Season Notes

- Santa Clara opened its season by winning the USF Invitational August 30. Ishaan Singh (24:21.6) finished fourth, Oliver Maldonado (24:23.3) finished fifth, Paul Beaven (24:23.7) finished sixth, Kyle Berg (24:24.5) finished seventh, and Daniel Trampe (24:24.7), finished eighth to give the Broncos five of the top-10 runners. Singh's time was 10th best in program history and all five runners set personal bests. Austin Clough, Inbaa Chennai, Evan Charkut, Luke Johnson, Andrew Ho, and James Ponzio also set personal bests.
- Santa Clara was picked to finish third in the Preseason Poll voted on by the league's head coaches.
- The Broncos have eight newcomers this year. They welcome Jude Alvarez, McCoy Brooks, Kaden Helder, Eric Ortega-Gammill, Liam Papavasiliou, and Daniel Trampe as freshman and Jack Tolbert (Boise State) and Daniel Vaca (LMU) as transfers.
- Santa Clara finished last season third at the West Coast Conference Championships and had three runners - Nicholas Russell (2nd, 24:10.7), Ares Reading (9th, 24:59.7, and Ian Twyman (10th, 25:03.1) - named First Team All-WCC. The Broncos were the only team with three runners on the First Team.
- Russell finished fifth at the NCAA West Regional Championships with a time of 29:14.0, giving him a bid to the NCAA Championships in Charlottesville, Va., for the second year in a row.
- At the Championships, Russell placed 57th, clocking in at 30:05.9, the program's best performance in this race to date.
- Russell and Twyman were named to the NCAA DI Cross Country All-Region Team.
- Russell and Ishaan Singh were named WCC All-Academic. Dominic Baciocco, Kyle Berg, Oliver Branham-Upton, Harvey Chilcott, Mateo Fesslmeier, Brendan Mulvany, EJ Odocayen-Cruz, Colin Peattie, Nicholas Trepanier, and Twyman were honorable mention.
