Match Notes

- Santa Clara plays its first home games of the 2025 season when it hosts its annual Bronco Invitational, starting Friday and running through Sunday.
- The Broncos, coming off of back-to-back games road games versus nationally ranked teams, will take on two more top-25 teams this weekend at home in No. 24 Brown and No. 25 CSUN.
- Santa Clara will face UC Merced for the first time in program history. The Bobcats, currently an NAIA athletics program, will begin its transition to NCAA Division II next school year.
- The Broncos last beat Brown at home on March 29, 2006, a 5-2 decision at what was then called the Leavey Center Pool (now named Sullivan Aquatic Center).
- Santa Clara has gone 2-2 in each of its last two Bronco Invitationals (since 2023), and have gone 5-7 overall in the tournament since 2022. That includes two wins against Cal State Monterey Bay and three defeats versus Brown in the event.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara (2-2) played a single road game last weekend at No. 9 UC Davis, falling 17-6. The Broncos stayed close to the Aggies through the first period, scoring four goals against the Aggies' five to only trail by one after eight minutes of play. UCD pulled away slightly in the second quarter by shutting out the Broncos and tacking on two more goals, but it was still only a three-goal game at halftime, with UC Davis leading, 7-4.
- Santa Clara's 2025 schedule includes games versus 10 different nationally ranked opponents, five games against teams it beat in 2024, and two separate in-season tournaments.
- The Broncos (7-22 in 2024) will play 10 home games in 2025, including four during its annual Bronco Invitational, taking place this weekend. The Broncos are 9-17 at home over the past two seasons (4-7 in 2024, 5-8 in 2023). They haven't had that many home victories in a two-year span since 2017-18, when they also had nine.
- The top four teams in the Golden Coast Conference preseason poll are ranked in both the CWPA and the ACWPC polls. Defending champion Fresno State is ranked as high as No. 7 in the Association of Collegiate Water Polo Coaches poll, with LMU landing at No. 12. GCC Preseason No. 3 Pacific is ranked No. 18 and San Diego State is ranked No. 23.
- Santa Clara graduated each of its top three point scorers from 2024, but it returns each
 of its next three: Sydney Maccabe, Kate Rodman and Megan Chambliss. Maccabe and
 Rodman were both second on the team with 24 goals, while Chambliss was third with 16
 assists. Maccabe was the team leader with 48 sprint wins and 12 field blocks.
- Kate Rodman landed on the all-Golden Coast Conference second team as a sophomore in 2023. She tied for the team lead with 42 goals that season. She tallied 15 assists for a total of 57 points on the year second-most on the team. The now-senior driver also had 26 steals and 15 drawn exclusions back in that 2023 campaign.
- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team landed a programrecord 17 of its student-athletes on the 2024 GCC All-Academic Team, tied for secondmost in the conference. The Broncos were only two student-athletes behind San Diego State (19) for the most in the conference and tied with Pacific, who also had 17. Santa Clara's previous high in GCC All-Academic Team members was 15 in 2020. The Broncos had 14 recognized in each of the previous three seasons (2023, '22 and '21).
- The Broncos then collected 15 more all-academic awards from the ACWPC. The Broncos also collected another All-Academic Team award from the ACWPC, its 14th in a row. The team has been tabbed an All-Academic Team by the ACWPC every year since 2011. The team carried a collective cumulative GPA of 3.36 in 2024.
