Tournament Notes

- The Leadership and Golf Collegiate Championship, co-hosted by Saint Mary's and Seattle U., will serve as the fourth of five fall tournaments for the Broncos before the flip of the calendar.
- The tournament will be played at the Bayonet Golf Course in Monterey, set up for a par-72 at 7,044 yards. It will span three days with 18 holes a day beginning on Monday.
- Six Broncos are slated to participate in the event - Emil Nielsen, J.P. Odland, Jack Hayden, Alvaro Muller and Calder Overfelt will be the main five of the SCU Lineup, and Matt Robles will play as an individual.
- Hayden, a freshman, is already familiar with the course having just played and won the Otter Invitational at the same location last week with a final tally of 5-under 211.
- A total of 14 teams will make up the field - Santa Clara, Saint Mary's, Seattle U., LMU, Pacific, USF, Cal Baptist, Sacramento State, UC Irvine, UC Santa Barbara, BYU, Nevada, Illinois State and Sam Houston State.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara opened the season with a bang, capturing both the team and individual title at the Myrtle Beach Golf Trips Intercollegiate. The team turned a three-day total of 21-under 843 to capture the tournament championship.
- J.P. Odland won the first event of his young Bronco Career, and became the first Bronco individual since Nolan Forsman in 2021 to win medalist honors. He finished the event 9-under 67-71-69--207 and was part of a three-way tie for first place.
- Odland currently leads the team in scoring average at 69.33 and already has five rounds in the 60s for the fall.
- Odland made program history his last time out at the Alister MacKenzie Invitational, tying the program record of 15-under par (67-66-65--198) to finish in seventh.
- Jack Hayden also won medalist honors for the first time of his career with a 5-under 211 tally at the 2024 Otter Invitational where he played as an individual participant.
- In addition to Hayden, newcoemrs Tyler Gerace, Alvaro Muller, Emil Nielsen, Matt Robles and Kasper Verwers have each seen action already in the young season.
- Nielsen couldn't have asked for a much better debut, turning in an 8-under 208 to finish in fourth. at the Myrtle Beach Intercollegiate. Verwers also logged a top-20 finish in his first collegiate action, tying for 19th at 2-under 214.
- Nielsen is currently second on the team in scoring average at 70.89 strokes per round in three events.
- The Broncos are in the fourth year under the direction of head coach Andrew Larkin.
