Match Notes

- Santa Clara and LMU meet for the 54th time in history meeting.
- Last season, the Broncos scored two goals in the opening 11 minutes to <u>defeat the Lions 2-0 on the road</u>. It snapped a seven-game winless streak against LMU.
- In 2021, goalkeeper Jack Stoecker made his Bronco debut against LMU with an 11 save shutout which remains his career high for saves. The game was a goalless draw.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara has a 5-6-3 overall record, 2-2-2 in the West Coast Conference and sits in fifth place (among nine teams) in the league standings.
- The Broncos are coming off a 1-0 win over Gonzaga for their second straight win.
- Six Broncos Yoni Aidlberg, Noah Bohane, Florian Deletioglu, Malte Furst, Alvaro Gironda and Brennan Mallett will be recognized prior to the match on Senior Night. Jack Stoecker is a graduate student who was recognized at last year's Senior Night.
- The Senior Night ceremony is scheduled to begin at approximately 6:42 p.m. PT.
- Santa Clara has been a strong second half team with a plus six (10-4) goal differential but have struggled in the first half with a minus 11 goal differential (14-3).
- Against Pacific, the game opening goal scored on a penalty kick by Will Wiersdorf is the first lead the Broncos have had in the opening half all season.
- In league play, goalkeeper Jack Stoecker had a stretch of not allowing a goal in 250 minutes before San Diego (Oct. 17) scored with one second remaining in the first half. During that span, Stoecker posted a pair of shutouts in the Broncos goalless draws against Portand on the road and Saint Mary's at home.
- For his efforts against Portland (Oct. 4), Naji Elder was named WCC Defensive Player of the Week.
- Dating back to last year, three of the last six wins have come on a game-winning goal at the 88th minute or later. In last year's season finale against Pacific, Joshua Dabora scored in the 88th minute to help the Broncos clinch a share of the West Coast Conference title. In this year's season opener against UCSD, Florian Deletioglu tallied the game winner also in the 88th minute. And against San Jose State this season, the Broncos had a 2-1 buzzer beating win. Itamar Efrat scored the game winner with just two seconds left in the game that saw 12 cards issued.
- The Broncos started the year playing four straight games on the road, going 2-2-0, including a week long trip to the east coast playing Fordham and Boston University.
- Deletioglu returned to Fordham where he starred for four seasons before transferring this season. Deletioglu leads the team with three goals along with Tyler Tipton.
- The Broncos finished the nonconference schedule with a 3-4-1 record and faced four Big West teams UC San Diego, UC Davis, Sacramento State and CSUN. SCU went 1-3 agains them.
- SCU opened the season on Aug. 22 with a <u>1-0 win over UC San Diego</u>. Aug. 22 is the earliest game the Broncos played (in the fall) since at least 1977.
- Tipton leads the team with five goals on the season. Deletioglu and Wiersdorf are tied for second with three goals apiece. Wiersdforf has tallied a goal in the last two games. Wiersford, Jack Civitts and Andrew Sullivan each have a team leading two assists. Jack Stoecker has started at goalkeeper in 10 matches going 3-4-3, posting a .737 save% and 1.10 goals-against-average. He has three shutouts. Jackson

Season Notes

Ozburn has started in four matches, including the last two. He has a .667 save% and 1.75 GAA. He earned his first collegiate win against Pacific (Oct. 26) allowing one goal and making three saves in the 2-1 victory and firs shut out against Gonzaga (Oct. 30).

- Two Broncos have started in every game Yoni Aidlberg and Deletioglu.
- Ten (out of 15) newcomers have seen action thus far Deletioglu, Gironda, Baronyi Kengeye, Tipton, Jaiden Windell, Quinn Garrett, Kai Hatten, Andrew Sullivan, Ozburn and Simon Diagana.
- · Santa Clara is coming off a West Coast Conference Championship season, finishing the league slate with a 5-1-1 record (7-7-3 overall), to share the conference cochampionship with the University of San Diego.
- It was the 14th conference title in Bronco history.
- · San Diego got the automatic qualifying bid to the NCAA Tournament due to their head-to-head win for the tiebreaker advantage.
- · Last season, Santa Clara played six teams that qualified for the 2023 NCAA Tournament, defeating two of them – shutting out a high-powered Portland squad 1-0 that entered the game leading the nation in scoring and also blanking LMU 2-0 on the road.
- · Head coach Cam Rast enters his 23rd season at the helm coming off a season in which he was named WCC Coach of the Year for the seventh time (won previously in 2003, 2006, 2007, 2010, 2015, & 2021). Rast hit a couple of career milestones during the season picking up his 200th career victory (Nov. 4 vs. Gonzaga) and 100th WCC win (Sept. 30 vs. Saint Mary's). He has a career record of 206-154-67 including 106-66-36 in West Coast Conference play and 102-57-39 at home.

2024 Team

- · The 2024 squad is comprised of 29 players including 14 returners and 15 newcom-
- · Three returners were named All-West Coast Conference last year graduate student goalkeeper Jack Stoecker garnered first team honors, sophomore midfielder Martin Kwende Jr. was named second team all conference and was named to the All-Freshman team along with sophomore forward Jack Civitts.
- · Fifteen newcomers dot the roster: Jackson Blake, Sean Bratkowski, Simon Diagana, Florian Deletioglu, Quinn Garrett, Alvaro Gironda, Kai Hatten, Baronyi Kengeye, Jackson Ozburn, Khalil Rashad, Andrew Sullivan, Tyler Tipton, Carter Tseu, Jaiden Windell and Yu Yokokawa.
- · Of the 15 newcomers, 10 are freshman and five are transfers Deletioglu (Fordham), Gironda (played in Spain), Kengeye (West Alabama), Ozburn (Washington) and Tipton (Stanislaus State).
- · The captains for this season are: senior defender Yoni Aidlberg, junior midfielder Pierce Dyal and sophomore midfielder Will Wiersdorf.
- The Broncos return seven of 23 goals from last season (30.4%) led by Civitts with four. Dyal, Will Wiersdorf and Naji Elder each tallied a goal.
- Fourteen of 25 assists (56%) returns led by Aidlberg with five followed by Civitts
- · Stoecker played in nine games and posted a 6-1-2 record with a 0.78 goalsagainst-average, a .848 save percentage and recorded four shutouts. He was inserted into the starting XI midway through the season starting in nine of the final 10 matches. During that span, he twice won the WCC Defensive Player of the Week honors. Stoecker's .848 save percentage was the fifth best in the nation. In WCC play, he led in save percentage (.833) and finished second with a .857 goals-against-average and 4.29 saves per game to earn the only goalkeeper spot on the WCC first team.

Preseason

• By a vote of the league's nine head coaches, Santa Clara was picked to finish sixth in the WCC with Portland as the favorite to win the conference. League newcomer Oregon State was picked to finish first (56 points).

- · All four members of the coaching staff played in the WCC including three at Santa Clara - head coach Cam Rast '91, associate head coach Eric Yamamoto '90 and assistant coach Jack Murphy '22. Assistant coach Riley Hanley '15 played at Saint
- Murphy was promoted to assistant coach/director of operations in July after serving as a graduate assistant last season.
