swimming for the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee swimming both IM and breaststroke. Not only was she an All-League performer as a junior, she was also named a team captain as a senior.

Since joining the Vikings in August Nennig has spent time working with both dry land and swimming workouts, as well as working with the strength coach and helping with recruiting and other administrative duties.

In the coaching ranks prior to CSU, Nennig spent time working as both an Aquatic Director and high school swim coach in her native state of Wisconsin.





ALEX COHARA

Cohara swam a variety of events for CSU doing everything from 100 yards to 1,650...Cohara had the team's fourth best 100 freestyle time (48.31), fourth best time in the 500 freestyle (4:44.47), third best time in the 1,000 freestyle (9:38.25), third best time in the 1,650 freestyle time (16:17.54) and fourth best time in the 400 IM (4:05.31)...Finished 10th in the Horizon League Championships in the 1,000 Freestyle, 11th in the 1,650 freestyle and 11th in the 400 IM.

2010-11 // SOPHOMORE SEASON

Set new personal bests in the 400 IM (4:05.35), 1,000 free (9:39.92) and 1,650 free (16:20.64) at the Horizon League Championships...finished eighth at the league meet in the 400 IM...was ninth in the 1,000 free...finished 11th in the 1,650 free...also swam personal best 100 free (48.67) at the TYR Invitational...fifth on the team in the 500 free (4:45.23), third on the roster in the 1,000 free and fourth in the 1,650 free...new quickest time in 200 IM (1:58.32) against Notre Dame College...shaved almost 17 seconds off his 400 IM when compared to his best time as a freshman...also cut 22 seconds from his 1,000 free and 11 seconds from his 1,650 free from 2009-10 to 2010-11.

2009-10 // FRESHMAN SEASON

Swam the team's fourth fastest 500 free (4:40.50), fifth fastest 1,000 free (10:02.18), fourth fastest 1,650 free (16:31.60), fifth fastest 400 individual medley (4:22.12) and fifth fastest 200 breast (2:20.87)...set personal records during the season in the 100 free, 500 free, 1,000 free, 1,650 free, 200 back, 200 breast, 50 fly, 100 fly and 200 IM...consistently improved his time in the 200 free, culminating with a season best 1:43.05 performance at the Horizon League Championship.

2009 USA Swimming Scholastic High School All-American...four-year letterwinner in swimming...all-time high point holder at St. Edward High...placed first at sectionals and districts in the 200 and 500 free in 2009...set records in the 200 and 500 free during sectional competition...designated as co-captain as a senior.

2010-11 // JUNIOR SEASON

2010-11 Horizon League 'Swimmer of the Year'...continued his streak of perfection at the Horizon League Championships, winning three events to improve his record at the Horizon League Championships to 9-0...took first in the 500 free (4:24.95), the 1,000 free (9:06.34) and 1,650 free (15:23.93) to earn 'Co-Performer of the Meet'... qualified for the finals at the USA Swimming National Championships in the 1,650 free...went undefeated in four league dual meets...had top times in the Horizon League in the 400 IM (4:00.89), 500 free (4:24.95), 1,000 free (9:06.34) and 1,650 free (15:23.90)...swam third fastest 200 IM (1:52.99) on the Viking team, a time that was also a new personal best after not swimming the event as a sophomore...his 500 free was five seconds faster at the end of the 2010-11 than it was at the end of his sophomore season... earned league 'Swimmer of the Week' honors twice...honorable mention Mid-Major All-American by CollegeSwimming.com.

2009-10 // SOPHOMORE SEASON

Won 21 races, including the 500 free six times, the 1,000 free seven times, the 1,650 free twice, the 200 fly four times and the 400 IM twice...set three personal records in the 200 fly (1:49.12), 200 breast (2:11.50) and 400 IM (3:53.91)...finished with his best times in the 1,650 free and 400 IM at the Horizon League Championship while winning both events...also won the 1,000 free.

2008-09 // FRESHMAN SEASON

Became one of the best distance swimmers in CSU and Horizon League history after just one year with the program...won 32 races, including 11 wins in the 1,000 free and 10 wins in the 500 free...won all three of his individual swims at the Horizon League Championships with titles in the 500 free (4:26.00), 1,000 free (9:08.01) and 1,650 free (15:02.06, NCAA "B" cut) and was unanimously selected as the league's Swimmer of the Meet, Swimmer of the Year and Newcomer of the Year after leading the meet in points scored (60)...both the 1,000 and 1,650 times were league and CSU records...swam the team's fastest 500 free and the second-fastest time in school history (4:26.00) on Feb. 26...team's fastest and the second-fastest time in school history in the 400 IM (3:57.41) on Feb. 6...swam fourth-fastest time in school history and team's fastest time in the 200 fly (1:50.16) on Feb. 7...swam team's fastest time of the season and the fifth-fastest time in school history in the 200 free (1:40.08) on Dec. 5...five-time Horizon League Athlete of the Week.



STREAKING

The 2011-12 season was another strong one in the long line of winning tradition for the Cleveland State men's swimming program. The group finished the year with an 11-4 dual meet record, the program's 11th straight season with 10 or more wins.

SECOND AT THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIPS

On top of the 11 dual wins, the team also ended the season with a second place finish at the Horizon League Swimming and Diving Championships. That was the third straight year that the team finished in the top three at the league championships.

AT THE INVITES

The Vikings showed well in invitationals all season long, finishing no lower than third in any of their four invitationals on the season. Not only did they have the second place league championship result, but also a first place finish at the Bob Mowerson Sprint Meet, a third place finish at the Northwestern TYR Invitational, and a third place finish to open the season at the Michigan State Long Course Invitational.

RECORD BREAKERS

Last season was a great one not only for the team as a whole, but especially for multiple swimmers on an individual basis. Four Vikings broke school records in 2011-12, three in an individual race, and one group in a record breaking relay. Individually junior Berry Thompson broke the 100 freestyle record in 43.33, sophomore Alex Lewis broke the 100 butterfly record in 48.28, and sophomore Justin Kermack broke the record in the 200 butterfly in 1:47.30. On the relay side junior Justin Hill and freshman Nathan Grant joined Thompson and Lewis to help break the school's 400 freestyle relay record in 2:58.42. All four of those records were broken at the Horizon League Championships.

YOUNG SWIMMERS TAKING THE LEAD

The Cleveland State men's swimming team had a large number of successful swimmers that were younger swimmers in 2011-12. Looking at the 17 individual swimming events last season, none of the top times were held by graduating seniors in 2011-12. In fact, only one senior was even in the top two in any individual event (Pieter Ritz in the 1,000 freestyle and 1,650 freestyle).

SCHOLAR ALL-AMERICAN

Justin Kermack was honored last season, named as an Honorable Mention Scholar All-American. The Honorable Mention Scholar All-American award is presented to college and university swimmers and divers, who have achieved a grade point average of 3.5 or higher, for the semester or cumulative average, and have achieved a "B" time standard, but have not qualified to compete in their respective national championship.

MID-MAJOR ALL-AMERICANS

Juniors Justin Hill and Berry Thompson joined sophomores Alex Lewis and Justin Kermack in being named as Mid-Major Honorable Mention All-Americans.

THOMPSON AND HILL MAKE "LAST DITCH" EFFORT

Both Berry Thompson and Justin Hill qualified for the Last Ditch Qualifier in 2011-12. That is the final meet of the year following the league championships to give swimmers one last chance to earn a spot in the NCAA Championships. Hill ended the meet swimming a 20.24 in the 50 free, with Thompson swimming a 43.96 in the 100 free, both just shy of qualifying for the NCAA Championships.

GONZALEZ MAKES ZONE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Senior Josh Gonzalez represented Cleveland State at the NCAA Zone 'C' Diving Championships hosted by Indiana University. Gonzalez joined other qualified NCAA Division I divers from the states of Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan and Ohio who were competing for a chance to advance to the NCAA Championships. He finished the meet 34th on the one-meter board with a total of 255.80 and he placed 47th in the three-meter diving event with a score of 225.10.

2012 WOMEN'S SEASON REVIEW

THE VIKING WOMEN HAVE POSTED THREE STRAIGHT DOUBLE-DIGIT WIN SEASONS

THREE STRAIGHT

Although the Vikings swimming and diving team has only been working with Head Coach Wally Morton for five seasons, they have already become a dominant program in the swimming circles. The squad has posted three straight double-digit win seasons and combined for 41 wins in the last three years.

SCHOLAR ALL-AMERICANS

Cleveland State was outstanding not only in the pool last season, but strong in the classroom as well. Four CSU women swimmers were honored as Honorable Mention Scholar All-Americans by the College Swimming Coaches Association of America. Those four swimmers were Carys Behn, Alexandra Johansson, Joanna Olsson and Alice Sommerville.

The Honorable Mention Scholar All-American award is presented to college and university swimmers and divers, who have achieved a grade point average of 3.5 or higher, for the semester or cumulative average, and have achieved a "B" time standard, but have not qualified to compete in their respective national championship.

ALL-AMERICAN TEAM SCHOLARS

The women's swimming and diving team earned the Team Scholar All-America Award from the College Swimming Coaches Association of America for 2011-12. The team finished the year with a 3.31 GPA

The Team Scholar All-American award is presented to college and university swimming and diving teams who have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher. The award is presented to teams achieving this standard in the fall semester and in the semester of the NCAA Swimming and Diving Championships (Winter/Spring).

SECOND IN THE HORIZON LEAGUE

The Cleveland State women's team finished second at the Horizon League Championships in 2011-12, behind only Milwaukee. The second place finish was the highest league championship finish in program history. The team won eight events and three relays at the league championships, and also had the Diver of the Year in Kacey Cummings.

RECORD BREAKERS

The Vikings had another record-breaking season in 2011-12 as the swimmers broke school records in 11 of 17 individual events, with all four relay teams also breaking school records. There was also one diving record broken of the two diving events. School records were broken in the 50 free, 1,650 free, 50 butterfly, 100 butterfly, 200 butterfly, 100 back, 200 back, 100 breast, 200 breast, 200 IM, 400 IM, 200 free relay, 400 free relay, 800 free relay, 200 medley relay, 400 medley relay, and 3-meter diving.

Not only did Vikings swimmers break a variety of school records, they broke Horizon League records as well. Joanna Olsson broke the Horizon League record in the 400 IM with a time of 4:19.57. Alice Sommerville, Carys Behn, Christine Kopacko and Alexandra Johansson also broke the Horizon League record in the 200 freestyle relay with a time of 1:31.18.

CUMMINGS RECOGNIZED

Senior diver Kacey Cummings was recognized in the Horizon League as the "Diver of the Year" in 2011-12. Cummings also qualified for NCAA Zone 'C' Diving Championships hosted by Indiana University following the Horizon League Championships. She joined other qualified NCAA Division I divers from the states of Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan and Ohio who were competing for a chance to advance to the NCAA Championships.





THE ROBERT F. BUSBEY NATATORIUM



For over 35 years, Cleveland State's natatorium has earned its place among the elite swimming facilities in the United States and has enjoyed a rich history of championships and outstanding swimmers. A new chapter in that history was written in the fall of 1999 when the facility was officially dedicated as The Robert F. Busbey Natatorium after CSU's long-time swimming coach and athletic director, Bob Busbey. Despite all the prestige, however, the one part of the natatorium that has continued to stand out over the years is how advanced the pool's design is when compared to others around the country.

When it opened in 1973 as the CSU Natatorium, it was considered special simply because it was one of only two university indoor pools in the state of Ohio that was 50 meters in length. Since there were not many other pools like it in the country, it received immediate notice from the rest of the swimming community.

However, there were other aspects of the pool that made it unusual. The one feature that immediately stood out was the pool's large gutters, which made it extremely fast compared to those of other schools. In March of 1975, the NCAA decided to examine the theory itself when it scheduled the NCAA Division I and II Championships in Cleveland for the very first time. Over the course of consecutive weekends, the NCAA came to the conclusion that the Busbey Natatorium was one of a kind.

Following this historic meet, the NCAA gave in to the demands of swimmers and coaches alike and decided to return the championship meet to Cleveland State. When the 1977 Division I Championships were completed, there was no doubt left as to which pool was superior in the United States. The meet featured

the shattering of sixteen NCAA records; a mark that still stands today. In fact, the 1977 finals were later termed as "The greatest swimmers in the fastest pool at the greatest meet in history" by none other than the NCAA itself.

Two years later, the meet returned to Cleveland, and, after a five year lapse, it was back again for a fourth time in 1984 to sellout crowds yet again. Since that time, the pool has been an eleven-time host site of the Eastern

Intercollegiate Championships and hosted the Penn-Ohio Conference Championships a staggering 17 times.

The natatorium has been the site of championships of all shapes and sizes during its history, including six Horizon League Championships. What may stand out the most is the variety of the 16 national aquatic championships that have been held at Cleveland State. These events include United States international diving meets, AAU and YMCA national championships, the National Water Polo Championships and the World Swimming Games for the Deaf.

The natatorium has remained dear to the hearts of United States swimmers as it has been used by the 1976 United States Olympic Swimming and Diving Teams, the 1980 Olympic Diving Team and the 1984 Olympic Swim Team for their practices. The pool has even witnessed record-breaking performances by United States gold medal winners Tom Jager, Matt Biondi, Greg Louganis and Pablo Morales. In addition, the October 22, 2002 issue of Sports Illustrated ranked the Busbey Natatorium the sixth fastest pool in America.

The structure of the Busbey Natatorium itself is even unique. The fact that an incredible 933,000 gallons of water are needed to fill the pool is unusual. The natatorium measures 50 meters in length (with nine eight-foot competitive lanes) by 25 yards wide (with 23 seven-foot competitive lanes) with racing lanes measuring 12 to 16-1/2 feet deep. Below the surface, the pool features underwater speakers and six underwater windows which provide the CSU staff with an excellent coaching tool.

Also, the pool utilizes an automatic touchpad timing system for up to ten lanes during meets. In terms of diving competitions, the natatorium includes two one-meter maxiflex boards, two three-meter maxiflex boards, and a diving tower with platforms at 5, 7-1/2, and 10 meters.

The pool's uniqueness is not limited to simply the main pool itself. The south stands feature a 25-yard instructional pool which is also very useful as a warm up/cool down pool for competitions.

In ceremonies held on October 2, 1999, the 1,500-seat CSU Natatorium was officially renamed The Robert F. Busbey Natatorium, in honor of long-

time swimming coach and athletic director, Robert Busbey. Over a span of nearly a half-century, beginning with his enrollment at Fenn College in 1946, Busbey impacted the University's sports program as only a special few men have at any collegiate institution.

As a four-sport athlete, Busbey was Fenn's first All-American, gaining national prominence by winning that honor as a swimmer in both 1948 and 1949 and failing by the tiniest margin for a spot on the U.S. Olympic team in 1950. He went on to serve as head coach of his alma mater for 30 years. During his coaching tenure, he was named assistant coach for the 1964 U.S. Olympic Team, served as chairman of the NCAA Swimming Committee and was responsible for bringing five NCAA Championships to CSU.

For his accomplishments, Busbey was honored with the 1982 National Collegiate & Scholastic Swimming Trophy, one of the sport's highest awards.

In 1966, Busbey succeeded Homer E. Woodling as Cleveland State's Director of Athletics. Over a span of 24 years in that position, he developed a flourishing program and became a prime force in the planning and building of CSU's athletic facilities, including Krenzler Field, the CSU Convocation Center and the Physical Education Building.

Unanimously voted a charter member of the CSU Athletic Hall of Fame when it opened in 1975, Busbey became Associate Vice President for Athletic Affairs in 1990 and continued to serve his alma mater until his retirement in 1994.

For all its special features and the amount of events it has hosted in its 32 years, the natatorium truly enjoys one of the most fascinating histories of any aquatic facility in the United States.
