Match Notes

- The No. 17 Santa Clara University men's water polo team kicks off a five-game home stand Thursday when it hosts three-time defending national champion California.
- The Broncos haven't beaten California in any of the teams' previous 15 meetings dating to 2010, going 0-15 against the Golden Bears in that stretch.
- California has won all of the teams' previous encounters by an average of 10.4 goals per game, though two of the last three meetings have been decided by single-digit goals.
- The Broncos played their closest game against the Golden Bears in 2019 when they only fell by three goals, 12-9, in a neutral site game in Davis, Calif., on Sept. 22, 2019.

Season Notes

- No. 17 Santa Clara had a perfect weekend last weekend in Southern California, going an unblemished 3-0 at the Lancer Joust. The Broncos beat co-host Cal State Fullerton, 12-9, and Concordia University Irvine, 15-13, on Friday in Fullerton, Calif. They closed the unbeaten weekend on Saturday with a 14-8 win over Biola in Riverside, Calif.
- Santa Clara redshirt freshman **Luke Baird** was named the KAP7 West Coast Conference Newcomer of the Week Tuesday after helping lead the No. 17 Broncos to a perfect weekend at the Lancer Joust. Baird totaled seven goals, four steals, three field blocks and an assist with two multi-goal performances in three games. Baird tied for the game high Friday with a season-best four goals in the tournament opener versus host Cal State Fullerton. He came back in Friday's nightcap with two more goals against Concordia University Irvine for a sixgoal day Friday. Baird added another goal Saturday in the Broncos' 14-8 win over Biola, one of 10 Broncos to score in the game.
- Santa Clara freshman utility man **Riccardo De Simon** owns two WCC Newcomer of the Week awards this season. His most recent came for the week of Sept. 23-29 after helping lead the Broncos to a milestone road victory at No. 13 UC Davis. He also won the award for the week of Sept. 9-15 after scoring 11 goals across four games at the Princeton Invitational.
- Senior attacker **Zach Fales** was one of 20 student-athletes from across the country named Thursday to the 2024 Cutino Award Watch List, the award given annually to the top NCAA Division I collegiate male and female in water polo. Fales is the Broncos' leading points-getter with 63 total points. He has team highs in goals (37) and assists (26). Fales is also second on the team with 21 steals.

Season Notes

• Santa Clara head coach **Keith Wilbur** reached his 300th career men's water polo win this season thanks to a 14-12 win at No. 13 UC Davis on Sept. 27. He's earned all 300 of his wins at the helm of the Broncos' program. Wilbur is in his 23rd season as head coach of the program and is the winningest coach in program history. He began his tenure at Santa Clara in the fall of 2002.

- The Broncos (12-14 in 2023) finished 2023 ranked tied for 18th in the nation alongside WCC rival Pacific. Santa Clara has 13 matches scheduled in 2024 against teams ranked in both of the preseason top-20 polls, including showdowns against top-five teams California (No. 2/2) on Oct. 17, Stanford (No. 3/3) on Nov. 9 and Princeton (No. 5/5) on Sept. 13.
- Santa Clara returns its top two points scorers from 2023 in **Zach Fales** and **Gojko Kapovic**. Fales earned first team all-WCC honors and was tabbed an All-American honorable mention by the ACWPC after scoring a team-high 61 goals and totaling 101 points. Kapovic was the team's leading assists-getter with 59 and was second on the team with 88 total points. He also scored 29 goals (fourth on the team).
- The Broncos also return their starting goalkeeper from a year ago, **Harrison Labrosse**. The sophomore Labrosse made 159 saves in 16 starts. He also grabbed 12 steals on the season while logging a season-high 13 saves on two occasions.
- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team had a WCC-best 10 total honorees on the 2023 WCC All-Academic team. It later raked in 16 All-Academic awards from the ACWPC this summer. 2024 senior **Connor Long** earned "Outstanding" honors from the ACWPC.
