Tournament Notes

- The ITA Regional Championships is the second qualifying tournament for the 2025 NCAA Individual Championships, following the ITA All-American Championships. The Regional Championships started last week on college campuses across the country. Santa Clara will play in the Northwest region, hosted by Pacific, in one of 13 regional tournaments. The two singles finalists from each region (26 total) as well as the doubles champion from each region (13 total) will qualify for the NCAA Individual Championships through these Regional Championships.

- All Broncos are expected to play. Mahir Khurana is in qualifying starting on Thursday and all other players are in the main draw starting on Friday.

Season Notes

Season

- Various Santa Clara players have played across four tournaments so far this fall.
- At the Battle in the Bay Classic in San Francisco, Alexander Watanabe Eriksson and John Kim played.
- The second tournament was at the ITA Regional All-American Championships where Watanabe Eriksson, Luca Lemaitre and Lukas Maskow participated.
- Last week, at the Intercollegiate Championships, Maskow, Kim, Valentin Faure and Luca Bluett played. While at the UC Davis Aggies Invitational, Lemaitre, Tiago Boschmans and Khurana participated.
- Watanabe Eriksson leads the team with two singles victories.

Team

- Santa Clara is led by head coach Niall Angus who is in his 10th season at the helm and assisted by Josh Page who is in his second season.
- Angus is currently the second winningest coach in Santa Clara men's tennis history with 118 wins entering the 2026 spring dual match season. Sean Burns is the all-time winningest coach with 130 career wins.
- The fall roster is comprised of eight players this fall, all returnees from last season when they finished 15-9 overall including 5-2 in the West Coast Conference. The league record was good for a second place tie.
- Last season, the Broncos were ranked nationally for 11 straight weeks and finished No. 73 nationally, qualifying for the WCC Tournament for the seventh straight season.
- In the mid-major rankings, they finished No. 25 and in the Northwest Regionals rankings, No. 6. Luca Bluett and Kim were ranked No. 8 in the Northwest Regional doubles list.
- Four returners garnered All-WCC recognitions: Bluett and Kim were named to the doubles second team. Bluett also made singles honorable mention along with Watanabe Eriksson and Luca Lemaitre.
- The team lost just one player from last season, Payton Jim-On.

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
