- The Broncos will look to keep their streak of top-four finishes intact when they take part in the Causeway Invitational hosted by UC Davis, Feb. 23-24.
- The event will be played at Del Paso Country Club in Sacramento.
- Kelsey Kim will tee off No. 1 once again followed by Amy Im, Chloe Lam, Audrey Brust and Proud Sriwongngam. Rachael Wang will also compete as an individual.
- A total of 10 teams will take part in the event. In addition to the Broncos and host-UC Davis, San Francisco, San Diego State, Nevada, Colorado, Seattle, Cal Poly and Sacramento State will all be in attendance.

Season Notes

- The Broncos were recently picked third in the WCC Preseason Coaches Poll while Kelsey Kim was tabbed Preseason All-WCC.
- SCU is coming off a third-place finish at the San Diego State Classic. Kim finished runner-up with a career-best 6-under 210.
- The Broncos have finished inside the top-four of the standings in all five events this year.
- Santa Clara could not have asked for a much better fall campaign. The Broncos won the first event of the season, the Kalispel Invitational, and shot under par in the next three tournaments to finish second, fourth and tied for second.
- Entering this season, Santa Clara had only shot under par as a team twice in program history. They've done so in three consecutive tournaments, most recently with a 4-under 860 - the second-lowest score in program history.
- The Broncos tied for runner-up at the Rainbow Wahine Invitational to close out the fall. Kim led the way individually with a tie for third at 5-under 211 to match her personal-best which was set just a week earlier at the Golf Iconic Classic.
- SCU was 8-under 568 after the first two rounds of the Golf Iconic Classic. It is the second-lowest 36-hole score in program history. They shot 5-under 283 in the second round, which is tied for the sixth-lowest 18-hole score in program history.
- The Broncos finished runner-up at the Pat Lesser Harbottle after turning in a 2-under 862. Brust came ever so close to winning her first collegiate event, but ultimately finished tied for fourth - tied for her best career finish - at 1-under 215.
- The Broncos opened the season by winning the Kalispel Invitational by 10 strokes for the 19th team title under head coach Krystal Kelly.
- Kim leads the team in scoring average at 70.80 strokes per round. She has finished top-four in four events, including three-straight.
- Kim has already set the program record for rounds under par in a single season (10) and also holds the career record of 19.
- Amy Im played her first event of the season at the San Diego State Classic where she shot 1-over 217 to tie for 11th.
- Brust holds a scoring average of 72.67 strokes and has finished in the top-15 in four of five events played.

2024-25 Recap

- Santa Clara ended the season on a high note by capturing the 2025 National Golf Invitational team title. It was the Broncos' first tournament win since the 2022 season.
- The Broncos quietly put together the best team scoring average in program history, besting their 2023-24 record with a collective 295.67 strokes per round.
- Kelsey Kim was the best of the bunch with a 73.88 average (second-best in program history) and logged a team-best seven top-20 finishes as a sophomore.
- Chloe Lam had a fantastic freshman season, finishing with a the eighth-best scoring average in program history at 74.37 strokes. She was the Broncos' top finisher at the WCC Championship, tying the program record in the tournament of 3-over 219 to finish in a tie for fifth. For her efforts, she was honored as an All-WCC performer.
- With a 74.40 average of 62 career appearances, Kim currently holds the best career scoring average in program history, just ahead of Borina Sutkito (74.56) and Claire Choi (74.95).
- Audrey Brust, entering her senior campaign, is also one of the top players in program history, ranking fifth in career scoring average at 75.29 strokes over 96 rounds. Her 11 career rounds under par also rank fifth-most in the program's history.
