Match Notes

- Santa Clara wraps up its final home stand of the season this weekend with a Golden Coast Conference game Saturday versus California Baptist and its second meeting this season versus Fresno Pacific on Sunday for Senior Day.
- California Baptist and the Broncos have split their last four meetings, with the Lancers winning the last two and Santa Clara winning in 2022 and 2023.
- 11 of CBU and Santa Clara's meetings since 2009 have been decided by only one goal. The Broncos have won seven of those, including their last win over the Lancers, a 12-11 victory on April 13, 2023, at Sullivan Aquatic Center.
- Santa Clara hasn't lost to Fresno Pacific in 21 consecutive meetings, dating to 2009. That includes four wins when the teams were both members of the Wester Water Polo Association. The Broncos beat FPU, 14-10, on Feb. 1, in Fresno earlier this season.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara (5-14, 0-5 GCC) got off to a quick start Saturday but ultimately fell to No. 20 San Diego State, 14-10, at Sullivan Aquatic Center. Kate Rodman led the way for the Broncos with three goals and Libby Slater scored twice with five other Broncos finding the back of the net once. Nine Aztecs (14-11, 4-2 GCC) scored, led by three goals from Megan Holcomb with three others scoring twice each.
- · The Broncos will honor six seniors Sunday before their non-conference game versus Fresno Pacific, their final home game of the season, and the six seniors' final home game as members of the program. Nina Damjanac, Sophia Harvey, Francesca Moynihan, Stephanie Nelson, Rodman and Slater will all be honored in a pregame ceremony. The six have combined to play in 434 games for the Broncos and score 210 goals.

Season Notes

• In their domination of Occidental on March 30, the Broncos jumped out to an early lead with seven goals in the first period alone. They'd nearly double that with six more in the second period while blanking the Tigers to take a 13-3 lead into halftime. The Broncos scored four goals in both the third and fourth periods, while limiting Occidental to only one goal in the third and three in the fourth.

Megan Chambliss led the Broncos with four goals in that game, while Rodman tallied three goals. It was Chambliss' second multi-goal game in as many days after scoring two on March 29 at LMU. Makenna Genco, Sydney Maccabe and Slater each scored twice. Annika Burks, Evelyn McLaughlin, Moynihan, Avary Torres, Khloe Tarbet, Mia Barkett, Chloe Rizof and Harvey all scored once.

- Rodman currently leads the team in scoring this season with 33 goals. Chambliss follows closely behind with 30, while holding the team points lead at 43. Maccabe leads the team in conference goals with nine. The team also has a total of 117 assists this season, with the top contributing players being Moynihan (18), Maccabe (13), and Chambliss (13).
- Several Broncos rank among the GCC's top-10 in multiple defensive categories.
 Sydney Maccabe is eighth in the conference with 13 field blocks. Kate Rodman is 11th in the GCC with 25 steals. Goalkeeper Haley Tassell ranks seventh with 103 saves this season and seventh with 5.4 saves per game.
- Santa Clara's 2025 schedule includes games versus 10 different nationally ranked opponents, five games against teams it beat in 2024, and two separate in-season tournaments.
- The Broncos (7-22 in 2024) are playing 10 home games in 2025, including four during its annual Bronco Invitational, which took place on Feb. 14-16. The Broncos are 9-17 at home over the past two seasons (4-7 in 2024, 5-8 in 2023). They haven't had that many home victories in a two-year span since 2017-18, when they also had nine.
- The top four teams in the Golden Coast Conference preseason poll are ranked in both the CWPA and the ACWPC polls. Defending champion Fresno State is ranked as high as No. 8 in the Collegiate Water Polo Association poll, with LMU landing at No. 9. GCC Preseason No. 3 Pacific is ranked No. 25 and San Diego State is ranked No. 20.
- Santa Clara graduated each of its top three point scorers from 2024, but it returns each of its next three: Sydney Maccabe, Kate Rodman and Megan Chambliss.
 Maccabe and Rodman were both second on the team with 24 goals, while Chambliss was third with 16 assists. Maccabe was the team leader with 48 sprint wins and 12 field blocks.
- **Kate Rodman** landed on the all-Golden Coast Conference second team as a sophomore in 2023. She tied for the team lead with 42 goals that season. She tallied 15 assists for a total of 57 points on the year second-most on the team. The now-senior driver also had 26 steals and 15 drawn exclusions back in that 2023 campaign.
- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team landed a program-record 17 of its student-athletes on the 2024 GCC All-Academic Team, tied for second-most in the conference. The Broncos were only two student-athletes behind San Diego State (19) for the most in the conference and tied with Pacific, who also had 17. Santa Clara's previous high in GCC All-Academic Team members was 15 in 2020. The Broncos had 14 recognized in each of the previous three seasons (2023, '22 and '21).
- The Broncos then collected 15 more all-academic awards from the ACWPC. The Broncos also collected another All-Academic Team award from the ACWPC, its 14th in a row. The team has been tabbed an All-Academic Team by the ACWPC every year since 2011. The team carried a collective cumulative GPA of 3.36 in 2024.
