## 2025-26 Team

- Santa Clara is led by head coach Niall Angus who is in his 10th season at the helm and assisted by Josh Page who is in his second season.
- Angus is currently the second winningest coach in Santa Clara men's tennis history with 118 wins entering the 2026 spring dual match season. Sean Burns is the Broncos all-time winningest coach with 130 career wins.
- The spring roster is comprised of nine players including eight returnees and one newcomer, Ferran Redza, who joined as a mid-year enrollee. Redza reached a career-high World Junior ITF ranking of 307 and played in the main draw of the 2025 Junior Wimbledon doubles.
- In 2024-25, the Broncos finished 15-9 overall including 5-2 in the West Coast Conference, tied for second in the WCC.
- Last season the Broncos were ranked nationally for 11 straight weeks and finished No. 73 nationally, qualifying for the WCC Tournament for the seventh straight season.
- In the mid-major rankings, they finished No. 25 and in the Northwest Regionals rankings, No. 6. Luca Bluett and Kim were ranked No. 8 in the Northwest Regional doubles list.
- Four returners garnered All-WCC recognitions: Bluett and Kim were named to the doubles second team. Bluett also made singles honorable mention along with Watanabe Eriksson and Luca Lemaitre.
- The team lost just one player from last season, Payton Jim-On.

## Season Notes

- No. 44 Santa Clara plays one match this week, hosting Weber State on Sunday.
- The Broncos are ranked No. 44 this week after coming in at No. 40 in the initial ITA team rankings last week. The No. 40 ranking was the highest they have been ranked since 2013 when they were No. 37.
- Luca Bluett and John Kim are currently ranked as the No. 19 doubles team in the nation.
- Santa Clara won a pair of matches last weekend, beating New Mexico 6-1 and then-No. 74 UNLV 4-2.
- [Valentin Faure and Ferran Redza were named WCC Doubles Team of the Week](#) on Feb. 24 after securing the doubles point in both the New Mexico and UNLV matches on court 3. It was the second time this spring that a Bronco doubles team took the WCC Doubles Team of the Week honors - [Luca Bluett and John Kim won it back on Jan. 27](#).
- [Redza also was named the WCC Freshman Player of the Week on Feb. 3](#) after his 3-all clincher against Oregon in his collegiate debut.
- Two Broncos have had 3-all clinchers this season: Redza against Oregon and Kim against Washington
- SCU has three wins against nationally ranked doubles opponents this spring - Bluett and Kim beat No. 2 Petar Jovanovic and Benito Sanchez Martinez from Mississippi State and downed No. 12 Jacob Olar and Andrii Zimnokh from Alabama. Tiago Boschmans and Luca Lemaitre defeated No. 80 Miguel Avendano and Lucca Liu of UC Santa Barbara.
- In the first spring ITA rankings that came out on Feb. 4, Luca Bluett and John Kim came in at No. 17.
- Bluett and Kim are 4-1 in doubles dual matches on the season. Redza leads the team with eight doubles victories (8-3).
- Redza and Faure have a six-match win streak.
- Faure (7-2) and Lukas Maskow (7-4) leads the team in singles wins with seven.
- In doubles play, the Broncos are 19-6 on the year.
- The Broncos are a combined 30-9 in singles No. 3-6 this spring.
- Santa Clara was [picked to finish third in the West Coast Conference preseason poll](#) as voted by the league's eight head coaches.
- During the 2025-26 fall season, Bluett and Kim became the first-ever Santa Clara men's tennis players to qualify for the NCAA Individual Championships. They were one of the 32 doubles teams that competed in the 2025 NCAA Division I Men's Tennis Singles and Doubles Championship. They fell in the opening round in three sets to the doubles team from Penn, Aaron Sandler and Manfredi Graziani.
- The last and only time Santa Clara had a qualifier at the NCAA Individual Championships was in 2014 when women's player Katie Le played in her third consecutive singles championship from 2012-14.
- The 2012 SCU men's team qualified for the NCAA Team Championships.
- Bluett and Kim finished the fall with a 6-4 record while paired together.
- Last season, their first playing together, Bluett and Kim were a combined 14-7 including 12-6 in dual matches and 2-1 over the fall. All 12 wins in the spring came atop the doubles lineup helping them land second team All-West Coast Conference honors.
- Kim and Alexander Watanabe Eriksson recorded a team-high six singles victories during the fall campaign.
