- Santa Clara (0-0) opens its 2024 season at home at the Sullivan Aquatic Center, where it went 2-6 in 2023
- Santa Clara has won three consecutive meetings versus Fresno Pacific dating to 2022. The teams met twice last season, with the Broncos winning on the road at the Sunbirds, 21-5, and in a neutral pool in Riverside, Calif., 14-6.
- Fresno Pacific's last victory over the Broncos came at Sullivan Aquatic Center, a 10-7 win on Oct. 6, 2021.
- The Broncos are 3-1 in their last four season openers (since 2020), with the only defeat during that stretch coming on Sept. 3, 2022, on the road at No. 9 San Jose State (at West Valley College in Saratoga, Calif.), 10-8.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara enters the 2024 season as the No. 19 ranked team, thanks to both the Collegiate Water Polo Association and the ACWPC preseason top-20 rankings.
- The Broncos (12-14 in 2023) finished the 2023 season ranked tied for 18th in the nation alongside West Coast Conference rival Pacific. Santa Clara has 13 matches scheduled in 2024 against teams ranked in both of the top-20, including showdowns against top-five teams California (No. 2/2) on Oct. 17, Stanford (No. 3/3) on Nov. 9 and Princeton (No. 5/5) on Sept. 13.
- All seven members of the WCC received votes in the CWPA preseason national poll, with six of them earning placement in the poll. WCC Preseason Coaches' Poll favorite Pacific was the highest-ranked WCC member at No. 7. San Jose State landed at No. 9, Pepperdine was No. 13, LMU was placed at No. 16, Cal Baptist earned a No. 17 showing, and the Broncos came it at No. 19. Air Force earned three votes in the CWPA poll.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara returns its top two points scorers from 2023 in Zach Fales and Gojko Kapovic. Fales earned first team all-WCC honors and was tabbed an All-American honorable mention by the ACWPC after scoring a team-high 61 goals and totaling 101 points. Kapovic was the team's leading assists-getter with 59 and was second on the team with 88 total points. He also scored 29 goals (fourth on the team).
- The Broncos also return their starting goalkeeper from a year ago, **Harrison Labrosse**. The sophomore Labrosse made 159 saves in 16 starts. He also grabbed 12 steals on the season while logging a season-high 13 saves on two occasions.
- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team had a WCC-best 10 total honorees on the 2023 WCC All-Academic team. It later raked in 16 All-Academic awards from the ACWPC this summer. 2024 senior **Connor Long** earned "Outstanding" honors from the ACWPC.
