### **Match Notes**

- The Broncos conclude a three game road trip at Oregon State (17-8, 11-4)
- This is the Broncos second meeting with the Beavers this year after falling 3-1 on Oct. 2 at home.
- The Broncos won both matches against the Beavers last season and have won three of the last four contests.
- Santa Clara is 6-5 against Oregon State overall, dating back to their first meeting in 1980.

### **Season Notes**

- The Broncos went 1-1 last week defeating LMU in five sets on Thursday for their seventh straight victory, only to fall 3-0 to Pepperdine on Saturday.
- The win over LMU marked their 10th conference victory, the most WCC wins since 2019.
- Cate Shanahan led the Broncos with 18 kills, her 17th game of the season in double figure
  against the Lions.
- Grace Flanagan had a career high 15 kills, her sixth game this season in double figures
  against LMU, while Morgan Hayes had 16 kills, one shy of her career high set earlier this
  season at San Jose state (9/16).
- Macy Hinshaw totaled 42 assists and a career high 23 digs, for her 12th double-double of the season Thursday.
- Macy Hinshaw won WCC Setter of the Week for the fourth time this season after recording 36 assists against USF and 42 against Pacific, her 15th game this season with 40 or more.
- Hinshaw leads the conference (31st nationally) with 1008 total assists, and is second in assists per set (48th nationally) with 9.88 assists per set.
- The Broncos are second in the WCC in team kills (1,309) and team assists (1,213).
- Lexi Trapani leads the conference with 390 total digs, and is second in the WCC in digs per set (3.82).
- Layla Truitt led the Broncos with 12 kills against Fresno State, hitting an astounding .706, the first Bronco to hit over .700 since Jensen Cunningham hit .706 vs. Stony Brook on Sept. 3. 2016.
- Cate Shanahan obliterated her previous career high of 20 kills, recording 26 against Pepperdine, becoming the first Bronco to have 25 kills or more since Layla Truitt on Nov. 10, 2022. She also added a career best 17 digs at WSU.
- Lexi Trapani hit her career high with 24 digs at Saint Mary's, and Morgan Hayes recorded
  a career high 17 kills against San Jose State. Tia Kapihe also had a career best with 14
  kills against UNLV.
- Hinshaw had a career high 54 assists against Portland, and 23 digs at LMU.
- The Broncos are in their seventh season under the direction of Erin Lindsey.
- Santa Clara returns four starters from a season ago, as well as 11 letterwinners.
- The Broncos brought in four newcomers with transfers Bryn Shankle (TCU) and Hailey Newell (Sonoma State), and two freshmen Ashlynn Reilly and Caitlin Johnson.
- The Broncos brought back four starters including the team's block leader from last season Grace Flanagan, Layla Truitt, Macy Hinshaw, and Cate Shanahan.
- Santa Clara had three players earn All-WCC accolades last season, making it four times over the last six years that they have done so. Two of the three return in 2025. Grace Flanagan and Layla Truitt both earned All-WCC Honorable Mention recognition.
- Grace Flanagan was named to the 2025 Preseason All-WCC team after recording All-WCC Honorable Mention recognition last season.
- Santa Clara had seven players earn All-Academic honors last season, one shy of tying their program record of 8 from 2023.
- Santa Clara was 11-16 overall last season.
