Season Notes

- The Broncos were unable to find a win at the Harvard Invitational but look to jump back in Claremont, Calif. this weekend.
- Santa Clara took their first conference win, 9-8 against CUI. This featured a comeback from a 7-3 deficit and a buzzer-beater for the game by Sydney Maccabe.
- Maccabe was honored as the GCC Player of the Week as she finished the week-end with seven goals, six steals, and three assists.
- Chloe Morrison was noticed as a GCC stand-out player in week six of the season after recording four goals, three steals, and four kickouts drawn at the Harvard Invitational.
- Santa Clara is 1-1 in overtime battles, taking the win 11-9 against Fresno Pacific but losing 8-9 to La Salle.
- Elle Fredrickson notched five goals in the OT win against Fresno Pacific. This was her second time this season putting up five goals and as a result, getting highlighted as a Golden Coast Conference Top Performer.
- Santa Clara came up short at the Stanford Invitational, after facing Cal State East Bay, Biola, and Stanford.
- Santa Clara opened the season with a win against CSU Monterey Bay, where they defeated the Otters 10-5.
- Liyara Senadheera was noticed as a top performer of the week by the GCC after recording 13 saves with a save percentage of .833 against CSU Monterey Bay.
- Fredrickson led the Broncos to their first victory with three goals to her name.
- Five seniors- Morrison, Maddie Clough, Alyssa Jacobsen, Fredrickson, and Senadheera come back for their fourth season.
- Junior Kate Rodman was named to the All-Golden Coast Conference second team after the 2023 season. She had eight games during the season where she scored at least three goals and she scored a season-high four goals on two different occasions.
- Rodman and Fredrickson tied with the most goals on the team throughout the 2023 season (44).
- Morrison was the sole Bronco to start in all 31 games of the 2023 season.
- The Broncos are looking to improve from last years 10-21 record as they compete in the Golden Coast Conference.
- Santa Clara is led by Claire Linney, who served as the assistant coach for eight seasons, and enters her third season at the helm. She is assisted by Allie Lamb in her second year in the role and Lauren Baglietto as the graduate assistant coach.
