- The newcomers are: transfers Daniella Dimitrova from Baylor, Tian Yu Dong and Jamie Pope both from Saint Mary's, Jillian Roa from Nebraska plus freshmen Juliette Krumholz and Anna Rahman.
- Dimitrova sat out the fall campaign and will be making her Bronco debut in the spring.
- SCU lost five players - Maria Antonova, JennaMarie Gordon, Finley Kalinic, Gabriela Tevez and Varya Zlotnik - from last season's team.

Match/Season Notes

Coming Up:

- Santa Clara hosts No. 12 Stanford in a midweek tilt at the Degheri Tennis Center. The Cardinal feature three players ranked in the ITA singles rankings and three ranked doubles teams.

Last Time Out:

- The Broncos split the road matches at Utah State and Weber State last weekend. The Broncos fell to Utah State 4-3 after leading 3-1 on Saturday. They bounced back on Sunday, beating Weber State 6-1.

Win Totals:

- With a win over the weekend, Santa Clara is now 6-2 on the season matching last season's win total.

Updefeated on Court 4:

- The Broncos have not dropped a match at singles court four all season. Jillian Roa and Anna Rahman are a combined 8-0 on court four with Roa winning seven of those matches.

Stats:

- Roa and Velizara Fileva lead the team with seven singles wins. All of Fileva's victories have come on court three where she is 7-1.
- Fileva and Roa have teamed up to form the doubles one team and is tied for the team lead with a 4-2 record along with Daniella Dimitrova and Tian Yu Dong who are also 4-2.
- Head coach Allie Will-Van Alstyne is 2-0 in season openers, having picked up a win in her head coaching debut last season against the Academy of Art.

Strong Start:

- SCU started the season 3-0 for their best start since 2011. The 2011 squad won their first seven dual matches.

Unlucky Weather:

- The weather affected the match times for four straight scheduled matches (Jan. 25 - Feb. 1) including one postponement and cancelation each along with pushing up the start time in two others.

2024 Fall Season

- Santa Clara played in a total of four tournaments in the fall.
- Newcomer Tian Yu Dong led the team with six singles wins.
- All nine Broncos who played doubles in the fall had at least one win.
