Tournament Notes

- The Broncos will stick around the Evergreen State for their second tournament in as many weeks to open the fall. SCU is looking to carry over the same success from their first outing where they turned in a program top-10 team score en route to a championship title.
- Santa Clara is a usual participant at the Pat Lesser Harbottle Invitational having played in the event in six of the last seven seasons. SCU tied for fourth last season with a 6-over 870 total.
- Santa Clara will stick with same lineup that brought home the Kalispel Invitational Trophy - Audrey Brust, Kelsey Kim, Chloe Lam, Alexa Pineda and Proud Sriwongngam.
- The Broncos are one of 15 teams that will make up the field for the 2025 Pat Lesser Harbottle joining host-Seattle, Weber State, Northern Colorado, Idaho, Utah Valley, UC Riverside, Eastern Washington, Grand Canyon, Montana, British Columbia, Gonzaga, Portland State, North Dakota State and Fresno State.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara couldn't have asked for a better start to their 2025 fall season. The Broncos won the Kalispel Invitational by 10 strokes for the 19th team title under head coach Krystal Kelly.
- The Broncos posted top-10 marks in program history in all three major team categories:
 - 7th lowest individual round - 284 (-4)
 - 8th lowest 36-hole total - 579 (+3)
 - 6th lowest 54-hole total - 868 (+4)
- Junior Kelsey Kim had the best outing of her career with a career-low 4-under 212 total. The tally is tied for the sixth-best in program history.
- Kim finished second overall, which is also the best finish of her career.
- Audrey Brust tied for eighth to move up in the career standings for top-20 finishes (6th with 18), top-10 finishes (8th with seven), rounds under par (4th with 12) and rounds played (5th with 99).
- Kim has 11 rounds under par for her career, good for the 6th most in program history just behind Brust.

2024-25 Recap

- Santa Clara ended the season on a high note by capturing the 2025 National Golf Invitational team title. It was the Broncos' first tournament win since the 2022 season.
- The Broncos quietly put together the best team scoring average in program history, besting their 2023-24 record with a collective 295.67 strokes per round.
- Kelsey Kim was the best of the bunch with a 73.88 average (second-best in program history) and logged a team-best seven top-20 finishes as a sophomore.
- Chloe Lam had a fantastic freshman season, finishing with a the eighth-best scoring average in program history at 74.37 strokes. She was the Broncos' top finisher at the WCC Championship, tying the program record in the tournament of 3-over 219 to finish in a tie for fifth. For her efforts, she was honored as an All-WCC performer.
- With a 74.40 average of 62 career appearances, Kim currently holds the best career scoring average in program history, just ahead of Borina Sutkito (74.56) and Claire Choi (74.95).
- Audrey Brust, entering her senior campaign, is also one of the top players in program history, ranking fifth in career scoring average at 75.29 strokes over 96 rounds. Her 11 career rounds under par also rank fifth-most in the program's history.
