Match Notes

- Santa Clara kicks off Golden Coast Conference play Saturday at home when it hosts two-time defending champion and No. 10-ranked Fresno State.
- Fresno State has defeated the Broncos seven consecutive times dating back to 2018. That streak includes four straight wins in Santa Clara.
- The Bulldogs have scored no fewer than 15 goals in each of the teams' last six meetings, and have won the last five games by no fewer than 13 goals with an average margin of victory of 15.2 goals.
- The Broncos have won at least one GCC game in each of the past three seasons. They won two in 2022.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara (4-8) played four tough games last weekend at the annual Claremont Convergence in Southern California. The Broncos dropped all four contests despite playing closely with California Lutheran (12-10 final score) and Claremont-Mudd-Scripps (11-6 final score).
- **Chloe Rizof** led Santa Clara last weekend in scoring at the Claremont Convergence Tournament with seven goals over four games and two days. **Libby Slater** was right behind her with six total goals in the tournament. **Kate Rodman** had five goals over the weekend.
- Santa Clara's 2025 schedule includes games versus 10 different nationally ranked opponents, five games against teams it beat in 2024, and two separate in-season tournaments.
- The Broncos (7-22 in 2024) will play 10 home games in 2025, including four during its annual Bronco Invitational, taking place this weekend. The Broncos are 9-17 at home over the past two seasons (4-7 in 2024, 5-8 in 2023). They haven't had that many home victories in a two-year span since 2017-18, when they also had nine.
- The top four teams in the Golden Coast Conference preseason poll are ranked in both the CWPA and the ACWPC polls. Defending champion Fresno State is ranked as high as No. 6 in the Collegiate Water Polo Association poll, with LMU landing at No. 13. GCC Preseason No. 3 Pacific is ranked No. 23 and San Diego State is ranked No. 20.
- Santa Clara graduated each of its top three point scorers from 2024, but it returns each of its next three: **Sydney Maccabe**, **Kate Rodman** and **Megan Chambliss**. Maccabe and Rodman were both second on the team with 24 goals, while Chambliss was third with 16 assists.

Season Notes

Maccabe was the team leader with 48 sprint wins and 12 field blocks.

- **Kate Rodman** landed on the all-Golden Coast Conference second team as a sophomore in 2023. She tied for the team lead with 42 goals that season. She tallied 15 assists for a total of 57 points on the year – second-most on the team. The now-senior driver also had 26 steals and 15 drawn exclusions back in that 2023 campaign.

- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team landed a program-record 17 of its student-athletes on the 2024 GCC All-Academic Team, tied for second-most in the conference. The Broncos were only two student-athletes behind San Diego State (19) for the most in the conference and tied with Pacific, who also had 17. Santa Clara's previous high in GCC All-Academic Team members was 15 in 2020. The Broncos had 14 recognized in each of the previous three seasons (2023, '22 and '21).

- The Broncos then collected 15 more all-academic awards from the ACWPC. The Broncos also collected another All-Academic Team award from the ACWPC, its 14th in a row. The team has been tabbed an All-Academic Team by the ACWPC every year since 2011. The team carried a collective cumulative GPA of 3.36 in 2024.
