Tournament Notes

- Santa Clara is ready to begin play at the John Burns Intercollegiate, which will be the second of six spring events.
- J.P. Odland will tee off No. 1 followed by Matt Robles, Calder Overfelt, Kevin Hollomon and Emil Nielsen
- This year's field is stacked with 19 teams competing for the title. In addition to Santa Clara and host-Hawaii, UTEP, Utah, San Diego State, San Francisco, BYU, Saint Mary's, Missouri, Cal, Miami (Ohio), Fresno State, LMU, New Mexico, Grand Canyon, Texas A&M, Long Beach State, Washington State and UNLV will all be attendance.
- The Broncos shot 10-under par to take third place at least season's John Burns Intercollegiate. Robles led the charge with a tie for eighth at 4-under 206 while Overfelt (T14) and Nielsen (T20) also finished in the top 20.

Season Notes

- The Broncos will take part in six tournaments throughout the spring in their quest to qualify for the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight year.
- SCU is coming off a 10th place finish in the first event of the spring - the N.I.T. hosted by Arizona.
- Santa Clara posted a pair of top-three finishes during the fall. They opened the year with a runner-up finish at the Palouse Collegiate by turning in the second-lowest score to par in program history (39-under 813). They also picked up a third place finish at the Saint Mary's Invitational (2-under 862).
- J.P. Odland was named to the 10-man Preseason All-WCC Team.
- Odland leads the team in scoring average (70.8) and had a pair of top-10 finishes in the fall. He enters the spring with the Broncos' highest individual ranking at No. 247.
- Odland opened the fall with a tie for ninth at the Palouse Collegiate (8-under 205) and bookended the fall with a fourth-place finish at the Preserve Golf Course Collegiate (9-under 207).
- Calder Overfelt also had a great fall with a 71.2 scoring average and a pair of top-three finishes. He began the season with a phenomenal 14-under 199 at the Palouse Collegiate - tied for the third-lowest score in program history - en route to a runner-up finish. The Newport Beach product tied for third at the Saint Mary's Invitational (4-under 212).
- Matt Robles (71.53) posted three top-20 finishes, including a fourth-place finish at the Palouse with an 11-under 202 total.
- Kevin Hollomon (71.58) played in four events in the fall and closed things out with consecutive top-12 finishes at the Saint Mary's Invitational (t-12) and the Preserve Golf Course Collegiate (t-9).
- Tucker Sweeney, a freshman captured his first collegiate tournament while playing as an individual at the RCA Electric Invitational. He shot an 8-under 63 in the opening round - tied for the lowest round by a freshman in program history - and finished the event 8-under 205 in total.

2024-25 Recap

- The Broncos are coming off one of their most successful seasons in program history. The team shattered the program season scoring record (283.72 strokes), had three All-WCC honorees (most since 2018) and qualified for the NCAA Tournament for just the third time in program history.
- Other highlights from the historic 2024-25 season:
 - SCU placed fifth or better in eight of their 13 events.
 - The Broncos finished the regular season ranked 45th in the National Collegiate Golf Rankings - their best finish in program history.
 - SCU shattered the program's 54-hole record at the WCC Championship with a 26-under 838 to finish stroke play in third place. The advanced to match play for the first time in program history.
 - SCU turned in the third-best score-to-par performance in program history at the Alister Mackenzie Invitational, shooting 37-under 815.
- Santa Clara returns four of their top five scorers from a year ago - J.P. Odland (70.92), Matt Robles (71.52), Emil Nielsen (72.56) and Calder Overfelt (72.87).
- Odland had one of the finest individual seasons in program history in 2024-25. His 70.92 scoring average ranks fourth-best in program history, he became the first player in program history to win multiple events (he tied for medalist honors at both the Myrtle Beach Golf Trips Intercollegiate and The Goodwin), he tied the program record for rounds in the 60s (15) and the second-most rounds under par (20).
- Odland shot 15-under 198 at the Alister Mackenzie Invitational to tie Hayden Shieh for the lowest score-to-par in program history.
- Matt Robles also had a fantastic campaign as a freshman, finishing the year second on the team in scoring (71.52) and earning both All-WCC and WCC Freshman of the Year honors. He tied Odland for the team-lead with five top-10 finishes (tied for seventh-most in program history).
