Tournament Notes

- Santa Clara will play their fourth of six spring events with a three-day stay in San Francisco for the Goodwin hosted by Stanford at historic TPC Harding Park.
- The course will be laid out for a 71,93-yard par 70.
- The same five Broncos will play the course again this week with Calder Overfelt in the lead position followed by Muzzy Donohue, J.P. Odland, Jeff Kwak and Nolan Forsman.
- This year's Goodwin field is stacked with 27 top tier teams. In addition to Santa Clara and host-Stanford, Appalachian State, Cal, Cal Baptist, Cal Poly, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Georgia, Howard, Lipscomb, Little Rock, Long Beach State, Oregon, Pepperdine, San Diego State, San Diego, San Jose State, TCU, Tennessee, UC Davis, UCLA, Nevada, Southern Cal, Utah, Utah Tech and Washington State will all be in contention.

Season Notes

- The Broncos are coming off a tie for 11th at the Lamkin in San Diego. Jeff Kwak had the top individual finish at 1-under 215 to tie for 33rd.
- Muzzy Donohue had a sensational turn at the Arizona N.I.T., especially in the final two rounds where he turned in back-to-back 66s to finish in a tie for seventh at 14-under 70-66--202. The score was both a career-low and the lowest 54-hole score posted by a Bronco since Matt McCarthy shot a 13-under 200 at the 2019 Alister MacKenzie Invitational.
- Donohue was named the WCC's Men's Golfer of the Month for January.
- Santa Clara played five fall events and finished with a bang by winning the White Sands Bahamas Invite - their first team event win since 2017-18. The Broncos shot a school-record 45-under 273-277-269--819 en route to capturing the trophy. Four players finished in the top 10 of the final standings with Muzzy Donohue finishing third overall at 12-under 69-70-65.
- Freshman J.P. Odland was named to the Preseason All-WCC Men's Golf Team and the Broncos were selected to finish fourth in the team standings.
- Odland had a fantastic fall, finishing with a team-low 70.13 stroke average across all five events. He had three top-20 finishes with his best being a tie for seventh at the USF/Howard Intercollegiate (7-under 209).
- Fellow freshman Jeffrey Kwak (71.40), as well as Joey Hayden (72.27) and Calder Overfelt (72.27) also played in all five fall events.
- Odland tallied a team-high 10 rounds under par while Overfelt and Nolan Forsman each tallied six.
