2023-24 Team

- Santa Clara roster is comprised of nine players this spring with three returnees and six newcomers after starting the fall season with just six players.
- Tiago Boschmans, Sebastian Buxman and Luca Lemaitre joined the team as mid-year enrollees for the spring 2024 season.
- The returnees are: senior Guillaume Dalmasso, graduate students Christian Lerby and Matthew Rodriguez.
- The newcomers are: graduate transfers Arjun Honnappa from Western Michigan and Sebastian Buxman from Weber State, sophomore transfer Alexander Watanabe Eriksson from UC Santa Barbara and freshmen Tiago Boschmans, Luca Lemaitre and Lukas Maskow.
- The Broncos lost five players to graduation who helped the team finish with a 16-10 record last season including a 6-3 mark in the West Coast Conference and a berth in the semifinal rounds at the league tournament.
- Lerby entered the 2023-24 season ranked No. 84 in the ITA preseason national singles rankings.

Match/Season Notes

- Santa Clara faces Saint Mary's in a nonconference match on Sunday as a replacement match for the Idaho match that was canceled last weekend due to rain. This match was originally scheduled for Wednesday, Jan. 24 but postponed due to weather concerns.
- While the Idaho match was scheduled for home, this match against Saint Mary's will be on the road in Moraga, California.
- The Broncos and the Gaels will face each other again in a West Coast Conference match on April 14 in Santa Clara.
- The Broncos are coming off a thrilling 4-3 comeback win over Cal in their season opener on Sunday. Freshman Luca Lemaitre delivered the 3-all match clincher in his first collegiate match. Both the doubles and singles point clinchers came on tiebreakers.
- For their efforts against Cal, the Broncos swept the weekly WCC honors Luca Lemaitre was named WCC Singles Player of the Week while Sebastian Buxman and Arjun Honnappa took home the WCC Doubles Team of the Week honors.
- Saint Mary's played their season opener against Stanford last Thursday and fell, 7-0.
- There is no live stats nor live stream for the match.

2024 Preseason

- Christian Lerby and Guillaume Dalmasso were named preseason All-West Coast Conference.
- Lerby finished the fall ranked No. 44 and Dalmasso was ranked No. 102 by the ITA in singles play.
- Santa Clara was picked to finish third in the conference as voted by the league's nine head coaches.

2023 Fall Season

- Christian Lerby finished the fall season with a team-high seven singles wins and Alexander Watanabe Eriksson topped in doubles wins with four.
- At the Arkansas ITF M15/ USTA 15K Fayetteville Futures (Oct. 30 Nov. 2), Lerby won three-straight matches and qualified to play in the main draw before falling in the second round.
- Lerby and Guillaume Dalmasso played at the ITA Northwest Super Regional Championships (Oct. 20-22) where both of them advanced to the singles quarterfinals.
- At the ITA Northwest Regional Championships (Oct. 6-8) in Berkeley, California, Lukas Maskow advanced to the singles round of 16.
- At the ITA All-American Championships (Oct. 2-3) in Tulsa, Oklahoma, Lerby won two singles matches before falling in the the round of 32 in the qualifying draw. Also playing in the qualifying draw, Dalmasso defeated No. 57-ranked Matisse Bobichon of VCU in the round of 128 but lost in the next round.
- At the Aggie Invitational, Watanabe Eriksson won the Flight B singles championship while Rodriguez was a the runner-up in the Flight C singles draw.
