Series Notes

- Santa Clara wraps up its four-game home stand with a non-conference midweek matchup Tuesday night versus Big West Conference member Cal Poly.
- The Broncos have dominated their series versus the Mustangs as of late, winning nine of the last 12 meetings (since 2018). Their last three losses in the series have all come on the road in San Luis Obispo (dating to 2017). Cal Poly beat the Broncos, 1-0, two weeks ago on April 15 in San Luis Obispo.
- This season's midweek home-and-home series between Cal Poly and Santa Clara marks the fourth consecutive such series (since 2022). They've split the series twice in the past three years, with the Broncos sweeping both games in 2023.
- Seven of the Broncos' last nine wins over the Mustangs have come by three runs or fewer, including two by one run in extra innings.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara (16-23, 5-10 WCC) dropped its fourth consecutive weekend series and fifth in its last six by narrowly being edged twice in three games versus Pacific. The Tigers clipped the Broncos, 5-4, in game one Friday. Santa Clara hit two home runs in Friday's opener and brought the tying run to the plate in the ninth, but went 1 for 8 with runners in scoring position. Saturday, the Broncos had the tying run in scoring position in the ninth inning but couldn't get it home, falling 9-8. Santa Clara won the series finale, 7-2, thanks to five early runs and an outstanding start on the mound from Cooper Lanz.
- **Dylan Joyce** put together a standout week at the plate for Santa Clara last week, hitting .417 (5 for 12) with a 1.250 slugging percentage and 15 total bases over three games against Pacific. He blasted three home runs and a double, drove in four runs, and scored four times. Joyce delivered multiple hits in back-to-back games, highlighted by a two-homer, three-RBI performance on Saturday. It was his first multihome run game as a Bronco. Defensively, Joyce was flawless at first base, recording 25 putouts without an error for a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage and helping turn four double plays, including an unassisted one on Saturday.
- Sophomore shortstop **Ben Cleary** had a season-long 16-game reached base safely streak snapped on April 17 at LMU, but he's still reached safely in 36 of his 38 games played this season. Cleary's on-base percentage sits just under .400 at .399. He's second on the team with 42 hits, third with 20 walks and tied for fourth with five hit-by-pitches. He's currently on a five-game hit streak, batting .333 with seven runs.
