Tournament Notes

- The ITA Sectional Championships will be the last chance for some of the top players from across the country to qualify for the 2025 NCAA Individual Championships.
- The ITA Sectionals will have a draw size of the following, (Singles: 32) (Doubles: 16). From this, six singles players from each section (24) will qualify for the NCAA Singles Championship (semifinalists, two quarterfinal playoff winners). Meanwhile, three doubles teams from each section (12) will qualify for the NCAA Doubles Championship through the Sectional Championships (champion, finalist, third place).

- Three doubles teams and at least two singles players will be competing in the ITA Sectionals.

Season Notes

Season

- Various Santa Clara players have played across five tournaments so far this fall.
- At the Battle in the Bay Classic in San Francisco, Alexander Watanabe Eriksson and John Kim played.
- The second tournament was at the ITA Regional All-American Championships where Watanabe Eriksson, Luca Lemaitre and Lukas Maskow participated.
- At the Intercollegiate Championships, Maskow, Kim, Valentin Faure and Luca Bluett played. While at the UC Davis Aggies Invitational that was played simultaneously as the Intercollegiate Championships, Lemaitre, Tiago Boschmans and Khurana participated.
- And at the ITA Regionals, the whole team played.
- This fall, the team has a 33-26 singles and 8-12 doubles record. Faure, Maskow and Kim leads the team with five singles wins each. In doubles, Bluett, Boschmans, Kim and Lemaitre have three wins apiece.

Team

- Santa Clara is led by head coach Niall Angus who is in his 10th season at the helm and assisted by Josh Page who is in his second season.
- Angus is currently the second winningest coach in Santa Clara men's tennis history with 118 wins entering the 2026 spring dual match season. Sean Burns is the all-time winningest coach with 130 career wins.
- The fall roster is comprised of eight players this fall, all returnees from last season when they finished 15-9 overall including 5-2 in the West Coast Conference. The league record was good for a second place tie.
- Last season, the Broncos were ranked nationally for 11 straight weeks and finished No. 73 nationally, qualifying for the WCC Tournament for the seventh straight season.
- In the mid-major rankings, they finished No. 25 and in the Northwest Regionals rankings, No. 6. Luca Bluett and Kim were ranked No. 8 in the Northwest Regional doubles list.
- Four returners garnered All-WCC recognitions: Bluett and Kim were named to the doubles second team. Bluett also made singles honorable mention along with Watanabe Eriksson and Luca Lemaitre.
- The team lost just one player from last season, Payton Jim-On.

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
