### **Match Notes**

- Friday's game versus crosstown rival and No. 9-ranked San Jose State marks Santa Clara's opening of West Coast Conference play.
- The Broncos have lost their last two conference openers (2022, '23). They last defeated Biola, 19-7, at home on Sept. 24, 2021, to open Western Water Polo Association play.
- George Washington is the Broncos' fifth East Coast opponent in the past two weeks and one of seven East Coast teams they'll face in 2024. The Broncos went 3-1 last weekend against East Coast teams at the Princeton Invitational.
- Santa Clara hasn't beaten San Jose State since the COVID-shortened 2020 season that was held during the spring of 2021. The Broncos beat the Spartans, 11-10, at Sullivan Aquatic Center, in what was the season opener on Feb. 28, 2021.
- The Broncos beat George Washington in the Revolutionaries' only other trip to the Mission Campus in the past 17 years. They beat them, 12-11, on Oct. 24, 2016, in what was then called the "Rodeo Tournament," hosted by the Broncos at Sullivan Aquatic Center.

### Season Notes

- The No. 18 Santa Clara University men's water polo team had its best showing last weekend at the annual Princeton Invitational in six years. The Broncos went 3-1 at the tournament for the first time since 2018 with wins over Iona, Bucknell and Wagner, and a narrow, 15-9, defeat at the hands of host and No. 6 Princeton.
- Freshman utility player **Riccardo De Simon** was named the KAP7 WCC Newcomer of the Week Monday for the week of Sept. 9-15 after he scored a team-leading 11 goals across four games at the Princeton Invitational. He had multiple goals in three games, including a season-high five Saturday in the Broncos' 20-16 win over Bucknell. It was De Simon's back-to-back goals four minutes into the first period versus Bucknell that put the Broncos up for good, erasing a 3-2 Bisons lead and making it 4-3 at the time. He added six steals and four assists on the weekend.

### **Season Notes**

• Santa Clara head coach **Keith Wilbur** is on the cusp of his 300th career win, all with the Broncos. After a 3-1 weekend at the Princeton Invitational and a 4-1 start to the 2024 season, Wilbur currently sits at 298 career wins. Wilbur is in his 23rd season as head coach of the program and is the winningest coach in program history. He began his tenure at Santa Clara in the fall of 2002.

- The Broncos (12-14 in 2023) finished the 2023 season ranked tied for 18th in the nation alongside WCC rival Pacific. Santa Clara has 13 matches scheduled in 2024 against teams ranked in both of the preseason top-20 polls, including showdowns against top-five teams California (No. 2/2) on Oct. 17, Stanford (No. 3/3) on Nov. 9 and Princeton (No. 5/5) on Friday.
- All seven members of the WCC received votes in the CWPA preseason national poll, with six of them earning placement in the poll. WCC Preseason Coaches' Poll favorite Pacific was the highest-ranked WCC member at No. 7. San Jose State landed at No. 9, Pepperdine was No. 13, LMU was placed at No. 16, Cal Baptist earned a No. 17 showing, and the Broncos came it at No. 19. Air Force earned three votes in the CWPA poll.
- Santa Clara returns its top two points scorers from 2023 in **Zach Fales** and **Gojko Kapovic**. Fales earned first team all-WCC honors and was tabbed an All-American honorable mention by the ACWPC after scoring a team-high 61 goals and totaling 101 points. Kapovic was the team's leading assists-getter with 59 and was second on the team with 88 total points. He also scored 29 goals (fourth on the team).
- The Broncos also return their starting goalkeeper from a year ago, **Harrison Labrosse**. The sophomore Labrosse made 159 saves in 16 starts. He also grabbed 12 steals on the season while logging a season-high 13 saves on two occasions.
- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team had a WCC-best 10 total honorees on the 2023 WCC All-Academic team. It later raked in 16 All-Academic awards from the ACWPC this summer. 2024 senior **Connor Long** earned "Outstanding" honors from the ACWPC.
