### Tournament Notes

- Santa Clara is returning to the NGI for the second consecutive season.
- Once again, the NGI will be played at Ak-Chin Southern Dunes in Maricopa, Ariz. This will be the second time this season that the Broncos have played the course. They previously were there for the Wyoming Cowgirl Classic.
- The tournament will be a three-day format with 18 holes each day beginning on Friday.
- The Broncos are keeping the same five in the lineup but changing the order around a bit. Inara Sharma will play in the No. 1 position followed by Audrey Brust, Meva Schmit, Kelsey Kim and Patricia Garre Munoz.
- The field consists of 10 teams: Arkansas State, Austin Peay, Chattanooga, Florida Atlantic, Jacksonville State, Mercer, Rutgers, Santa Clara, UNCW and USC Upstate.
- The Broncos fared well in last season's inaugural NGI, finishing in fifth.

### Season Notes

- A pair of Broncos were honored by the WCC at the end of the regular season. Kelsey Kim was tabbed as the conference's freshman of the year while Meva Schmit earned All-WCC honors.
- Schmit led the team in scoring average at 74.85 strokes per round, edging out Inara Sharma (74.92) and Audrey Brust (74.93).
- Kim played in nine events with a 75.42 stroke average.
- Brust, a preseason All-WCC selection, led the team with five top-20 finishes and tied with Sharma for the most rounds under par (5).
- Sharma and Lauren Shew each earned First Team WCC All-Academic Honors while Brust was an honorable mention selection.
- Santa Clara finished in the top four in three of four fall events.
- SCU's best finish of the fall came in season-opening UVU Collegiate Shootout in Provo, Utah. The Broncos finished runner-up after turning in the lowest 54-hole score in program history over 18-under 846.
- The Broncos also set the school record for lowest 18-hole round by carding a 12-under 276 in the second round of the UVU Collegiate.
- Sharma tied for the lowest individual round in program history with a 5-under 67 as part of that record-breaking second round while Audrey Brust tallied the second-lowest 54-hole score with an 8-under 208 to finish fourth individually.
- Sharma led the team in scoring average in the fall with a 72.67.
- Santa Clara was tabbed to finish second in the WCC preseason poll.
- Head Coach Krystal Kelly is in her 14th season leading the Broncos.
