## Tournament Notes

- The ITA All-American Championships serves as one of the qualifying tournaments for the NCAA individual championships. The NCAA men's singles and doubles championships will be held Nov. 18-23, 2025 in Orlando, Florida.
- The All-American Championships will have a draw size of the following, Singles: Pre-Qualifying (160), Qualifying (64), Main Draw (64) and Doubles: Pre-Qualifying (32), Qualifying (32), Main Draw (32). From this, ten singles players (10) will qualify for the NCAA Singles Championship (eight main draw quarterfinalists & two feed-in consolation finalists). Meanwhile, four doubles teams (4) will qualify for the NCAA Doubles Championship through the All-American Championships (four main draw semifinalists).
- Three Broncos - Alexander Watanabe Eriksson, Luca Lemaitre and Lukas Maskow - will be playing in the pre-qualifying rounds.

## Season Notes

### Season

- Santa Clara opened the fall season last weekend at the Battle in the Bay Classic in San Francisco. Alexander Watanabe Eriksson and John Kim played in a total of two doubles and five singles matches coming up with a pair of singles victories.
- The remainder of the fall schedule as well as the 2026 spring schedule will be released at a later date.

### Team

- Santa Clara is led by head coach Niall Angus who is in his 10th season at the helm and assisted by Josh Page who is in his second season.
- The fall roster is comprised of eight players this fall who all return from last season when they finished 15-9 overall including 5-2 in the West Coast Conference. The league record was good for a second place tie.
- Last season, the Broncos were ranked nationally for 11 straight weeks and finished No. 73 nationally, qualifying for the WCC Tournament for the seventh straight season.
- In the mid-major rankings, they finished No. 25 and in the Northwest Regionals rankings, No. 6. Luca Bluett and Kim were ranked No. 8 in the Northwest Regional doubles list.
- Four returners garnered All-WCC recognitions: Bluett and Kim were named to the doubles second team. Bluett also made singles honorable mention along with Watanabe Eriksson and Luca Lemaitre.
- The team lost just one player from last season, Payton Jim-On.
