Match Notes

- Santa Clara begins its final home stand of the season, a stretch of three games, on Saturday when it hosts No. 20 San Diego State in a Golden Coast Conference clash.
- San Diego State has won 13 in a row over the Broncos, but they haven't all come easy. Six of the teams' last nine meetings have been decided by five or fewer goals. That includes four determined by three goals or fewer.
- The Broncos last defeated then-No. 9-ranked San Diego State on Feb. 8, 2014, in a neutral-site matchup at UC San Diego. The Broncos were ranked No. 20 at the time.
- The Aztecs have beaten the Broncos at least five consecutive times at home, dating to 2015.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara (5-13, 0-4 GCC) went 1-2 on its Southern California road trip last weekend, dropping two GCC games before dominating Occidental College on Sunday, 21-7. The Broncos fell to Azusa Pacific, 18-10, on Friday, and No. 12 LMU, 17-7, on Saturday. **Makenna Genco** logged her first career multi-goal game at APU on Friday, scoring twice. Fellow freshman **Chloe Rizof** scored three times in that game, all in the second half. **Megan Chambliss** and **Sydney Maccabe** notched multi-goal games on Saturday at No. 12 LMU.
- In their domination of Occidental on Sunday, the Broncos jumped out to an early lead with seven goals in the first period alone. They'd nearly double that with six more in the second period while blanking the Tigers to take a 13-3 lead into halftime. The Broncos scored four goals in both the third and fourth periods, while limiting Occidental to only one goal in the third and three in the fourth.

Chambliss led the Broncos with four goals, while Kate Rodman tallied three goals. It was Chambliss' second multi-goal game in as many days after scoring two Saturday at LMU. Genco, Maccabe and **Libby Slater** each scored twice. **Annika Burks**, **Evelyn McLaughlin**, **Francesca Moynihan**, **Avary Torres**, **Khloe Tarbet**, **Mia Barkett**, **Rizof** and **Sophia Harvey** all scored once.

Season Notes

- **Kate Rodman** currently leads the team in scoring this season with 30 goals. **Megan Chambliss** follows closely behind with 29, while holding the team points lead at 39. **Sydney Maccabe** leads the team in conference goals with eight. The team also has a total of 109 assists this season, with the top contributing players being **Francesca Moynihan** (14), **Maccabe** (13), and **Chambliss** (10).

- Several Broncos rank among the GCC's top-10 in multiple defensive categories. **Sydney Maccabe** is tied for fourth in the conference with 12 field blocks. **Kate Rodman** is tied for seventh in the GCC with 25 steals. Goalkeeper **Haley Tassell** ranks seventh with 95 saves this season and seventh with 5.3 saves per game.

- Santa Clara's 2025 schedule includes games versus 10 different nationally ranked opponents, five games against teams it beat in 2024, and two separate in-season tournaments.

- The Broncos (7-22 in 2024) are playing 10 home games in 2025, including four during its annual Bronco Invitational, which took place on Feb. 14-16. The Broncos are 9-17 at home over the past two seasons (4-7 in 2024, 5-8 in 2023). They haven't had that many home victories in a two-year span since 2017-18, when they also had nine.

- The top four teams in the Golden Coast Conference preseason poll are ranked in both the CWPA and the ACWPC polls. Defending champion Fresno State is ranked as high as No. 8 in the Collegiate Water Polo Association poll, with LMU landing at No. 9. GCC Preseason No. 3 Pacific is ranked No. 25 and San Diego State is ranked No. 20.

- Santa Clara graduated each of its top three point scorers from 2024, but it returns each of its next three: **Sydney Maccabe**, **Kate Rodman** and **Megan Chambliss**. Maccabe and Rodman were both second on the team with 24 goals, while Chambliss was third with 16 assists. Maccabe was the team leader with 48 sprint wins and 12 field blocks.

- **Kate Rodman** landed on the all-Golden Coast Conference second team as a sophomore in 2023. She tied for the team lead with 42 goals that season. She tallied 15 assists for a total of 57 points on the year – second-most on the team. The now-senior driver also had 26 steals and 15 drawn exclusions back in that 2023 campaign.

- Santa Clara raked in the academic awards last school year. The team landed a program-record 17 of its student-athletes on the 2024 GCC All-Academic Team, tied for second-most in the conference. The Broncos were only two student-athletes behind San Diego State (19) for the most in the conference and tied with Pacific, who also had 17. Santa Clara's previous high in GCC All-Academic Team members was 15 in 2020. The Broncos had 14 recognized in each of the previous three seasons (2023, '22 and '21).

- The Broncos then collected 15 more all-academic awards from the ACWPC. The Broncos also collected another All-Academic Team award from the ACWPC, its 14th in a row. The team has been tabbed an All-Academic Team by the ACWPC every year since 2011. The team carried a collective cumulative GPA of 3.36 in 2024.
