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GENERAL INFORMATION

North Carolina Wesleyan has joined many small colleges and universities across the nation by compiling a complete record of its intercollegiate athletic teams. The contents for this publication were initially compiled in July of 2006 by the NCWU Sports Information Office.

This book contains records of the Bishops' 18 current varsity sports: baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, football, men's golf, women's lacrosse, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's track & field, and volleyball.

With the help of North Carolina Wesleyan alumni and sports fans, we hope to continue this research and add to this publication annually. We ask that you will forward to the NCWU Sports Information Office any records or corrections you may have.

THE BATTLING BISHOP MASCOT

To help spread the Methodism Church, John Wesley (the father of the Methodist Church) put together a plan that enlisted preachers who traveled to different communities to spread the Word of God. Their trips, also known as circuits, helped to lay the foundation for the Methodist Church, especially in the South. Circuit Riders were servants of God who accepted a very difficult and dangerous task. They rode on horseback and labored against the forces of Mother Nature, often through the night. The Riders traveled famously light, carrying only their Bible and small amounts of food, and earned very little money.

Francis Asbury (1745-1816) was the founding bishop of American Methodism. Traveling his circuits, he trekked over 270,000 miles and preached over 16,000 sermons. Like Asbury, the Circuit Rider that represents Wesleyan could indeed be considered a "Battling Bishop." The Rider is symbolic of the values of the College, the Methodist Church, and servitude to God.

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HALL OF FAME

Since 1999, North Carolina Wesleyan has honored 70 former athletes, administrators, coaches and/or teams by enshrining them in its Athletics Hall of Fame. These individuals have created a higher standard for Bishop athletics, and each year, new inductees are selected based on their accomplishments. Those selected are inducted each fall during Homecoming festivities.

HALL OF FAMER WALLACE JOHNSON

Wallace Johnson is the only Hall of Fame inductee in the sport of cross country after turning in a tremendous Battling Bishop career from 1979 to 1982. The Ahoskie, N.C. native was a four-time Dixie All-Conference selection (three in cross country, one in track) and the lone individual league champion in Wesleyan history. As a junior, Johnson was crowned the conference's overall champion after turning in a time of 27:28 in the 5.4 mile run. Johnson, in fact, did not lose a race that entire season and proceeded to run his winning streak to 11 races as a senior. He wrapped up his career with a school-record time of 25:56 in the DIAC Championship... a record that still stands today. In addition to his cross country prowess, Johnson also excelled in track. He currently holds Wesleyan records in the 1500- and 800-meter runs with times of 4:20 and 1:59, respectively. His 800-meter time was good enough to earn him his second DIAC title.

On September 4th, 2004, the North Carolina Wesleyan football program took the field for the first time. Former head coach Jack Ginn had been preparing for this game at Shenandoah University for almost two years, and he led nearly 150 Blue & Gold players into battle that night. Although NCWC lost its inaugural game to the Hornets by a 24-7 score, it would not be long for the Battling Bishops to begin a notable list of "firsts" that has grown much more quickly than most expected.

North Carolina Wesleyan hosted its first home game at the Rocky Mount Athletic Complex on September 18th, 2004 against Greensboro College. It proved to be a special day for the Blue & Gold as they recorded the program's first victory, as well as its first USA South Conference win, by a 14-6 score.
