#### **Tournament Notes**

- Fresh off a fantastic start to the fall season, the Broncos return to action at the William H.
   Tucker Intercollegiate in Albuquerque on Sept. 19-20.
- The Broncos are playing in the Tucker for the third-consecutive season. Last year they shot 13-over 877 to take seventh place.
- This year's field features 18 teams: New Mexico (host), Santa Clara, Arkansas State, Colorado, Colorado State, Eastern Michigan, Fresno State, Grand Canyon, Long Beach State, New Mexico State, North Texas, Oral Roberts, Rice, San Francisco, Stetson, Tarleton State, USC and UTEP
- Fresh off the best outing of his collegiate career, Calder Overfelt will be in the No. 1 spot followed by Matt Robles, J.P. Odland, Kevin Hollomon and Jack Hayden. Emil Nielsen is set to make his first appearance of the season as an individual.

#### **Season Notes**

- The Broncos finished runner-up at the season-opening Palouse Collegiate where they turned in one of the top team and individual performances in program history.
- SCU turned in multiple scores that rank inside the program's top five all time with their 54-hole total of 39-under 813 standing in a tie for the second-lowest score to par in program history.
- Calder Overfelt was sensational with a whopping 14-under 199 total tied for the thirdlowest score to par in program history. He finished runner-up, just one stroke behind the medalist
- Matt Robles was hot on Overfelt's heels at 11-under 202 to take fourth place. The score tied for his career low.
- J.P. Odland tied for ninth, moving him up to sixth on the program's top-10 list for top-10 finishes with nine. He turned in a career-low 8-under 68 in the final round, tied for the fourth-lowest round in program history.

### 2024-25 Recap

- The Broncos are coming off one of their most successful seasons in program history. The
  team shattered the program season scoring record (283.72 strokes), had three All-WCC
  honorees (most since 2018) and qualfied for the NCAA Tournament for just the third time
  in program history.
- Other highlights from the historic 2024-25 season:
  - SCU placed fifth or better in eight of their 13 events.
  - The Broncos finished the regular season ranked 45th in the National Collegiate Golf Rankings their best finish in program history.
  - SCU shattered the program's 54-hole record at the WCC Championship with a 26-under 838 to finish stroke play in third place. The advanced to match play for the first time in program history.
  - SCU turned in the third-best score-to-par performance in program history at the Alister Mackenzie Invitational, shooting 37-under 815.
- Santa Clara returns four of their top five scorers from a year ago J.P. Odland (70.92), Matt Robles (71.52), Emil Nielsen (72.56) and Calder Overfelt (72.87).
- Odland had one of the finest individual seasons in program history in 2024-25. His
  70.92 scoring average ranks fourth-best in program history, he became the first player in
  program history to win multiple events (he tied for medalist honors at both the Myrtle
  Beach Golf Trips Intercollegiate and The Goodwin), he tied the program record for rounds
  in the 60s (15) and the second-most rounds under par (20).
- Odland shot 15-under 198 at the Alister Mackenzie Invitational to tie Hayden Shieh for the lowest score-to-par in program history.
- Matt Robles also had a fantastic campaign as a freshman, finishing the year second on the team in scoring (71.52) and earning both All-WCC and WCC Freshman of the Year honors. He tied Odland for the team-lead with five top-10 finishes (tied for seventh-most in program history).
