## Match Notes

- Saturday's meeting will be the 29th meeting between the two schools.
- It is the final regular season game for both teams.
- Santa Clara has not lost to Pacific since the 2018 season and are 2-0-2 in the last four meetings.
- Santa Clara is 2-3-3 at home while Pacific is 2-4-2 in away games this season.

## Season Notes

- Santa Clara is 4-1-1 in West Coast Conference play and is tied atop the WCC standings along with San Diego who has the tiebreaker advantage due to their head-to-head win. Both the Broncos and the Toreros have 13 points, one point ahead of second place Portland who has a 4-2-0 league record. San Diego plays Gonzaga on Friday.
- Santa Clara can win the outright conference championship with:
  - San Diego tie or loss + Santa Clara win. San Diego will then have 14 or 13 points and Santa Clara will have 16 points in this scenario.
  - OR
  - San Diego loss + Santa Clara tie + Portland tie or loss (vs San Francisco on Saturday). In this scenario San Diego will finish with 13 points, Santa Clara with 14 and Portland with 13 or 12.
- Even if both USD and SCU finish with wins this weekend (both will be crowned WCC Co-Champions), because of the head-to-head tiebreaker, USD will get the automatic qualifying bid for the NCAA Tournament.
- Eight Broncos - Jesse Anamoo, Caden Buckley, Joshua Dabora, Adem Hamdaoua, Tyrone Kirunda, Timmy Rast, Felix Schaefer and Jack Stoecker - will be recognized in the pregame Senior Night ceremony starting at 6:42 p.m.
- Broncos head coach Cam Rast won his 200th career win last Saturday and will be recognized prior to the Senior Night ceremony. In 22 seasons, all at Santa Clara, Rast has an overall record of 200-148-64. Against Saint Mary's (Sept. 30) in the conference opener, the six-time WCC Coach of the Year recipient won his 100th WCC game as his league record currently stands at 103-64-34. A win against Pacific will be his 100th win at home as he currently has a 99-55-37 record at Stevens Stadium.
- SCU played three-straight opponents who received votes in the United Soccer Coaches poll in October. They played No. 7 Portland (Oct. 6), No. 10 Stanford (Oct. 9) and LMU (Oct. 21) who received two votes. SCU went 2-1-0 in those games.
- Senior midfielder Adem Hamdaoua has had a hand in seven of the 10 goals scored by SCU during conference play. He scored a goal in each of the first three WCC games plus in the last game and assisted in three others.
- In conference play, Hamdaoua leads in game-winning goals (3) and points (11) and tied for first in assists (3) and goals (4).
- In conference action, junior goalkeeper Jack Stoecker leads in save percentage (.839) and is tied first in shutouts/game (.500), second in saves (26) and tied for second in goals-against average (.833). He is sixth nationally in save percentage (.854).
- Stoecker had recorded three-straight shutouts before conceding a goal in the first half against San Diego. It was the first goal given up in 394:52 of action.
- Hamdaoua and Stoecker have been named WCC Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week twice each this season.

## Season Notes

- SCU is 1-2 against ranked opponents this season, beating No. 7 Portland and falling to No. 17 Georgetown and No. 10 Stanford.
- SCU has played six games against teams currently ranked in the top-31 in the RPI. The Broncos are 2-4 in those games beating Portland and LMU but losing to Georgetown, Oregon State, Stanford and San Diego.
- Hamdaoua leads the team in points (16), goals (6), assists (4) and game-winning goals (4). Three of the game winners have come against WCC opponents.
- Santa Clara has used the same starting lineup in eight of the last nine games where they are 5-1-2. Prior to that, they used a different starting combination in each of the first eight games. Against Stanford, a different lineup was used coming off a match against Portland three days earlier.
- Caden Buckley, Damani Osei and Joshua Dabora started in each of the first 11 games and 15 of the last 16 games. They were rested against Stanford.
- Jack Civitts and Pierce Dyal have seen action in all 16 games.
- All 10 newcomers - Yoni Aidlberg, Noah Bohane, Jack Civitts, Itamar Efrat, Martin Kwende Jr., Brennan Mallett, Keagan Rhodes, Spencer Roberts, Will Wiersdorf and Aidan Wilmott- have started at least one game.
- Civitts is second on the team in points (11) and assists (3) and is tied for second in goals (4).
- Stoecker made his season debut getting the starting nod against CSU Bakersfield (Sept. 21) and has played every minute in eight of the last nine contests. His record is 5-1-2 with 35 saves, six goals allowed and has four clean sheets.
- Two Broncos have scored a brace in 2023: Caden Buckley's brace (Aug. 24 vs. Georgetown) was his career first while Adem Hamdaoua's (Sept. 7 vs. Incarnate Word) was his third of his career and his first as a Bronco. In his second season at SCU, he twice had a brace at his previous school, Drury University.
- The 2015 squad started the year 1-4 including a tough 1-0 loss in the fifth game just like this season. The 2015 team finished strong taking the WCC crown and making it to the second round of the NCAA tournament.
- The season opener on Aug. 24 tied for the earliest game the Broncos have played since at least 1977. In both 2012 and 2018, the Broncos opened their season on Aug. 24, losing to Cal 2-1 in 2012 and winning against San Diego State 2-0 in 2018.
- Head coach Cam Rast who is in his 22nd season at the helm is 11-10-1 in season openers.

## Preseason

- Junior midfielder Caden Buckley was named to the WCC men's soccer preseason team by a vote of the league's eight head coaches.
- The same panel picked Santa Clara to finish fifth in the WCC with Portland as the favorite to win the conference.
- Buckley is the sole captain for the 2023 Broncos squad.
- The Broncos embarked on a foreign tour to England over the summer (June 26 - July 7) and played local teams going 3-0-1.
- The last time SCU went on an international tour to England was in 2003, when they finished the year with a trip to the College Cup.

## 2023 Team

- The 2023 Santa Clara men's soccer team is comprised of 27 total players including 17 returning players from last season where they finished with a 4-5-6 overall record and 1-2-4 in West Coast Conference play to finish fifth.
- Ten newcomers dot the roster: Yoni Aidlberg, Noah Bohane, Jack Civitts, Itamar Efrat, Martin Kwende Jr., Brennan Mallett, Keagan Rhodes, Spencer Roberts, Will Wiersdorf and Aidan Wilmott.
- Two returners were named All-West Coast Conference last year - junior midfielder Caden Buckley garnered honorable mention honors and sophomore midfielder Pierce Dyal was named to the All-Freshman team.
- Senior forward Jesse Anamoo is the leading returning scorer with three goals (and an assist).
- Senior goalkeeper Felix Schaefer played in 12 games and posted a 4-4-4 record with a 1.36 goals-against-average and a .686 save percentage.

## Parking

Parking on Santa Clara's campus will remain free until further notice.
