Match Notes

- Santa Clara and Grand Canyon meet for the fourth time on Monday night.
- GCU is 3-1 on the year and close out their five-game homestand against Santa Clara.
- The Lopes and the Broncos have played two common opponents this year in Cleveland State and Sacramento State. Grand Canyon won both matches, 3-1 and 2-1 while Santa Clara tied Cleveland State 1-1 and beat Sac State 3-0.
- GCU is comprised of 13 returnees from a team that finished 5-10-3 last season and add 17 newcomers under second year head coach George Kiefer.
- Junior midfielder Jorge Lopez and graduate forward Ben Assane earned spots on the preseason All-WAC Team. They combined for 10 assists (five each) and four goals last season
- The Lopes were picked to finish sixth in the WAC among eight teams.

Season Notes

- Santa Clara is coming off a 2-0 blanking of San Diego State on Friday night behind a pair of goals by Niv Berkovitz and a four-save shutout by goalkeeper Jackson Ozburn.
- The Broncos have recorded back-to-back shutout wins for the first time since 2022 when they beat Grand Canyon (Sept. 9) and Utah Tech (Sept. 12).
- Goalkeeper [Jackson Ozburn was named WCC Defensive Player of the Week](#) on Sept. 1 for his efforts against No. 4 Stanford and Sacramento State, recording a total of eight saves to go along with a shutout.
- Over the last two matches, Ozburn has seven saves to record a pair of shutouts. He has three career clean sheets.
- The Broncos started the 2025 campaign with a pair of 1-all draws, against Cleveland State on the road and against UC Davis in the home opener. In both contests, the Broncos came back after allowing the first goal.
- It is the first time in program history to open the season with two draws.
- SCU got off to strong starts in the last three games against Stanford, Sacramento State and San Diego State, scoring the first goal in each game, all coming in the opening 45 minutes. Against the Cardinal, the Broncos conceded a pair of second half goals and lost 2-1 while against the Hornets, they added two goals in the back half to win convincingly 3-0. SCU scored a second half goal against SDSU in their 2-0 victory.
- In the UC Davis game, the Broncos leveled the game in the 89th minute on a header by Berkovitz. It was the fourth match that was decided in the final two minutes since the start of the 2024 season. In the 2024 season opener, Florian Deletiglu scored the game winner in the 88th minute against UC San Diego. Itamar Efrat tallied the game winner with two seconds left in the match in the win over San Jose State last September and the Broncos gave up the go-ahead goal with 38 seconds left in the match against LMU in November.
- Berkovitz leads the team with three goals while five others have tallied a goal each.
- Four players (Ozburn, Alejandro Arenas, Ethan Martinez and Will Wiersdorf) have not missed a minute of action this season, playing the entire 450 minutes.

Season Notes

- [Head coach Cam Rast](#) is in his 24th season at the helm where he has a career record of 208-157-69 including 106-68-36 in WCC and 102-59-40 at home.
- In season openers, Rast has a record of 12-10-2.
- Santa Clara had a 5-8-3 season with a 2-4-2 West Coast Conference record in 2024 to finish sixth in the league standings among nine teams.
- The Broncos play a total of 18 regular season matches, split evenly with nine non-conference and nine conference games. Last season, the number of league game increased from the customary seven matches they played from 2014-23 to eight due to Oregon State joining the league and this season it's up to nine matches with the addition of Seattle U.
- The Broncos face a challenging schedule playing five teams that qualified for the 2024 NCAA Tournament - UC Davis, Stanford, San Diego, Oregon State and Seattle. So far, they are 1-1 against those teams, getting the win over UC Davis but losing to Stanford.

2025 Team

- The 2025 squad is comprised of 30 players including 19 returners and 11 newcomers.
- Two returners were named All-West Coast Conference last year - senior Naji Elder and junior Will Wiersdorf garnered second team honors.
- Eleven newcomers dot the roster: Ezana Alemayehu, Moises Almontes, Alejandro Arenas, Alen Begovic, Niv Berkovitz, Diego Diaz, Josmar Guandique, Ethan Martinez, Gabrielius Mazonas, James Saggau and James Wangsness.
- Of the 11 newcomers, seven are freshman and four are transfers - Berkovitz (SMU), Diaz (Temple), Saggau (Cal Poly) and Wangsness (Princeton).
- Nine newcomers saw action in the season opener against Cleveland State. Arenas, Berkovitz, Diaz and Martinez started while Almontes, Guandique, Mazonas, Saggau and Wangness came in as substitutes. Begovic made his Bronco debut against Stanford (Aug. 28) as the 10th newcomer that's seen the field this fall.
- Spencer Roberts returns to the team after pursuing an opportunity with the engineering department last year. He was on the team in 2023.
- The captains for this season are: senior midfielder Pierce Dyal and junior midfielder Will Wiersdorf.
- The Broncos return nine of 13 goals from last season (69.2%) led by Tyler Tipton with five. Will Wiersdorf tallied three goals and Itamar Efrat had one.
- Six of 11 assists (54.5%) returns led by Wiersdorf and Andrew Sullivan with two each.
- Jackson Ozburn played in five games and posted a 2-3 record with a 1.60 goals-against-average, a .652 save percentage and recorded one shutout.
- During the offseason, goalkeeper Eddy Marin was a recipient of the [CalHOPE Courage Award](#), an award honoring student-athletes at California colleges and universities who have overcome the stress, anxiety, and mental trauma associated with personal hardships and adversity.

Preseason

- By a vote of the league's 10 head coaches, Santa Clara was picked to finish seventh in the WCC with San Diego as the favorite to win the conference. League newcomer Seattle was picked to finish tied for fourth.

Coaching Staff

- All four members of the coaching staff played in the WCC including three at Santa Clara - head coach Cam Rast '91, associate head coach Eric Yamamoto '90 and assistant coach Jack Murphy '22. Assistant coach Riley Hanley '15 played at Saint Mary's.
- Rast is the winningest active coach in the WCC leading his alma mater to eight NCAA tournaments and seven WCC Championships since taking over the Bronco men's soccer program in 2002. A former All-America player on Santa Clara's National Championship team of 1989 (along with Yamamoto) and U.S. Olympic Team captain in 1992, Rast spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at SCU from 1994-2001 and was inducted to the WCC Hall of Honor in 2018.
- Rast has been named WCC Coach of the Year seven times (2003, '06, '07, '10, '15, '21 and '23).
