## Mark Covert Classic

Cal State Fullerton's annual season-opening cross country meet at Carbon Canyon Park in Brea, Calif., was renamed the Mark Covert Classic in 2012, in honor of legendary distance runner and Cal State Fullerton graduate Mark Covert.

Covert won the NCAA College Division individual championship in 1970 and led the Titans to the NCAA team title in 1971. He also went on to run in the U.S. Olympic marathon trials in 1972 and became the first runner to cross a cross country trial/meet finish line wearing the famous waffle iron Nike shoes (1972).

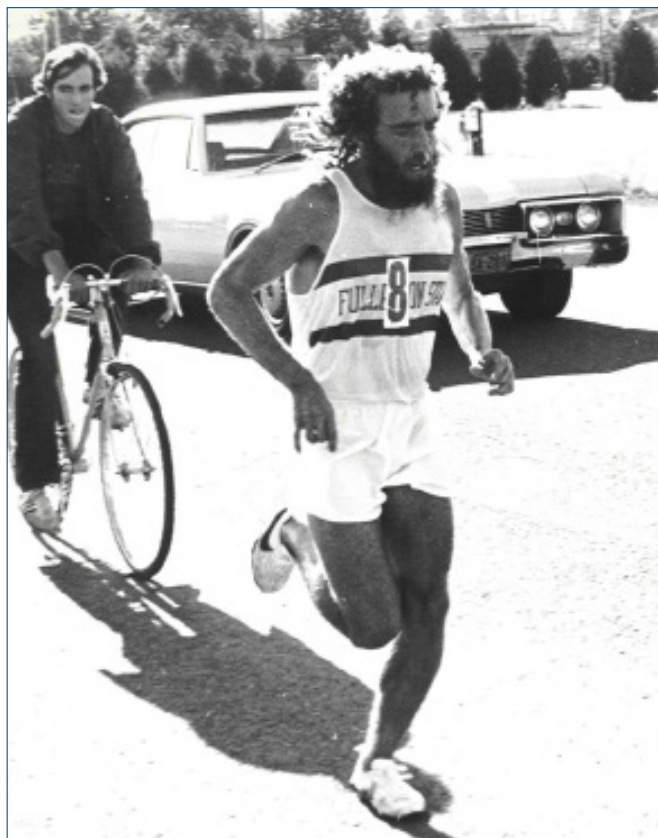
However, Covert is most famous for holding the American record for most consecutive days running at least a mile. Starting on July 23, 1968 and ending 45 years later on July 23, 2013, Covert ran at least one mile every day. The streak, which lasted 16,437 days, covered more than 151,000 miles, and is recorded as second longest running streak in the world, according to United States Running Streak Association and Streak Runners International.

Covert earned All-America status seven times during his career. He graduated from Burbank High School in 1968, received his bachelor's degree at Cal State Fullerton in 1973, and his master's degree from Cal Lutheran University in 1979. For the past 24 years he has been the track and field coach at Antelope Valley College in Lancaster, Calif. Prior to his time at Antelope Valley College, he had previous coaching stints at Glendale College (1974), L.A. Valley College (1976-83) and L.A. Trade Tech (1983-85).

Covert has been enshrined in the Cal State Fullerton Athletics, Mt. San Antonio College Cross Country, L.A. Valley College, NCAA Div. II Cross Country and Nike Halls of Fame. The meet was previously called the Fullerton Season Opener and typically draws more than 40 teams and more than 500 runners.

When the streak began:

- At the time, the Boston Marathon was still a small race for fast runners, with only 1,152 participants in 1969. The New York City Marathon started in 1970 with 127 runners.
- In the summer of '68, the U.S. was deeply entrenched in the Vietnam War.
- The Beatles were back in the studio working on the record that would become known as "The White Album".
- Neil Armstrong was a year away from becoming the first man to set foot on the moon.
- The last time Covert took a day off from running Lyndon Johnson was president and Mickey Mantle was struggling through his final summer with the New York Yankees.

Capping a remarkable season, the Titans bested 59 other colleges among over 450 runners to clinch the crown as the National Athletic Association (NCAA) Division II cross country champions in 1971. Cal State Fullerton was pioneered by four top-10 finishes following the 5-mile race at the Chicago Golf Club in Wheaton, Ill., on Nov. 13.

The Titans scored 47 points to garner the title, well ahead of runner-up South Dakota who tallied a score of 81.

Tim Tubb led the way for the Titan contingent, finishing second overall with a team-best mark of 24:34. Mark Covert crossed the line just four seconds behind, chalking up a third place finish in 24:38. John Casso became the third Fullerton runner to finish in the top-five, concluding the event in 24:48. Chris Hoffman (24:57) rounded out the Fullerton top-10 finishes with a ninth place showing. Dave White (40th), Doug Schmenk (90th) and Jim McGuire (125th) completed the Titan participants.

Fullerton nabbed victories at the Sacramento Invitational, Long Beach Invitational and Chapman Invitational en route to its first NCAA championship in program history.
