## **Tournament Central**

### Game/Season Notes

- Santa Clara travels Las Vegas to play in the UNLV Rebel Classic this Friday through Sunday. Four schools - Santa Clara, Southern Utah, Tulsa and host, UNLV - will participate in the 10-game, three-day tournament. The Broncos will participate in five games including two each on Friday and Saturday along with one game on Sunday.

- The Broncos are 4-6 on the season going 2-3 in each of the first two tournaments, the Fresno State Kickoff Classic and the Silicon Valley Classic I Tournament that was co-hosted along with San Jose State last week.
- SCU has scored 25 runs in their four wins (6.25 runs/game) but have only scored 11 runs in their six losses (1.83 runs/game).
- The veteran pitching staff that returns three of the four pitchers from last season has a 3.24 ERA. Newcomer Alaina Valdez leads the way not allowing an earned run in her four appearances spanning five innings while holding the opposition to a team-low .158 batting average. Hannah Edwards has a team-best three wins. The staff already has three saves in their four wins, after having two saves all last season.
- Offensively, the team is batting .235 with freshman Cairah Curran leading the way with a .400 batting average (12-for-30). The speedster also tops the team in stolen bases with six. Junior Morgan Salmon has supplied the power with three home runs and 10 RBIs to lead the team. One of home runs was walk-off two-run homer against South Dakota State in the Broncos first win of the season on Feb. 10.
- All seven newcomers saw action in the season opening tournamentincluding all five position players Kyla Acres, Taryn Clements, Cairah Curran, Caitlyn "Red" Golob and Rebecca Rubio each getting at least one hit and the two pitchers Avery Seva and Alaina Valdez seeing action in the circle.
- The six of the seven newcomers who are freshmen will be doing an Instagram Takeover on the @scusoftball account starting this Friday for the duration of the UNLV Rebel Classic Tournament. The seven member sophomore class did their class takeover during the season opening weekend.

### 2024 Preseason

- Three Broncos Hannah Edwards, Hazyl Gray and Morgan Salmon were named 2024 preseason All-West Coast conference by a vote of the league's five head coaches.
- · The Broncos were picked to finish fourth by a vote of the same panel.

### 2024 Schedule

- The 2024 schedule is comprised of 55 games including 22 at Santa Clara Softball Stadium. The Broncos will host two tournaments among the six they play and face two schools
   Stanford and LMU that qualified for the 2023 NCAA Tournament.
- In West Coast Conference action, the league will encompass a 16-game league slate
  for each of the five conference member schools. The WCC schedule will run for five weeks
  from April 12 to May 11 with one bye week. Each weekend series is comprised of four
  games with a single game series opener, followed by a doubleheader the next day and a
  single game series finale on the last day.

### 2023 Season Highlights

- The Broncos finished with an overall record of 23-26 after finishing the 2022 season at 21-30 to post their first back-to-back 20-win seasons since 2005 and 2006.
- The 23-win total was the highest since the 2006 campaign when they went 24-34.
- Most home wins (15-11) since Santa Clara Softball Stadium was built in 2016.
- · Had the first sweep of a conference opponent (Pacific) since 2019.
- Five West Coast Conference Player/Pitchers of the Week honors won the most ever in a season for SCU. The first year of WCC softball was in 2014.
- Six All-WCC honorees First Team: Ashley Trierweiler; Second Team: Emma Bickford,

- Two National Fastpitch Coaches Association All-Pacific Region honorees First Team: Ashley Trierweiler; Second Team: Hazyl Gray. They were the first Broncos to be recognized to the all-region team since Jaime Forman-Lau in 2004.
- Ashley Trierweiler named Second Team D1Softball, Third Team NFCA & Second Team College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-American.

### 2024 Team

- The 22 player roster has 15 returnees including the three of the four pitchers who pitched last season.
- The three returning pitchers (Hannah Edwards, Sage Hager and Hazyl Gray) account for 21 of 23 wins (91-percent) and 81-percent of innings pitched in 2023.
- Mix of returnees and newcomers will step in to replace the offensive productivity from last season where five of the top seven hitters closed our their Bronco careers. The Broncos return 35-percent of the hits and 42-percent of the RBIs from 2023.
- Six of the seven newcomers hail from the prep ranks with Alaina Valdez hailing from the JUCO ranks.
- All but two players hail from California. Cairah Curran is from Hawaii and Kyla Acres from Nevada.

### About the Coaching Staff:

- Gina Carbonatto enters her fifth season as the head coach of the Broncos. Entering the 2024 season, she has a career record of 60-92.
- Carbonatto has served as the assistant coach for Great Britain's Under-22 women's softball team since 2018.
- In the summer of 2022, Carbonatto coached Great Britain's U-22 that competed in the European Under-22 Women's Fastpitch Championship in Kunovice, Czech Republic.
- On Carbonatto's SCU staff are pitching coach Jen Deering, who is also in her fifth season, hitting coach Kristi Villar is in her second season, graduate assistant Montana Dixon is in her third season and former Bronco player Emma Bickford is in her first season as a volunteer assistant.
- Dixon serves in the Director of Operations role; Bickford will help with the infield coaching and Carbonatto with the outfield coaching.
- Bickford finished her Bronco career tied for eighth in hits (168), second in doubles (42), third in RBIs (102), seventh in total bases (242), eighth in slugging percentage (.425) and first in sacrifice flies (10) since 2000.
- For the upcoming season, Carbonatto will be the third base coach and Bickford the first base coach.
- · Deering and Villar will be the bench coaches.
