Game Notes

- The No. 14 Santa Clara University men's water polo team heads to Southern California for the Overnght MPSF Invitational, starting Friday. They'll play four games there across three days, opening with No. 5 Stanford on Friday. They'll take on either No. 7 Long Beach State or No. 15 California Baptist to open Saturday's play, depending on the results of Friday's games
- Santa Clara hasn't beaten Stanford in at least its last 18 tries (since 2008). The two
 programs faced each other last season at Stanford's Avery Aquatics Center, with the
 Cardinal taking a 19-9 victory.
- Santa Clara is playing in the MPSF Invitational for the first time since 2023 and has participated in the MPSF Invitational in three of the last four years (excluding 2024). The Broncos went a combined 3-5 in the 2022 and '23 tournaments.

Season Notes

- No. 14 Santa Clara hosted its first home contest of the season Saturday, though not an official game, using the exhibition versus American River College as a "dry run" for its first home games coming at the end of September and beginning of October. The Broncos beat the Beavers, 22-6, getting goals from 14 different players.
- Santa Clara climbed to No. 14 in Wednesday's Association of Collegiate Water Polo Coaches national top-20 poll. It equals the highest it climbed last season in the Oct. 2, 2024, ACWPC poll after defeating then-No. 13 UC Davis on the road on Sept. 27, 2024.
 The Broncos were ranked No. 15 in Wednesday's CWPA national top-20 poll, rising one spot from the previous week

Season Notes

- Freshmen powered Santa Clara to its most goals in a game in at least 18 years on Opening Day at UC Merced on Aug. 29. Rookies Imme van der Schaaf, Ashton Brown, Beck Early, Jamie De Zwart and Weston Bancroft all shined in their collegiate debuts with multi-goal games, leading the Broncos to a a dominating, 26-3, victory. Van der Schaaf led SCU with four goals, Brown scored three, while Early, De Zwart and redshirt freshman Weston Bancroft all scored two each.
- Santa Clara finished fifth in the West Coast Conference a year ago, posted its first over-.500 record in five years and nearly upset eventual WCC Tournament champion California Baptist in the first round of the tourney. The Broncos won 13 games last season and have won double-digit games in four consecutive years and six straight when not including the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season.
- Riccardo De Simon was named to the WCC Preseason Team on Aug. 22. De Simon quickly established himself last year as one of the WCC's top all-around players. He earned All-American Honorable Mention from the Association of Collegiate Water Polo Coaches, all-WCC Honorable Mention, and was named WCC Newcomer of the Week three times in his debut season. He also excelled in the classroom, earning AC-WPC All-Academic "Superior" honors and a spot on the WCC Commissioner's Honor Roll with "Bronze" accolades.
- De Simon leads the WCC in steals (20) and sprint wins (11) through the first three weeks of the season. He's also tied for seventh in the conference with 19 goals.
- Santa Clara returns two of its top-three point scorers from a year ago in De Simon (77 total points) and **Henry Engs** (61 total points). De Simon was the Broncos' second-leading scorer with 51 goals, while Engs was No. 2 in assists with 36.
- The Broncos also return starting goalkeeper Harrison Labrosse, who totaled 363 saves across his first two seasons. He also brought 22 career steals and 20 games of 10 or more saves into 2025. Labrosse is already off to a hot start this season with three double-digit saves performances and 54 saves overall -- third in the WCC.
- Santa Clara head coach **Keith Wilbur** reached his 300th career men's water polo win last season thanks to a 14-12 win at No. 13 UC Davis on Sept. 27, 2024. He's earned all 300 of his wins at the helm of the Broncos' program. Wilbur is in his 24th season as head coach of the program and is the winningest coach in program history. He began his tenure at Santa Clara in the fall of 2002.

- The Broncos (13-10 in 2024) finished 2024 ranked 18th in the final ACWPC poll. Santa Clara has 13 matches scheduled in 2024 against teams ranked in the CWPA preseason top-20 poll, including showdowns against top-10 teams like its battle versus No. 4 Fordham on Sept. 7, two upcoming clashes versus Stanford (No. 5) on Friday and Nov. 5, and one against Long Beach State (No. 7) on Oct. 11. They'll also face San Jose State (No. 6) and Pacific (No. 10) in conference play.
- All seven members of the WCC received votes in the CWPA preseason national poll, with six of them earning placement in the poll. WCC Preseason Coaches' Poll favorite San Jose State was tabbed No. 10. Pepperdine was the highest-ranked WCC member at No. 7. Pacific landed at No. 9, California Baptist was No. 13, LMU was placed at No. 16, and the Broncos came in at No. 18. Air Force earned two votes in the CWPA poll.
