Match Notes

- The No. 14/15 (ACWPC Poll/CWPA Men's Varsity Poll) Santa Clara University men's water polo team stays local this weekend with two games across town at San Jose State in the Big West/WCC Challenge.
- The Broncos are 2-5 versus current Big West Conference teams over the past three seasons (since 2022). They most recently defeated then-No. 13 UC Davis on the road, 14-12, on Sept. 27.
- Santa Clara hasn't faced UC Santa Barbara since 2021, falling in that game at home, 19-5. The Broncos last defeated the Gauchos on Sept. 21, 2008.
- The Broncos haven't defeated UC Davis in consecutive meetings since 2008, when they beat them on Nov. 15, 2008, and then again on Nov. 23, 2008.

Season Notes

- The No. 14/15 Broncos went on the road Friday and took down host and No. 13-ranked UC Davis, 14-12, to earn their first win over the Aggies in 13 years, and in the process, reach the 300th victory for head coach Keith Wilbur. Santa Clara (6-2) never trailed in the game. In the process, it beat the Aggies (6-8) for the first time since Oct. 9, 2011, when it beat them, 9-6. That game was also in Davis, the Broncos were also ranked No. 18 back then, and they also never trailed in that game.
- Santa Clara freshman utility man **Riccardo De Simon** earned another weekly award Tuesday, being named the KAP7 West Coast Conference Newcomer of the Week for the second time, this time for the week of Sept. 23-29 after helping lead the Broncos to a milestone road victory at No. 13 UC Davis. De Simon did it all Friday for then-No. 18 Santa Clara, scoring one goal, tallying a team-high three assists on three other goals, grabbing four steals, recording three field blocks on defense and also drawing two exclusions to help lead the Broncos to a historic 14-12 win on the road at then-No. 13-ranked UC Davis.

Season Notes

• Santa Clara head coach **Keith Wilbur** now has 300 career men's water polo wins, and he's earned all of them at the helm of the Broncos' program. Friday's 14-12 win at No. 13 UC Davis. Wilbur is in his 23rd season as head coach of the program and is the winningest coach in program history. He began his tenure at Santa Clara in the fall of 2002.

- The Broncos (12-14 in 2023) finished the 2023 season ranked tied for 18th in the nation alongside WCC rival Pacific. Santa Clara has 13 matches scheduled in 2024 against teams ranked in both of the preseason top-20 polls, including showdowns against top-five teams California (No. 2/2) on Oct. 17, Stanford (No. 3/3) on Nov. 9 and Princeton (No. 5/5) on Friday.
- All seven members of the WCC received votes in the CWPA preseason national poll, with six of them earning placement in the poll. WCC Preseason Coaches' Poll favorite Pacific was the highest-ranked WCC member at No. 7. San Jose State landed at No. 9, Pepperdine was No. 13, LMU was placed at No. 16, Cal Baptist earned a No. 17 showing, and the Broncos came it at No. 19. Air Force earned three votes in the CWPA poll.
- Santa Clara returns its top two points scorers from 2023 in **Zach Fales** and **Gojko Kapovic**. Fales earned first team all-WCC honors and was tabbed an All-American honorable mention by the ACWPC after scoring a team-high 61 goals and totaling 101 points. Kapovic was the team's leading assists-getter with 59 and was second on the team with 88 total points. He also scored 29 goals (fourth on the team).
- The Broncos also return their starting goalkeeper from a year ago, **Harrison Labrosse**. The sophomore Labrosse made 159 saves in 16 starts. He also grabbed 12 steals on the season while logging a season-high 13 saves on two occasions.
- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team had a WCC-best 10 total honorees on the 2023 WCC All-Academic team. It later raked in 16 All-Academic awards from the ACWPC this summer. 2024 senior **Connor Long** earned "Outstanding" honors from the ACWPC.
