Match Notes

- Santa Clara takes a break this weekend from Gold Coast Conference play to host its annual Alumni Game on Saturday before welcoming No. 13 Harvard on Sunday.
- Harvard has beaten the Broncos six consecutive times since 2015, with four of those victories coming at Sullivan Aquatic Center. Three of those games were decided by three goals or fewer, though the Crimson's last two victories have been by an average of 12 goals.
- Santa Clara last defeated the Crimson on March 9, 2014, in its own Harvard Invitational. The Broncos won the game, 9-7, after being tied, 4-4, at halftime.
- Harvard is the second Ivy League team the Broncos are facing at home this season, having already played against then-No. 24 Brown on Feb. 15 in a 16-5 defeat.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara (4-10, 0-2 GCC) stayed close to No. 23 Pacific early on Saturday, but a strong third period from the Tigers swung the game in their favor, as they downed the Broncos, 14-7, in a GCC game at Sullivan Aquatic Center.

Libby Slater had a hat trick on the day for the Broncos with three goals, all of them in the second half. Slater scored twice in the fourth period as the Broncos outscored the Tigers in the final period, 3-2. But it wasn't enough to overcome the Tigers' 6-1 offensive surge in the third period which put them up, 12-4, through three.

• Santa Clara (4-9) battled on March 8 against No. 10 Fresno State but ultimately fell short, 24-8. **Sydney Maccabe** led the Broncos in that game with three goals. **Chloe Rizof** individually scored two goals, and **Soph Harvey, Francesca Moynihan, and Kate Rodman** all scored one goal to contribute.

• Santa Clara's 2025 schedule includes games versus 10 different nationally ranked opponents, five games against teams it beat in 2024, and two separate in-season tournaments.

• The Broncos (7-22 in 2024) are playing 10 home games in 2025, including four during its annual Bronco Invitational, which took place on Feb. 14-16. The Broncos are 9-17 at home over the past two seasons (4-7 in 2024, 5-8 in 2023). They haven't had that many home victories in a two-year span since 2017-18, when they also had nine.

Season Notes

- The top four teams in the Golden Coast Conference preseason poll are ranked in both the CWPA and the ACWPC polls. Defending champion Fresno State is ranked as high as No. 6 in the Collegiate Water Polo Association poll, with LMU landing at No. 13. GCC Preseason No. 3 Pacific is ranked No. 23 and San Diego State is ranked No. 20.
- Santa Clara graduated each of its top three point scorers from 2024, but it returns each of its next three: **Sydney Maccabe**, **Kate Rodman** and **Megan Chambliss**. Maccabe and Rodman were both second on the team with 24 goals, while Chambliss was third with 16 assists. Maccabe was the team leader with 48 sprint wins and 12 field blocks.
- Kate Rodman** currently leads the team in scoring this season with 26 goals, with **Megan Chambliss** following closely behind with 22. **Sydney Maccabe** leads the team in conference goals with five. The team also has a total of 93 assists this season, with the top contributing players being **Francesca Moynihan** (12), Maccabe (11), and Chambliss (10).
- Kate Rodman** landed on the all-Golden Coast Conference second team as a sophomore in 2023. She tied for the team lead with 42 goals that season. She tallied 15 assists for a total of 57 points on the year – second-most on the team. The now-senior driver also had 26 steals and 15 drawn exclusions back in that 2023 campaign.
- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team landed a program-record 17 of its student-athletes on the 2024 GCC All-Academic Team, tied for second-most in the conference. The Broncos were only two student-athletes behind San Diego State (19) for the most in the conference and tied with Pacific, who also had 17. Santa Clara's previous high in GCC All-Academic Team members was 15 in 2020. The Broncos had 14 recognized in each of the previous three seasons (2023, '22 and '21).
- The Broncos then collected 15 more all-academic awards from the ACWPC. The Broncos also collected another All-Academic Team award from the ACWPC, its 14th in a row. The team has been tabbed an All-Academic Team by the ACWPC every year since 2011. The team carried a collective cumulative GPA of 3.36 in 2024.
