Match Notes

- Santa Clara hosts Gold Coast Conference rivals and No. 23 Pacific in its second week of GCC play.
- The Tigers currently sit in fourth place in the GCC with a 2-1 record, having already played three conference games. The Broncos are tied for fifth place in the conference after one week of play.
- Pacific has won 11 consecutive against the Broncos since 2014. In the teams' last meeting, the score was tied through one period and Pacific only led by two after three periods, but the Tigers pulled away in the fourth for a 12-6 win in Stockton, Calif.
- The No. 21 Tigers have won three of their last four games and have scored at least 10 goals in each of their last five, including beating No. 21 California Baptist on Saturday.
- The Broncos have won at least one GCC game in each of the past three seasons. They won two in 2022.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara (4-9) battled last weekend against No. 10 Fresno State but ultimately fell short, 24-8. **Sydney Maccabe** led the Broncos in their game against the Bulldogs with three goals. **Chloe Rizof** individually scored two goals, and **Soph Harvey, Francesca Moynihan, and Kate Rodman** all scored one goal to contribute.
- The Broncos played four tough games at the annual Claremont Convergence in Southern California on Feb. 28 and March 1. The Broncos fell in all four contests despite playing closely with California Lutheran (12-10 final score) and Claremont-Mudd-Scripps (11-6 final score).
- Rizof was Santa Clara's leading scorer at the Claremont Convergence Tournament with seven goals over four games and two days. **Libby Slater** was right behind her with six total goals in the tournament. Rodman had five goals over the weekend.
- Santa Clara's 2025 schedule includes games versus 10 different nationally ranked opponents, five games against teams it beat in 2024, and two separate in-season tournaments.
- The Broncos (7-22 in 2024) will play 10 home games in 2025, including four during its annual Bronco Invitational, which took place on Feb. 14-16. The Broncos are 9-17 at home over the past two seasons (4-7 in 2024, 5-8 in 2023). They haven't had that many home victories in a two-year span since 2017-18, when they also had nine.

Season Notes

- The top four teams in the Golden Coast Conference preseason poll are ranked in both the CWPA and the ACWPC polls. Defending champion Fresno State is ranked as high as No. 6 in the Collegiate Water Polo Association poll, with LMU landing at No. 13. GCC Pre-season No. 3 Pacific is ranked No. 23 and San Diego State is ranked No. 20.
- Santa Clara graduated each of its top three point scorers from 2024, but it returns each of its next three: **Sydney Maccabe**, **Kate Rodman** and **Megan Chambliss**. Maccabe and Rodman were both second on the team with 24 goals, while Chambliss was third with 16 assists. Maccabe was the team leader with 48 sprint wins and 12 field blocks.
- Kate Rodman** currently leads the team in scoring this season with 25 goals, with **Megan Chambliss** following closely behind with 22. **Sydney Maccabe** leads the team in conference goals with three. The team also has a total of 87 assists this season, with the top contributing players being Maccabe (11), **Francesca Moynihan** (10), and **Megan Chambliss** (9).
- Kate Rodman** landed on the all-Golden Coast Conference second team as a sophomore in 2023. She tied for the team lead with 42 goals that season. She tallied 15 assists for a total of 57 points on the year – second-most on the team. The now-senior driver also had 26 steals and 15 drawn exclusions back in that 2023 campaign.
- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team landed a program-record 17 of its student-athletes on the 2024 GCC All-Academic Team, tied for second-most in the conference. The Broncos were only two student-athletes behind San Diego State (19) for the most in the conference and tied with Pacific, who also had 17. Santa Clara's previous high in GCC All-Academic Team members was 15 in 2020. The Broncos had 14 recognized in each of the previous three seasons (2023, '22 and '21).
- The Broncos then collected 15 more all-academic awards from the ACWPC. The Broncos also collected another All-Academic Team award from the ACWPC, its 14th in a row. The team has been tabbed an All-Academic Team by the ACWPC every year since 2011. The team carried a collective cumulative GPA of 3.36 in 2024.
