#### **Match Notes**

- Santa Clara and Saint Mary's meet for the 65th time in history.
- Three matches into the nine-game West Coast Conference schedule, Santa Clara sits in a tie for third place along with LMU with five points, two points behind Portland and Oregon State.
- Both the Broncos and the Gaels have tallied one goal each in WCC play. Broncos are 1-0-2 in league action as they have not conceded a goal while the Gaels are 0-2-1 having allowed five.
- Saint Mary's has scored 10 goals on the season led by Bastian Toelhoej with four.
- Sam Bentley has been in goal in all but 21 minutes, making 36 saves for a .679 save percentage and a 1.74 goals-against-average.
- Head coach Adam Cooper is in his 20th season at the helm and has a 166-127-65 record entering Wednesday's match.

#### **Season Notes**

- Santa Clara is in the middle playing three WCC matches over a span of 10 days that began last Friday hosting league newcomer Seattle U. Following the midweek contest at Saint Mary's this Wednesday, they return home and hosts San Francisco on Sunday.
- The Broncos are undefeated in the last six matches going 2-0-4, outscoring the opponents seven goals to two.
- SCU has not conceded a goal in the last 353 minutes, a span that includes three straight shutouts, all coming in conference action. During that span, goalkeeper Jackson Ozburn has a streak of 308 minutes without allowing a goal. The last goal he gave up was in the opening half against No. 16 Utah Valley (Sept. 20) before sitting out the second half.
- The last time SCU opened league play with three straight clean sheets was in 2004, when they had four straight.
- SCU had four straight draws prior to beating Seattle U last Friday. It was the first time in program history they played four consecutive matches ending in a tie.
- Santa Clara currently has played in six draws this season, tied for second most in program history (1986 and 2022). The program record for the most ties in a season is seven that occured in 2008.
- Ozburn is tied for the WCC lead with six clean sheets along with Portland's Miguel-Angel Hernandez. The Broncos keeper is second in save percentage (.775) and third in GAA with 0.80. He has been twice named WCC Defensive Player of the Week this season, on <u>Sept. 1</u> and on Oct. 6.
- The Broncos have already scored more goals this season (15) than they did all last season (13). This season's balanced attack features eight players with a goal led by Niv Berkovitz with five
- Berkovitz is tied for fifth in the WCC with five goals.
- The Broncos started the 2025 campaign with a pair of 1-all draws, against Cleveland State on the road and against UC Davis in the home opener. It was the first time in program history to open the season with two draws.
- In the last two seasons, Santa Clara has been involved in four matches that was decided
  in the final two minutes. This season against UC Davis, the Broncos leveled the game in the
  89th minute on a header by Niv Berkovitz. Last year, in the season opener, Florian Deletioglu
  scored the game winner in the 88th minute against UC San Diego. In September 2024, Itamar

#### **Season Notes**

Efrat tallied the game winner with two seconds left in the match in the win over San Jose State and the Broncos gave up the go-ahead goal with 38 seconds left in the match against LMU in November.

- Freshman Ethan Martinez leads the team with 1,061 minutes logged (out of a possible 1,080 minutes). He has played the full 90 minutes in 10 of the 12 matches.
- Head coach Cam Rast is in his 24th season at the helm where he has a career record of 210-158-73 including 107-68-38 in WCC and 104-59-41 at home.
- In 2024, Santa Clara had an overall record of 5-8-3 including 2-4-2 in the WCC to finish sixth in the league standings among nine teams.
- The Broncos play a total of 18 regular season matches, split evenly with nine nonconference and nine conference games. Last season, the number of league game increased from the customary seven matches they played from 2014-23 to eight due to Oregon State joining the league and this season it's up to nine matches with the addition of Seattle U.
- The Broncos face a challenging schedule playing five teams that qualified for the 2024 NCAA Tournament UC Davis, Stanford, San Diego, Seattle and Oregon State. So far, they are 2-1-1 against those teams, getting wins over UC Davis and Seattle, losing to Stanford and playing to a draw against San Diego.

#### 2025 Team

- The 2025 squad is comprised of 30 players including 19 returners and 11 newcomers.
- Two returners were named All-West Coast Conference last year senior Naji Elder and junior Will Wiersdorf garnered second team honors.
- Eleven newcomers dot the roster: Ezana Alemayehu, Moises Almontes, Alejandro Arenas, Alen Begovic, Niv Berkovitz, Diego Diaz, Josmar Guandique, Ethan Martinez, Gabrielius Mazonas, James Saggau and James Wangsness.
- Of the 11 newcomers, seven are freshman and four are transfers Berkovitz (SMU), Diaz (Temple), Saggau (Cal Poly) and Wangsness (Princeton).
- Spencer Roberts returns to the team after pursuing an opportunity with the engineering department last year. He was on the team in 2023.
- The captains for this season are: senior midfielder Pierce Dyal and junior midfielder Will Wiersdorf.
- The Broncos return nine of 13 goals from last season (69.2%) led by Tyler Tipton with five.
   Will Wiersdorf tallied three goals and Itamar Efrat had one.
- Six of 11 assists (54.5%) returns led by Wiersdort and Andrew Sullivan with two each.
- Jackson Ozburn played in five games and posted a 2-3 record with a 1.60 goals-against-average, a .652 save percentage and recorded one shutout.
- During the offseason, goalkeeper Eddy Marin was a recipient of the <u>CalHOPE Courage Award</u>, an award honoring student-athletes at California colleges and universities who have overcome the stress, anxiety, and mental trauma associated with personal hardships and adversity

#### Preseason

• By a vote of the league's 10 head coaches, Santa Clara was picked to finish seventh in the WCC with San Diego as the favorite to win the conference. League newcomer Seattle was picked to finish tied for fourth.

#### Coaching Staf

- All four members of the coaching staff played in the WCC including three at Santa Clara
   head coach Cam Rast '91, associate head coach Eric Yamamoto '90 and assistant coach
   Jack Murphy '22. Assistant coach Riley Hanley '15 played at Saint Mary's.
- Rast is the winningest active coach in the WCC leading his alma mater to eight NCAA tournaments and seven WCC Championships since taking over the Bronco men's soccer program in 2002. A former All-America player on Santa Clara's National Championship team of 1989 (along with Yamamoto) and U.S. Olympic Team captain in 1992, Rast spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at SCU from 1994-2001 and was inducted to the WCC Hall of Honor in 2018.
- Rast has been named WCC Coach of the Year seven times (2003, '06, '07, '10, '15, '21 and '23).

#### In the Family

- Yamamoto's daughter, Malia, is a junior defender on the Santa Clara women's soccer team.
- Murphy's father, Gregg, is the associate head coach for the SCU women's soccer team.
