AGFINANCIAL ARENA

Evangel University broke ground on the 70,000-square-foot AGFinancial Arena on October 28, 2023. The state-of-the-art sports complex will host the university's basketball, volleyball, football, and soccer programs.

The arena portion of the facility is 40,000 square feet and will include a home-game court and two full cross courts for practices and tournaments, a VIP lounge and box suites, a concourse with concessions and gathering spaces, support and staffing offices, locker rooms, and meeting rooms. Seating capacity is expected to be around 1,300.

The Randy Rowden Training Facility will occupy 30,000 square feet on the south side of the Valor Center, and will include VIP box seating overlooking the north end zone of Coryell Field. The facility will house Evangel's football and soccer programs, as well as athletic director's offices and operations. It will also include a state-of-the-art strength training room, athletic medicine hub, and a 2,500-square-foot multipurpose room for campus events and meetings.

AGFinancial Arena's south entrance plaza will serve as a student venue for pre- and post-game gatherings, and additional parking for the venue will be developed near its north entrance.

AGFinancial Arena, including the Randy Rowden Training Facility, are two major projects included in Evangel's Here. Now. campaign, a \$24 million fundraising effort launched this summer. Other projects include the complete remodel of Walther Hall dormitory and the installation of an artificial turf lighted intramural field.

Collectively, these projects represent the first major building effort on Evangel's campus since the construction of the Ralph M. Riggs Administration Building in 2009.

EVANGEL SPORTS NETWORK

Evangel Athletics has built an internal network to stream more than 90 home events yearly since 2016-17. The athletic department has spearheaded the effort that partners with local professional talent and Evangel students to produce nearly every game. Evangel Athletics manages all aspects of radio, television, and digital rights.

Since 2019 the Evangel University Athletics Department has partnered with Mediacom to produce several home games that are simulcast on the Evangel Sports Network and the KCAC Conference Network platforms. MC22 produces and helps air a number of football, volleyball, basketball, baseball, and softball games each year.

KCAC CONFERENCE NETWORK

The KCAC Network is the official digital network of the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference. It will encompass all original programming from the KCAC.

The KCAC Network is available on your desktop and mobile/tablet devices. The official website of the KCAC Network is www.kcacnetwork.com, while the KCAC app is available for iOS in the App Store and Android on Google Play. Mobile devices, including iPhones, iPad, and Android, will work with the default web browser.

Devices should be kept up to date and connected to a reliable data connection for optimal playback. Apple users and owners of an AppleTV device can 'throw' the webcast from their iPhone or iPad using the AirPlay feature. Computer users can output their display directly to an HDMI signal if supported; otherwise, a converter may be required. These options may require advance setup, and we suggest using an 'On Demand' archive to test prior to watching a live event.

ADDITIONAL MEDIA COVERAGE

Evangel teams enjoy media coverage both locally, regionally, and nationally. In addition to appearing live on regional TV.

Local media coverage of Evangel also includes regular coverage on local television stations KY3 (NBC Affiliate) and KOLR 10 (CBS Affiliate). Local radio stations also provide coverage, including coaches' interviews weekly with Zimmer Communications Jock 96.9 FM station, an ESPN Radio affiliate.

HEAD COACH | 4TH SEASON | EVANGEL '05

Bert CAPEL

Head Coach Bert Capel enters his fourth season at the helm of the Valor Men's Basketball team in the 2024-25 season.

Capel has enjoyed success in his first three seasons, leading the team to a trio of national tournament appearances, the first time making it to the national tournament in three consecutive years since the six year postseason run from 2009-15.

Last season, Capel led the Valor to their farthest finish since the 2002 national championship season, helping push the Valor to an Elite Eight finish where they fell to the number-one overall seed, Grace, by a slim margin, after a cinderella run as a 15-seed.

A member of Evangel's 2002 NAIA National Championship team during his standout playing career, Capel is the eighth head coach in the 67-year history of the EU men's basketball program after being selected to replace Hall of Famer Steve Jenkins, who announced his retirement after 39

years at the helm.

Capel brings a wealth of coaching experience from multiple levels to the Evangel staff, including a total of six seasons spanning two separate stints on Jenkins' bench. Prior to his return to EU in 2019, Capel spent nine seasons at the NCAA Division I level on the coaching staffs at Florida State and Stetson, in addition to one year as an assistant coach at the junior college level with Jacksonville College.

From 2019-21, Capel played a pivotal role in elevating Evangel's on-court success, including helping EU post a 10-win turnaround in 2019-20, marking its best single-season win improvement in 14 years. Evangel also earned its first postseason berth in five years in 2020, before garnering votes in the NAIA's Top 25 poll for the first time since 2015.

Prior to returning to Springfield, Capel spent six seasons as a full-time Division I assistant at Stetson, where he helped lead the Hatters to improved win totals in four of his first five seasons, as well as their first Atlantic Sun Conference Championship game appearance in 2016. He also helped coordinate Stetson's recruiting efforts, pre-and-postseason individual workouts and conditioning programs

and managed the Hatters' summer camps.

Capel made the move to Stetson after serving as an assistant coach at Jacksonville (Texas) College for the 2012-13 season. Prior to joining the Jaguars staff, Capel was a graduate assistant (2009-11) and the recruiting assistant (2011-12) at Florida State for a total of three seasons. During his time at FSU, he was a part of the school's first ACC Tournament championship and three-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the Sweet 16 in 2011.

Capel began his coaching career at Evangel in 2005, joining Jenkins' staff as an assistant. EU posted four-straight 20-win seasons, appeared regularly in the NAIA Top 25 poll and made two NAIA National Tournament trips, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2008.

As a player for EU from 2000-04, Capel helped usher in perhaps the most successful periods in program history as part of a banner career that saw the Kentucky native earn All-Heart Conference honors. In all, he scored 1,060 points and grabbed 456 rebounds to help EU claim two regular-season Heart titles. Most notably, he was a member of

Evangel's 2002 national championship team that finished 35-1 and was consistently the NAIA's top-ranked squad throughout the season.

A graduate of Heritage Academy in Florence, Ky., Capel was inducted into the Northern Kentucky Sports Hall of Fame in 2012 for his accomplishments in both basketball and baseball. He earned his Bachelor of Science from Evangel in 2005, a Master of Arts at Evangel in 2008, and a Master of Science from Florida State in 2011.

Capel and his wife, Stacy—a former Evangel volleyball student-athlete and a 2005 EU alumna—are the parents of two daughters, Myla and Kinzli, and one son, Dru.

First-year Evangel men's basketball coach Bert Capel wasted little time in selecting the first member of his coaching staff, announcing the addition of **Jackson Capel** as assistant coach in April 2021.

"I'm excited that Jackson will be joining our staff, working alongside me to continue the tradition of excellence here at Evangel," Bert Capel said. "He's already had a significant impact on this program as a player, and I look forward to having him share his passion for EU with our student-athletes."

Jackson Capel, the younger brother of the new EU head coach, returns to his alma mater where he was a three-time NAIA All-American and remains the program's all-time leading scorer (2,337). A four-time All-Heart of America Athletic Conference selection, he still holds several Evangel records, including most three-pointers in a game, single-season, and career.

After earning his degree from EU, he played professionally for nine seasons in Spain, Germany, and Switzerland. He was part of a championship team in the Spanish LEB Gold League during the 2016-17 season and was named to Eurobasket.com all-league teams in Germany and Switzerland.

Most recently, he served as an assistant coach at NCAA Division II member Palm Beach Atlantic University during an abbreviated 2020-21 season.

Before heading to PBA, Capel spent two seasons as an assistant at Indiana University-East, where the Red Wolves went 23-10 and 26-9 with back-to-back trips to the NAIA National Tournament. Prior to his time at IU-East, he coached one season at Cincinnati Christian in the River States Conference.

Capel has also been inducted into the Evangel Hall of Fame (2020) and the Northern Kentucky Sports Hall of Fame (2019). He graduated from Evangel in 2009 with a degree in business management and earned his master's degree from the University of the Cumberland in 2020.



MIXING IT UP

**VALOR LOOK TO BUILD CHEMISTRY WITH
MIX OF RETURNERS AND NEWCOMERS IN 2024-25**



Since becoming the head coach of the Valor Men's Basketball team back in 2021, Bert Capel has brought a trio of winning seasons to the program, as he looks to continue that trend with his youngest group in 2024-25.

After pushing his teams to three consecutive postseason appearances, including a Cinderella run last season and an NAIA Elite Eight finish, the highest in Evangel history since the 2002 national championship, Coach Capel has successfully taken the reigns from legendary head coach Steve Jenkins. The Valor finished 21-11 last season, their first year in the KCAC, and although it was the least amount of wins for a Capel-coached squad, they also finished the highest out of all of his teams.

The departure of Josh Pritchett, former NAIA All-American, as well as Bryce Hunt, Jace Coffie, and Broc Smith will play a factor in the upcoming season. When asked about the transition from last year to this year, head coach Bert Capel stated, "I feel like this year will be a lot different than in the past, mainly because we

lost quite a few guys who were here when I first started." Evangel returns eight players who earned time last season, including starters Manrique Alvarado, Garrett Davault, Stephen Salvi, and Josh Mason. Alvarado, a senior from Costa Rica, averaged 8.4 points and 3.4 assists per game from the point guard spot, while Davault, a junior from Norwood, Mo., was Evangel's second leading scorer (15.4) and pulled down 4.2 rebounds per game. Seniors Salvi and Mason both played well from the guard position, with Mason averaging 10.4 ppg and Salvi averaging 4.7 ppg.

Also returning this season after earning time last year is Carson Cavalier, a senior from Waynesville, Missouri. The three point specialist made a huge impact late last season, leading Evangel in scoring against Grace College, hitting seven in the elite eight matchup. The stretch big, Logan Rodgers, returns for his last season. The Ohio native competed in 30 games. Defensively, Ty Campbell returns and looks to make his mark and earn more playing time. Other returners who will look to earn time are Jarren Harrell, Kaleb Wofford, Troy

Peitzman, and Ty Lyon.

After sitting out last season as redshirts, Harrison Doennig (Kickapoo), Isaac Wootton (Edmund, Okla.), Cole Griesemer (Hillcrest), Cade Sutton (Bunker) and Luke Foster (Rolla), all will make a big impact for the Valor squad. "Doennig and Foster both bring size in the paint for us, which we will need after losing two huge pieces (Hunt/Coffie) to graduation last year," head coach Capel stated. "Wootton is one of those players who will be really, really good and is looking to put it all together. Sutton is a long, athletic guard who can jump out of the gym, and Griesemer is the same, both hard workers and guys who want to make an impact."

Joining the Valor as transfers this year is Kent Carroll (Tabor), Dane Foster (Lincoln Land CC), and Bryce Ware (Jacksonville College). All three will play guard roles and look to provide needs offensive sparks off the bench for Evangel. Redshirt newcomers for the season include Kit Zervas (Link Year), Gentry Lawton (Wylie, Texas), and local products Akarius Staten-Ballance (Hillcrest) and Joe Graves (Ozark, Mo.).



Senior **Manrique Alvarado** averaged 8.4 points per game last season, while eclipsing triple digit assist numbers (110).



Junior **Garrett Davault** returns to the Valor looking to continue his strong offensive numbers, averaging 13.7 points per game last season and 4.2 rebounds.

Evangel was able to close out decades of history on a high note last season, earning a win in their final game in the historic Ashcroft Center, 80-74, over nationally ranked #4 Oklahoma Wesleyan. The Valor will now compete in the roughly 23 million dollar AGFinancial Arena, a massive upgrade from the smaller facility Evangel previously played in. "It's an incredible facility. Recruiting wise, we hope it helps us and gives us an edge, but ultimately I think our fans will love it and I'm excited for the community to show up and watch games in a building with air conditioning! ."

Evangel was picked to finish fourth in the KCAC Coaches Preseason Poll. When asked about the rating, Capel stated "I had a feeling we would finish around there, after losing the key players that we did. We have a little bit of proving to do this season and at the end of the day, it's fun and cool to see where people think you are but all that matters is how you play at the end of the season."

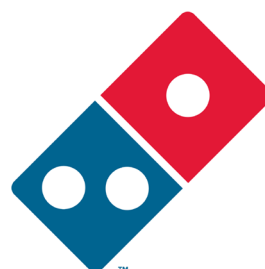

When asked about what Coach Capel wants Evangel Men's Basketball to be known for, he stated, "I want other teams to see Evangel on their schedule and know that they're a hard nose team that will get after you. I want our opponents to know that we are a team that's tough and that plays together and that every game is going to be a battle."

The Valor will open their season on November 1st, at home against Mission University. Evangel opens their conference slate on November 16th, also at home, against Friends.

doctoral studies in management.

organization Empowered21, where he serves as liaison to Spirit-empowered scholars.
