- Santa Clara is led by second year head coach Allie Will-Van Alstyne and assisted by Connor Van Alstyne, also in his second season.
- Last year, the Broncos improved by six games in coach Will-Van Alstyne's first season from the previous season.
- The roster is comprised of 10 players this fall with four returnees and six newcomers.
- The returnees are: seniors Kacey Feng, Velizara Fileva and Olivia Wiese as well as junior Anna Semler.
- The newcomers are: transfers Daniella Dimitrova from Baylor, Tian Yu Dong and Jamie Pope both from Saint Mary's, Jillian Roa from Nebraska plus freshmen Juliette Krumholz and Anna Rahman.
- Dimitrova sat out the fall campaign and will be making her Bronco debut in the spring.
- SCU lost five players - Maria Antonova, JennaMarie Gordon, Finley Kalinic, Gabriela Tevez and Varya Zlotnik - from last season's team.

Match/Season Notes

Coming Up:

- Santa Clara opens West Coast Conference play at home against LMU on Sunday. LMU plays their WCC opener a day earlier on Saturday against Portland in Los Angeles. The Broncos will look to snap out of their six match losing streak with four of those coming against ranked opponents.

Last Time Out:

- SCU lost 7-0 against No. 56 Cal Poly on the road last weekend in a make up match from Jan. 26 that was postponed due to rain

Win Totals:

- Santa Clara is 6-8 on the season and one win shy of eclipsing last season's win total.

Courts 3 & 4 Dominance:

- At No. 3 & 4 in the singles lineup, the Bronco players are a combined 19-7. Velizara Fileva is 9-2 at No. 3 and Jillian Roa and is also 9-2 at No. 4.

Doubles Play:

- In each of the eight losses this spring, the Broncos have dropped the doubles point. Four of those losses have been by a 4-3 score.

Stats:

- Fileva and Roa leads the team with nine singles wins. In the against Cal State Fullerton, Roa's nine match win streak at No. 4 was snapped.
- Daniella Dimitrova leads the team with six doubles wins this spring. Four of them while paired with Tian Yu Dong and two with Anna Rahman.

Strong Start:

- SCU started the season 3-0 for their best start since 2011. The 2011 squad won their first seven dual matches.

Unlucky Weather:

- The weather affected the match times for four straight scheduled matches (Jan. 25 - Feb. 1) including one postponement and cancelation each along with pushing up the start time in two others. It also impacted the match against Stanford (Feb. 19) with a couple of rain delays but was eventually completed after five and a half hours.

2024 Fall Season

- Santa Clara played in a total of four tournaments in the fall.
- Newcomer Tian Yu Dong led the team with six singles wins.
- All nine Broncos who played doubles in the fall had at least one win.
