Match/Season Notes

- Santa Clara opens West Coast Conference play at LMU on Sunday.
- For LMU, it is their third WCC match having already played Pacific (W, 4-1) and No. 7 Pepperdine (L, 0-7) on Feb. 27 and March 1.
- The Broncos are coming off a 4-3 loss at home to Weber State on Sunday that snapped their two-match win streak.
- The back-to-back matches won by SCU against Jessup (March 9) and Utah State (March 10) are their first consecutive wins since the 2021-22 season when they won five in a row.
- The Lions are in the midst of a nine-match home stand. They are 3-3 so far and are 4-3 overall at home this season. The Broncos are 1-3 in away matches.
- The weather has wreaked havoc with the schedule as Santa Clara has had three matches canceld by rain this spring.
- The spring season opening victory against Academy of Art (Jan. 26) was head coach Allie Will's first career victory in her inaugural season.
- SCU's 4-3 victory over UC Irvine (Feb. 10) came on Varya Zlotnik's 3-all clincher.
 SCU stormed back from a 3-1 deficit in the match to pick up their second win of the season.
- JennaMarie Gordon leads the team with eight singles wins, all coming atop the lineup. She had a five match win streak from Feb. 18 to March 10.
- In doubles, the tandem of Gordon/Velizara Fileva have five victories to lead the team.

2023 Fall Season

- · Santa Clara played in three tournaments during the fall.
- Varya Zlotnik led the team with six singles wins and JennaMarie Gordon had a team-high seven doubles victories.
