2023-24 Team

- Santa Clara roster is comprised of nine players this spring with three returnees and six newcomers after starting the fall season with just six players.
- Tiago Boschmans, Sebastian Buxman and Luca Lemaitre joined the team as mid-year enrollees for the spring 2024 season.
- The returnees are: senior Guillaume Dalmasso, graduate students Christian Lerby and Matthew Rodriguez.
- The newcomers are: graduate transfers Arjun Honnappa from Western Michigan and Sebastian Buxman from Weber State, sophomore transfer Alexander Watanabe Eriksson from UC Santa Barbara and freshmen Tiago Boschmans, Luca Lemaitre and Lukas Maskow.
- The Broncos lost five players to graduation who helped the team finish with a 16-10 record last season including a 6-3 mark in the West Coast Conference and a berth in the semifinal rounds at the league tournament.
- Lerby entered the 2023-24 season ranked No. 84 in the ITA preseason national singles rankings.

Match/Season Notes

- Santa Clara is ranked No. 62 in the Intercollegiate Tennis Association rankings that came out last Tuesday (March 12). The Broncos have been ranked for four-straight weeks and has climbed as high as No. 54, their highest since the 2014-15 season when they were ranked No. 52.
- Christian Lerby remains ranked No. 78 after reaching a high of No. 42 in the initial spring season rankings.
- The new rankings will come out on Tuesday, March 19 just prior to the match between Santa Clara and Washington, who are ranked No. 74 in last week's rankings. It marks the final match of the six-match homestand where the Broncos have gone undefeated.
- Over the weekend, the Broncos posted shutout sweeps over Seattle (4-0) and UC Santa Cruz (7-0) to extend their win streak to six matches. Both matches were played on Saturday at home.
- It was the fourth and fifth sweeps of the season. The other blankings were variety against Florida Gulf Coast (Feb. 25), Grand Canyon (Feb. 16) and UNLV (March 9). The Broncos have swept the last three matches.
- The Broncos have two wins over nationally ranked opponents this season a pair of 4-3 victories over No. 53 South Florida and No. 69 New Mexico.
- The Broncos are 5-0 in true road contest, 0-1 in neutral site matches and 6-1 at home.
- SCU has been involved in eight 4-3 matches this season, winning six of them including four 3-all clinchers.
- Four different players have won the 3-all clinching matches: at Cal (Luca Lemaitre with the clincher), vs. UC Davis (Christian Lerby), at No. 53 South Florida (Alexander Watanabe Eriksson) and against No. 69 New Mexico (Lukas Maskow).
- For the Broncos efforts against Cal, the Broncos swept the weekly WCC honors Luca Lemaitre was named WCC Singles Player of the Week while Sebastian Buxman and Arjun Honnappa took home the WCC Doubles Team of the Week honors.
- Luca Lemaitre leads the team in singles wins with eight (all but one win coming at court four) while Lerby and Guillaume Dalmasso tops in doubles wins with nine.
- In the initial ITA spring season rankings, Lerby was ranked No. 42 in singles. He entered
 the 2023-24 preseason ranked No. 84 and moved up 40 spots in the final fall rankings.
- SCU has defeated three University of California system schools this season Cal, Davis and Irvine. Their lone loss was against a UC school in UC Santa Barbara.
- Santa Clara played Saint Mary's in a nonconference match on Jan. 28 as a replacement match for the Idaho contest that was canceled due to rain. The Broncos and the Gaels will face each other again in a West Coast Conference match on April 14 in Santa Clara.
