## Santa Clara at Husky Invitational

## Season Notes

- Santa Clara was at the UW Invitational last time out.
- "Another successful trip to the northwest. Kyle and Colin both continue to compete at a high level. They've been able to eliminate the clock and just compete, it's fun to watch. We've had a lot of illness going around the last few weeks and all things considered this was a great trip. Looking forward to coming back for our final indoor meet in two weeks," head coach Felipe Montoro said after the UW Invitational.
- At the UW Preview, Colin Peattie ran 1:53.30 in the 800m, sixth best in program history. Peattie also ran a 4:08.39 in the mile, good for sixth best in program history. Paul Beaven ran the ninth fastest mile in program history at the UW Preview with a time of 4:13.55. Beaven also ran the 3000m in 8:12.46, fifth best in program history. At the UW Invitational, Peattie ran 4:06.16, third in program history. Kyle Berg ran the 5000m in 14:19.58 at the UW Invitational, the fifth fastest indoor time in program history.
- The Broncos have eight newcomers this year. They welcome Jude Alvarez, McCoy Brooks, Kaden Helder, Eric Ortega-Gammill, Liam Papavasiliou, and Daniel Trampe as freshman and Jack Tolbert (Boise State) and Daniel Vaca (LMU) as transfers.
- Last season Nicholas Russell and Alex Scales both qualified for West Regionals.
- Russell qualified in the 10000m with a time of 28:42.97 set at the Stanford Invitational. This is the third year in a row he has qualified in the 10000m.
- Scales qualified in the 800m with a time of 1:48.68 set at the Oxy Invitational. This is the fourth year in a row he has qualified for the regionals in the event.
- Nicholas Russell (7:57.04) and Ian Twyman (7:57.29) broke the program record in the 3000m at the UW Husky Invite in 2024. Russell set the program mark in the in the 10000m at the Stanford Invitational with a time of 28:42.97. Alex Scales set the program record in the 800m with a time of 1:48.64 at the Oxy Invite.
- Santa Clara also had a strong showing in the classroom with five student-athletes honored on the CSC Academic All-District teams. Chilcott (3.606, Biology), Russell (3.675, Public Health Science), Josh Simboli (3.799, Finance), Ishaan Singh (3.693, Management Information Systems), and Twyman (3.672, Neuroscience) were the honorees.
