Match Notes

- Santa Clara (2-1) wraps up its season-opening road trip Sunday at No. 9 UC Davis. The Broncos have opened 2025 with four consecutive road games.
- Santa Clara has only beaten UC Davis once in the team's past 17 meetings over the last 14 years, an 11-10 victory in Santa Clara on April 19, 2014.
- The Broncos have been within four goals of the Aggies three times in the teams' past seven meetings, including a narrow, 7-6, defeat five years ago on Feb. 23, 2019.
- UC Davis has won eight straight over Santa Clara, scoring 11 or more goals in all but one of those games.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara (2-1) split two road games last weekend, beating Fresno Pacific, 14-10, before falling at No. 17 San Jose State, 21-6.
- Santa Clara's 2025 schedule includes games versus 10 different nationally ranked opponents, five games against teams it beat in 2024, and two separate in-season tournaments.
- The Broncos (7-22 in 2024) will play 10 home games in 2025, including four during its annual Bronco Invitational, taking place this season on Feb. 14-16.
- The top four teams in the Golden Coast Conference preseason poll are ranked in both the CWPA and the ACWPC polls. Defending champion Fresno State is ranked as high as No. 7 in the Association of Collegiate Water Polo Coaches poll, with LMU landing at No. 12. GCC Preseason No. 3 Pacific is ranked No. 18 and San Diego State is ranked No. 23.
- Santa Clara graduated each of its top three point scorers from 2024, but it returns each of its next three: **Sydney Maccabe**, **Kate Rodman** and **Megan Chambliss**. Maccabe and Rodman were both second on the team with 24 goals, while Chambliss was third with 16 assists. Maccabe was the team leader with 48 sprint wins and 12 field blocks.

Season Notes

- **Kate Rodman** landed on the all-Golden Coast Conference second team as a sophomore in 2023. She tied for the team lead with 42 goals that season. She tallied 15 assists for a total of 57 points on the year – second-most on the team. The now-senior driver also had 26 steals and 15 drawn exclusions back in that 2023 campaign.
- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team landed a program-record 17 of its student-athletes on the 2024 GCC All-Academic Team, tied for second-most in the conference. The Broncos were only two student-athletes behind San Diego State (19) for the most in the conference and tied with Pacific, who also had 17. Santa Clara's previous high in GCC All-Academic Team members was 15 in 2020. The Broncos had 14 recognized in each of the previous three seasons (2023, '22 and '21).
- The Broncos then collected 15 more all-academic awards from the ACWPC. The Broncos also collected another All-Academic Team award from the ACWPC, its 14th in a row. The team has been tabbed an All-Academic Team by the ACWPC every year since 2011. The team carried a collective cumulative GPA of 3.36 in 2024.
